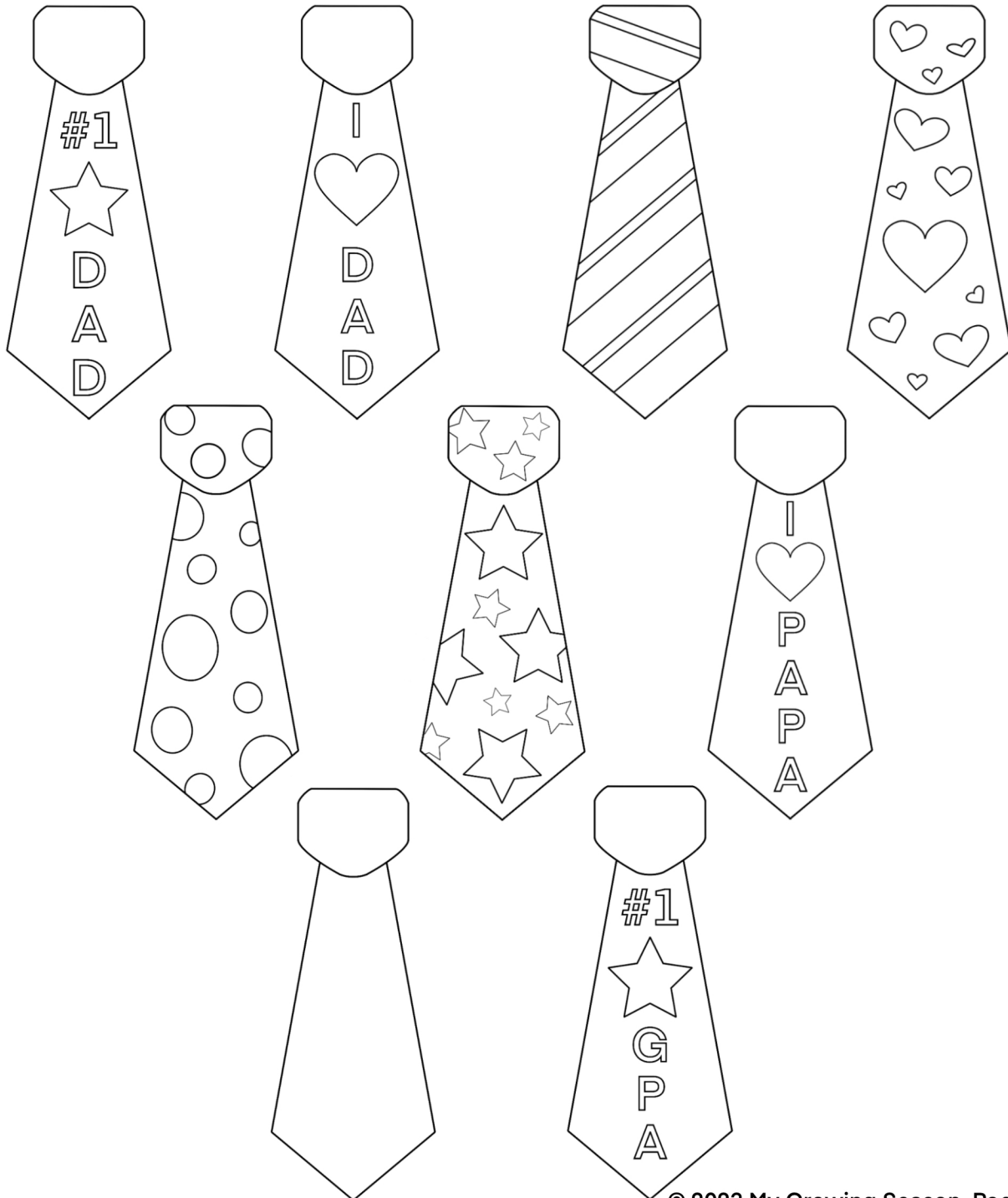


Step 1

Pick a tie front to decorate! Tie fronts can be decorated with colored pencils, crayons, markers, paint, watercolor, stickers, etc. You can even create your own design on the blank tie!

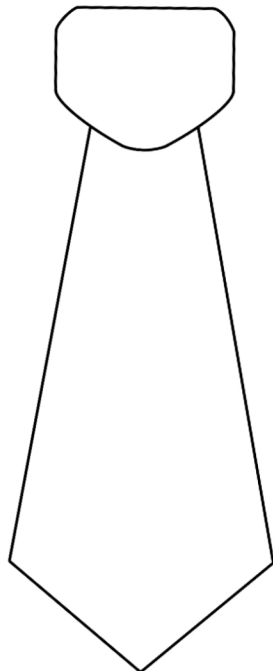
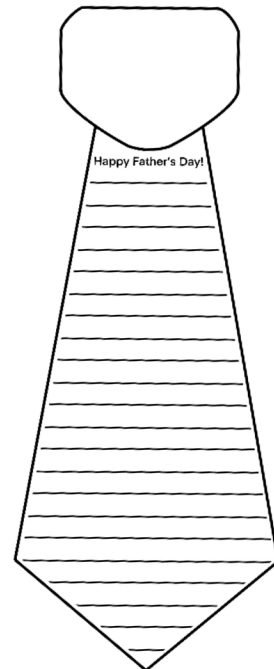
TIP: Cardstock is a great option for durability, especially if you plan to use marker or paint; the colors will be less likely to bleed through.

