ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The 1st generation anticoagulant in
Double Tap (Diphacinone) is metabolised
relatively quickly meaning it is less likely to
bioaccumulate and put our
non-target species at risk.
If game species are exposed to bait, they will
void these compounds quickly.
Cholecalciferol is readily metabolised and
does not persist in the environment.
