Back to School Pennant Flag- INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Figure out which of the pages you will need in the document. Don't print all the pages if you only need 1 grade! When you go to print, instead of selecting print all, type in the page numbers you want printed.

STEP 2: Default settings on every printer will differ. Be sure to select "scale to fit" when printing the pennants (this is sometimes under "more settings"). This will ensure nothing gets cut off while printing.

STEP 3: Determine if you want to print on printer paper or cardstock. Load the appropriate paper. We recommend cardstock for durability but paper certainly works in a pinch.

STEP 4: Cut the pennant out and fold back the flap outlined in dotted lines. This flap will close around the dowel.

STEP 5: The flap can be taped down around the dowel. If for any reason the dowel is too thick to fit in the paper flap, you can always hot glue the pennant to the dowel.

STEP 6: *EXTRA* Tie some ribbon around the dowel for extra style and color.

STEP 7: Take a photo with your cute new flag!