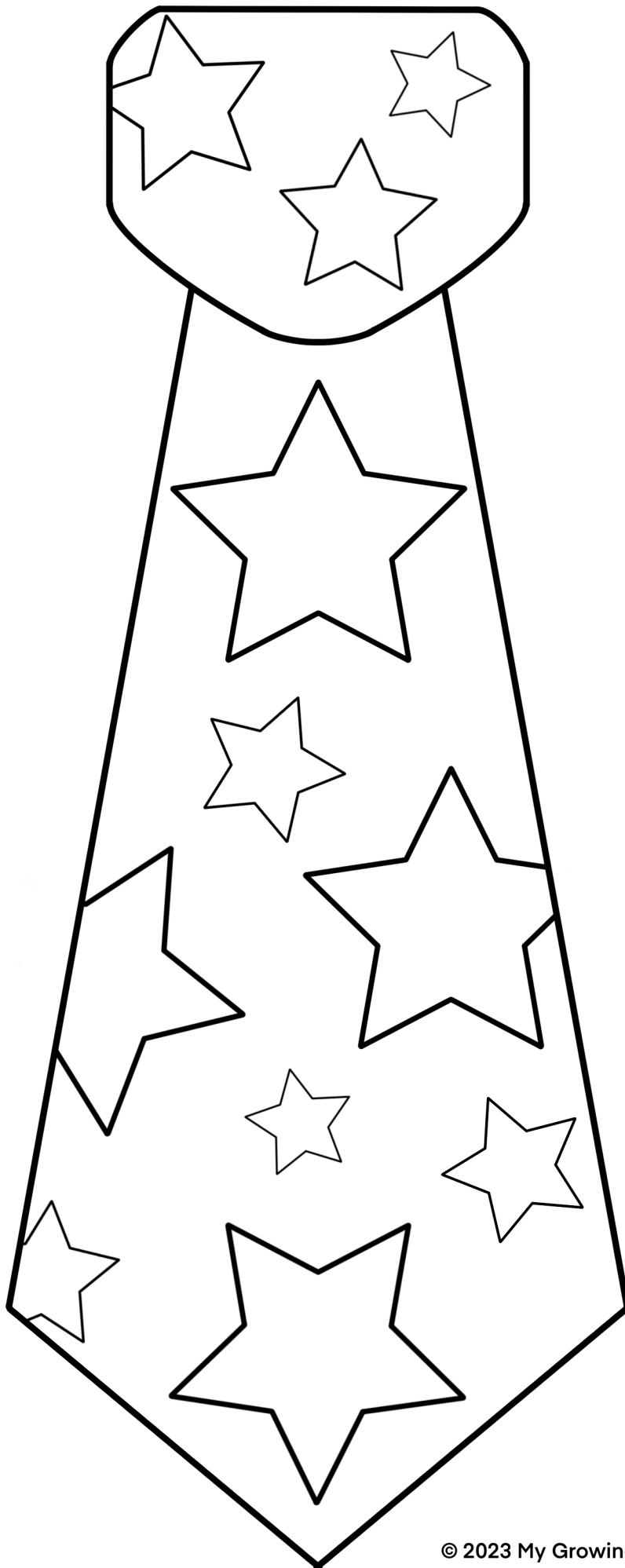


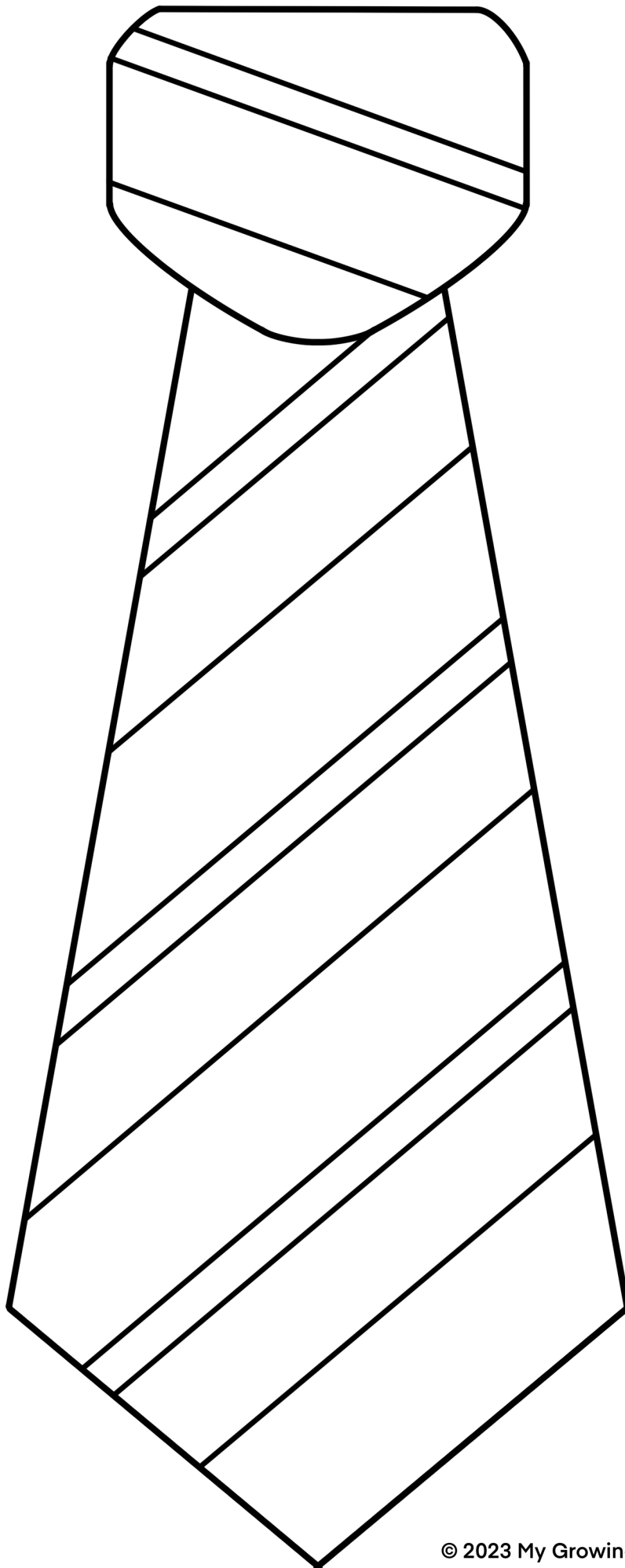
Step 2

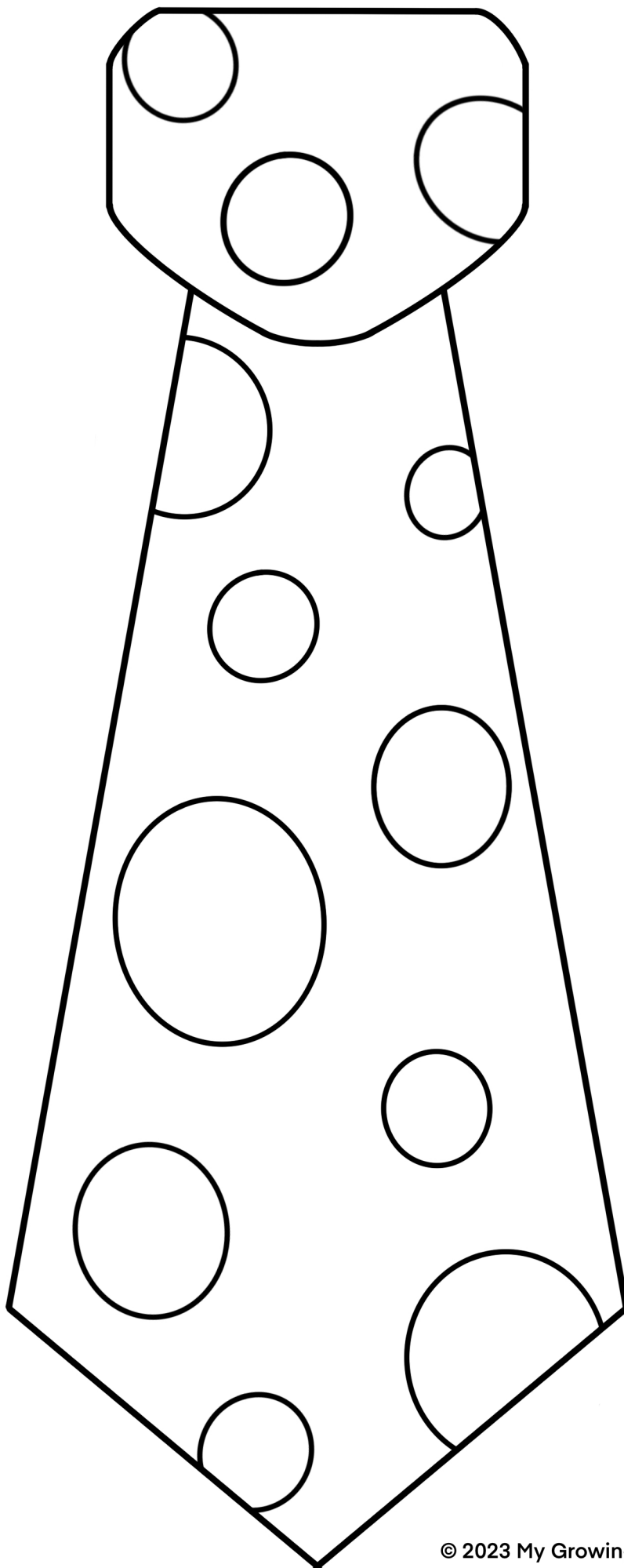
Pick the back of your tie! You can fill in the blanks for a father or grandfather, write your own note on the lines, or use a blank tie for a message of your choosing.

