

Find your bracelet size with this easy-to-use tutorial. All you need for this is a printer and paper.

Instructions for use:

1. First, print this document out ensuring the page scaling is set to $100 \%$ for a full A4 page. When printed, check the line below - it should measure exactly 30 mm . This is your accuracy guide.
2. Cut out the ruler and cut open the line at the base of the ruler (where it says 'Cut Here', we like to make things easy).
3. Wrap the sizer around your wrist, making sure the numbers are visible, and insert the tip through the gap. Adjust until you have a nice, close fit around your wrist.
4. Look at the measurement where you've inserted the tip of the sizer through the gap you've cut, and voila, you have your wrist size circumference.