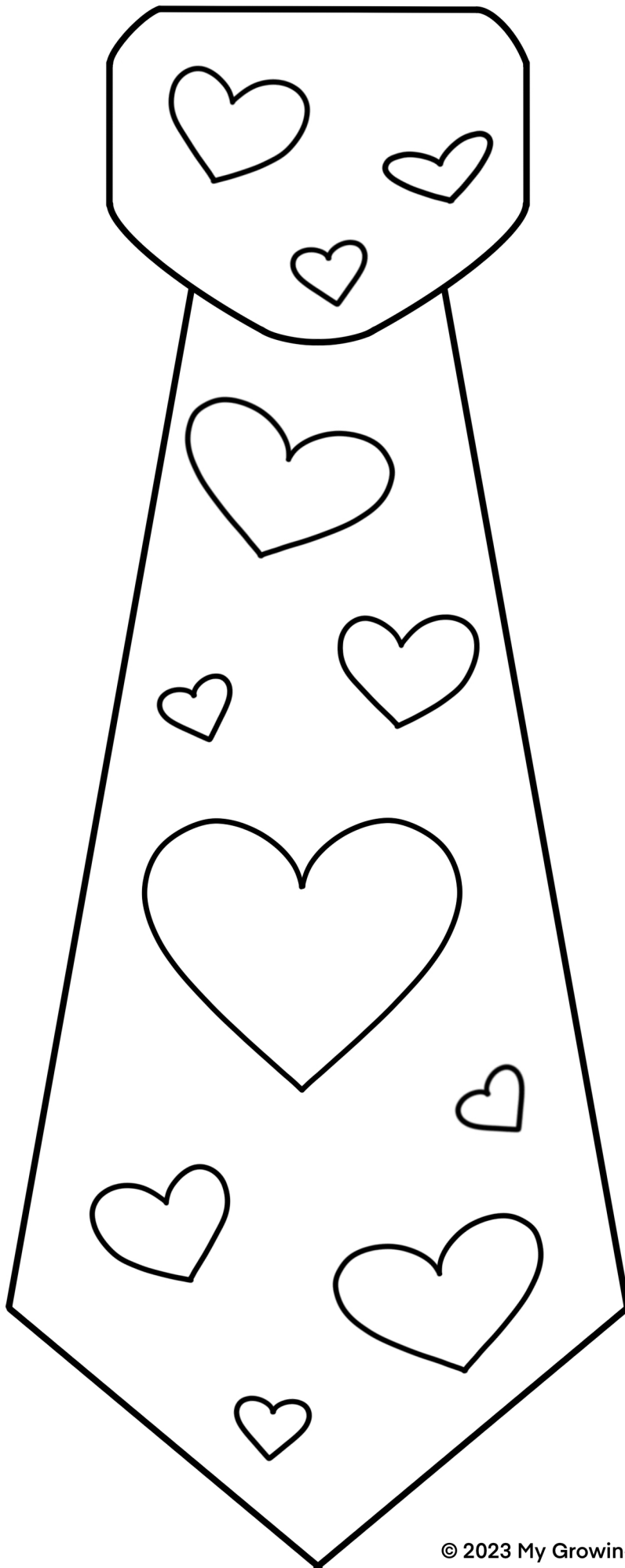
The two sides of the tie can either 1) be printed on one piece of paper using double sided printing, or 2) printed on two separate pieces of paper which are then glued together at the top of the tie knot. Glue the patterned tie on top.

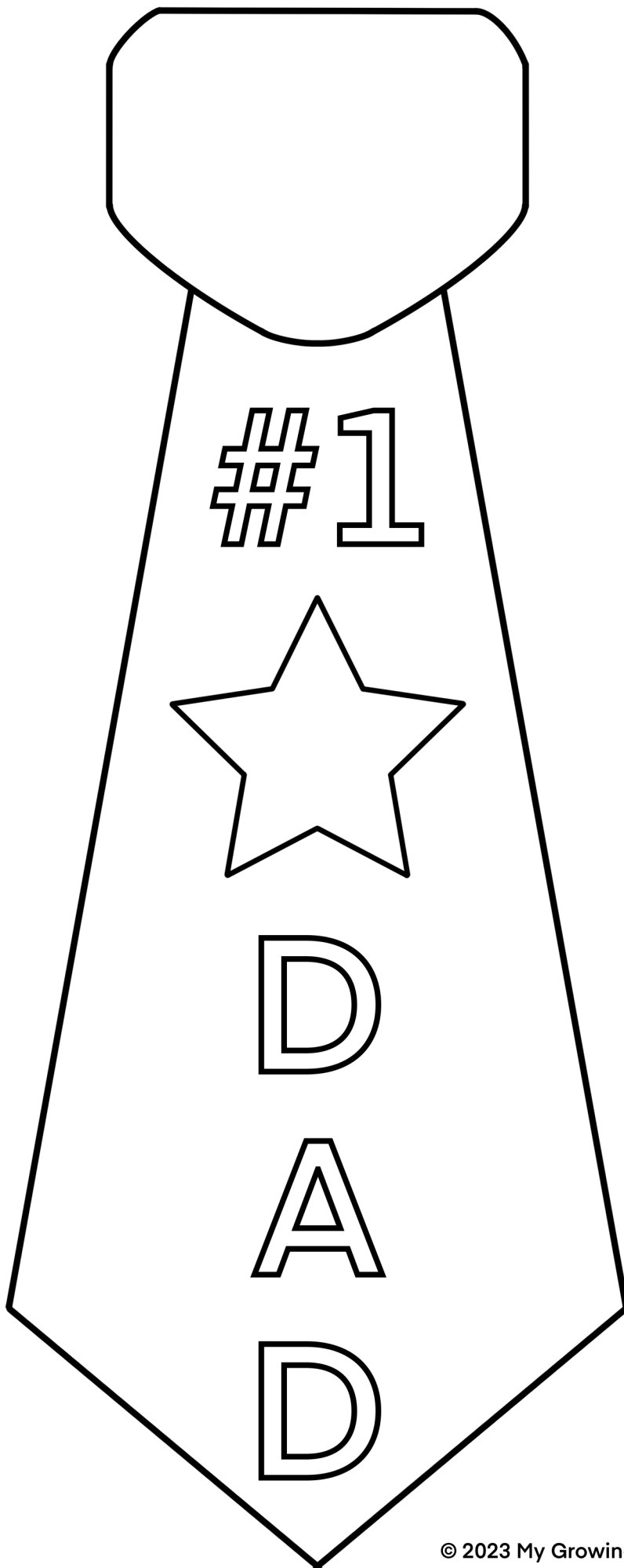


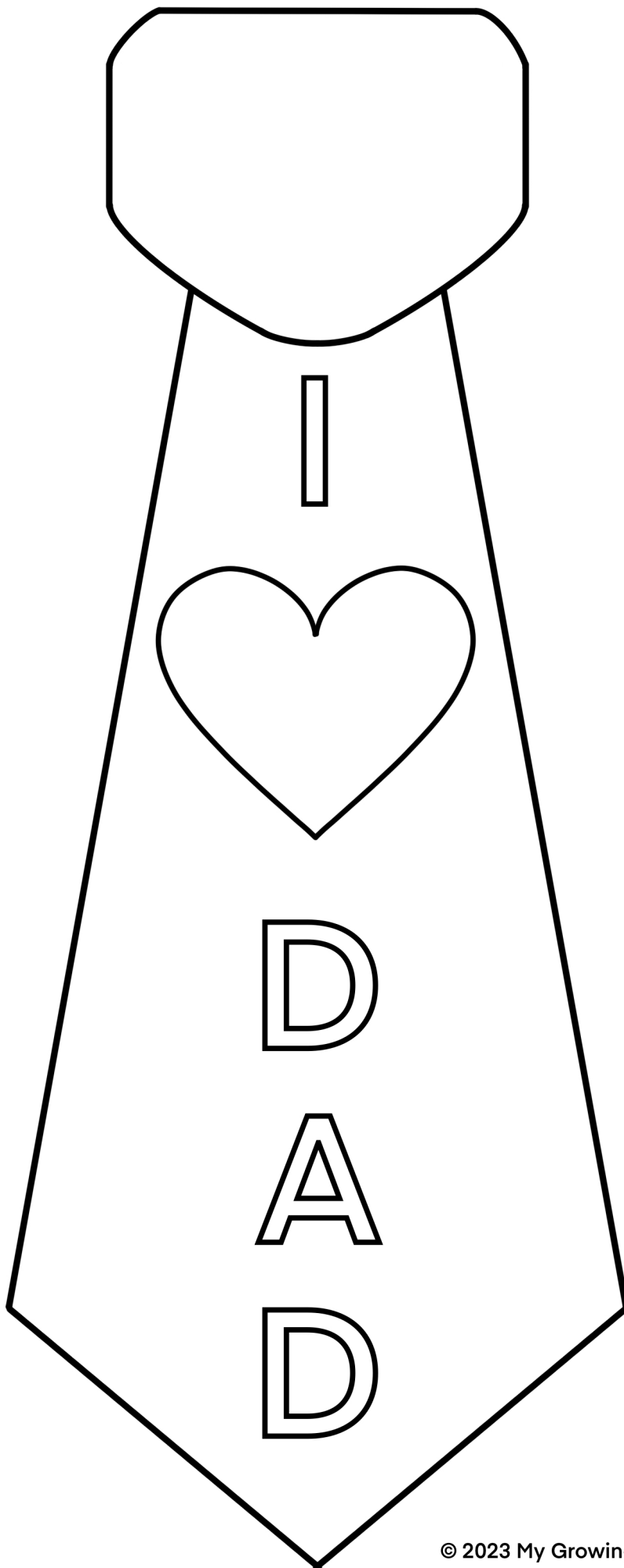


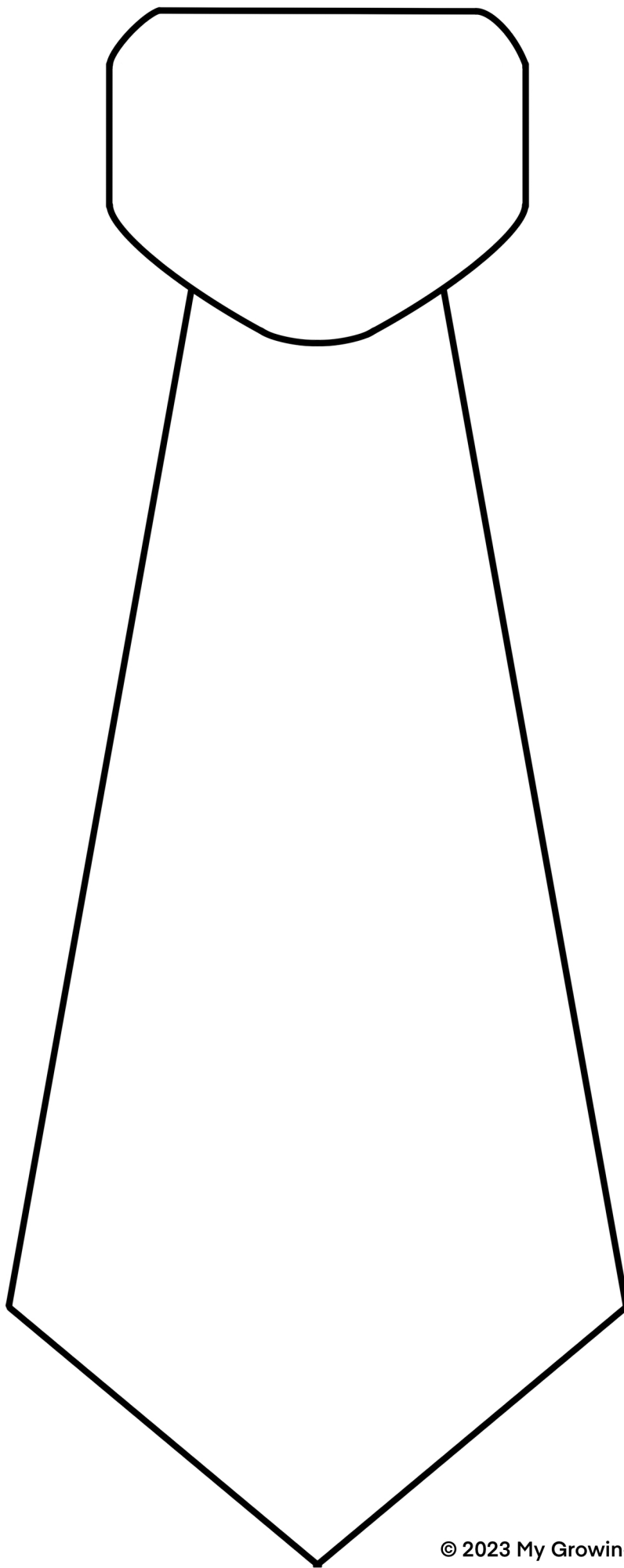


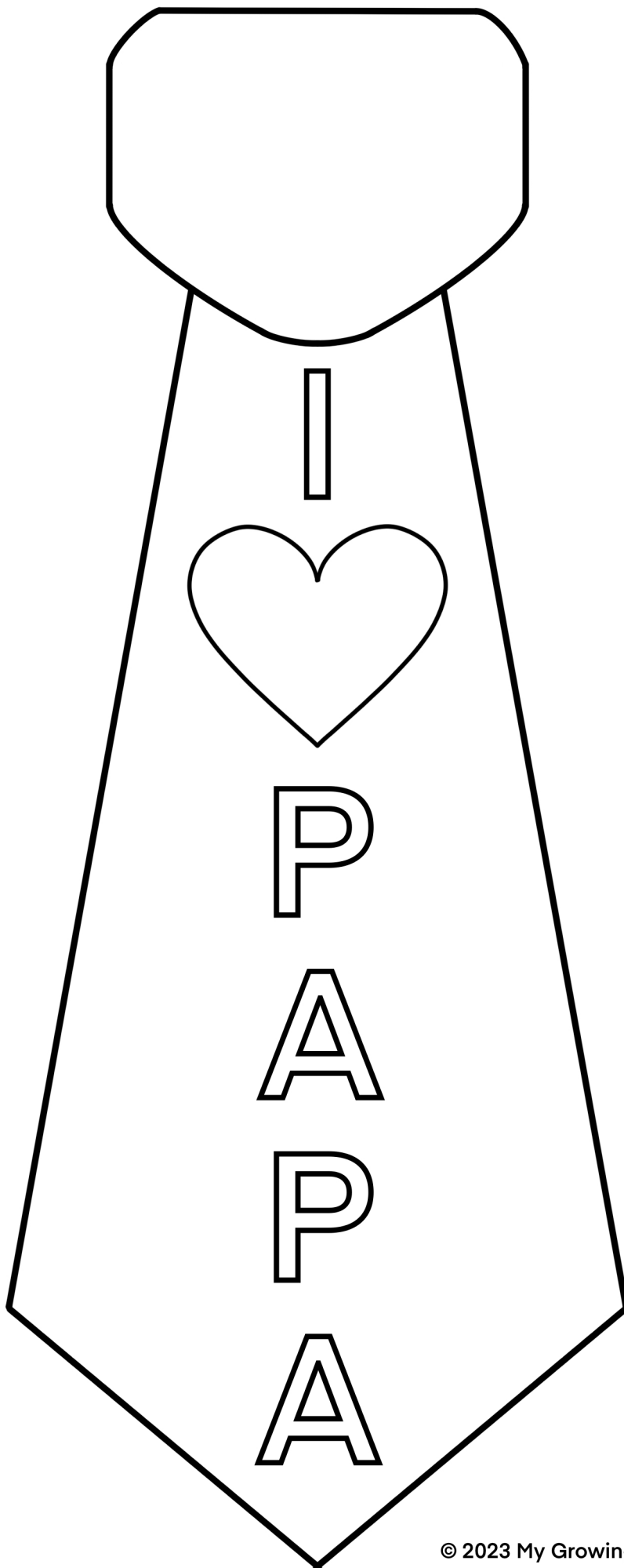


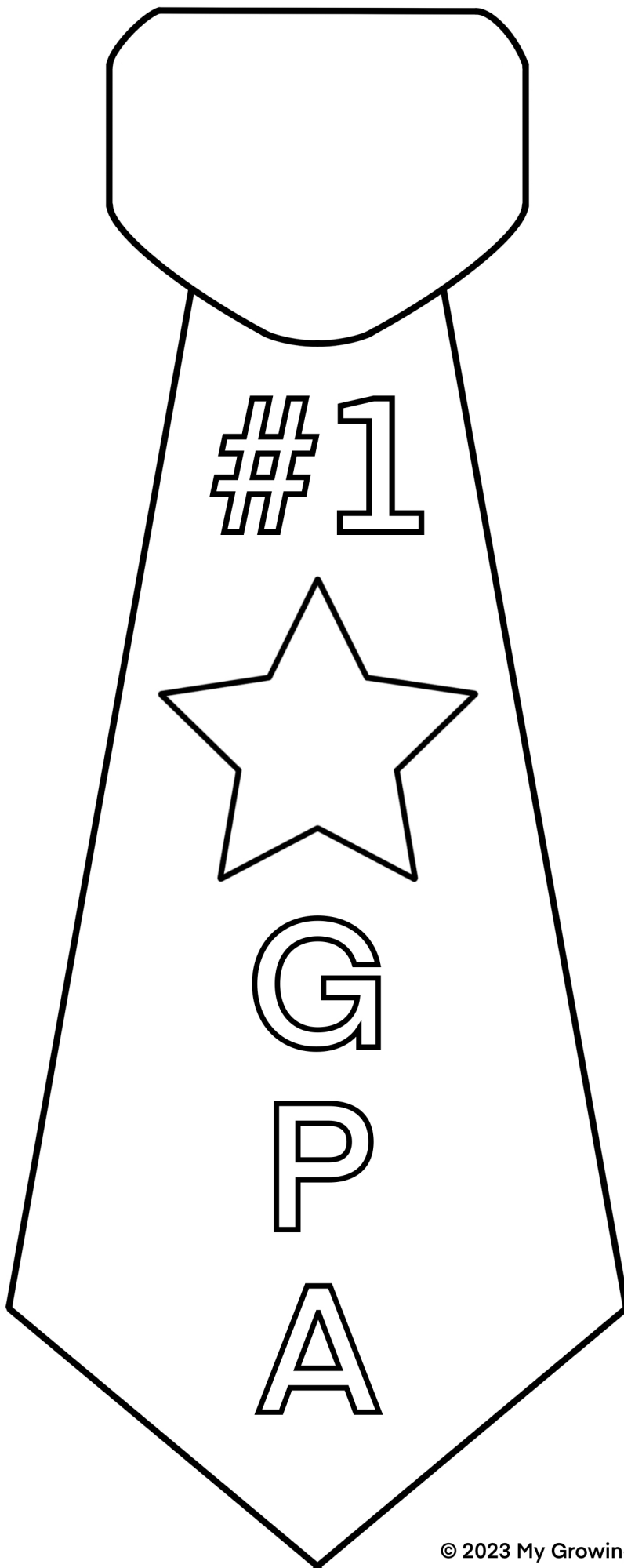


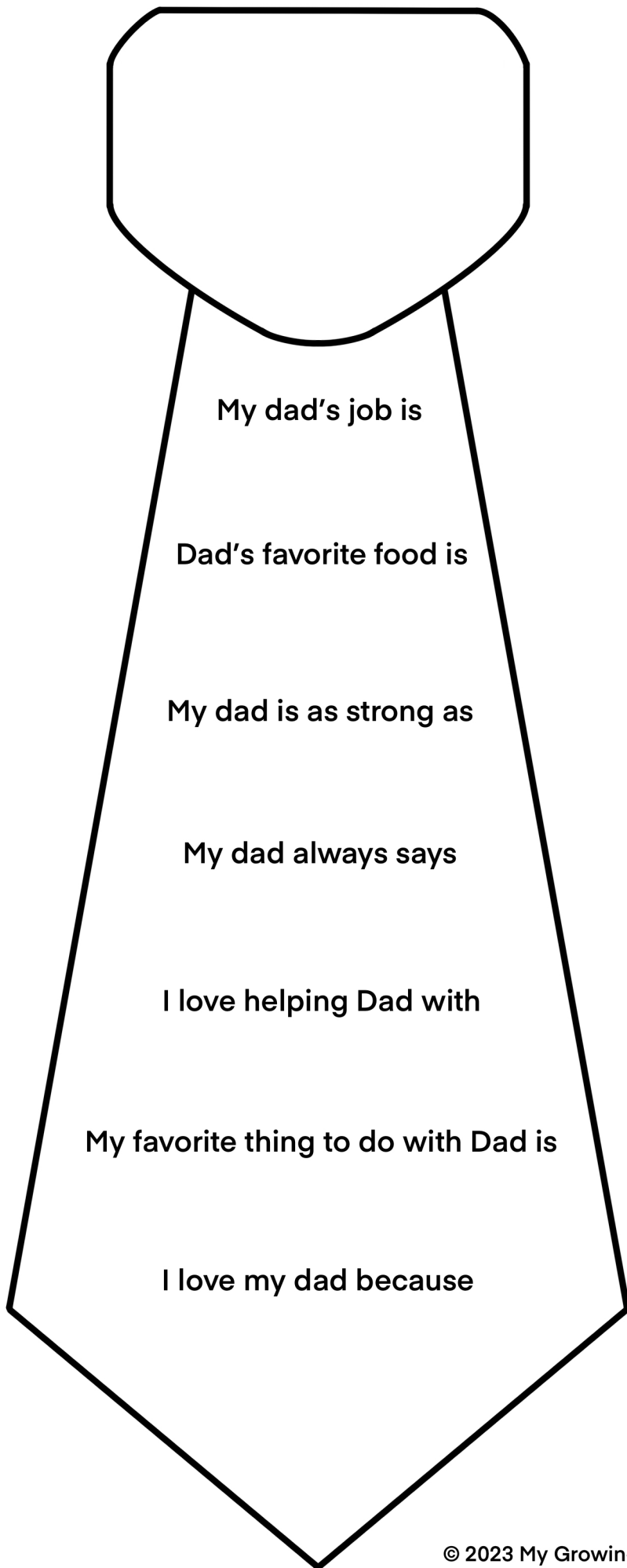
