Ferafeed Pastes and Pellet Product Selection Guide

Selecting the best Ferafeed can be a daunting process when embarking on invasive animal pest control for the first time. Each Ferafeed has unique use applications and this table will help to guide you to make the best product selection for your job. All products listed are entirely non-toxic and we often refer to them as prefeeds.





Ferafeed 213 Paste

Possums, Rodents and Wallabies

- Most popular peanut butter paste with mixed grains and some Ferafeed Pellets
- Appearance: rough grainy consistency and dyed green
- Bait Placement: in bait stations with Feratox Pellets; make up balls
 of 12-20 grams of paste and insert a Feratox Pellet and place into
 empty labelled Feratox biodegradable bags; by placing in bait
 stations before applying Feracol Paste
- Trapping: suitable for attracting animals to kill and live capture traps

Ferafeed Peanut Classic Paste

Possums only

- A peanut butter based prefeed non-toxic paste with numerous Ferafeed Pellets and cinnamon lure added as attractant
 - Appearance: looks like green dyed play dough with brown spots
 - Bait Placement: used in bait stations with Feratox Pellets or for making up Feratox Bio Bags
 - Trapping: suitable for attracting animals to all types of traps



Possums and Rodents



- An extra smooth prefeed non-toxic paste with cinnamon lure
- Appearance: very smooth consistency, likened to whipped smooth peanut butter and dyed blue
- Bait Placement: used as a companion product to toxins Cyanide Paste, Feratox Pellets and Feracol Paste.
- Trapping: suitable for attracting animals to all types of traps

Ferafeed Prefeed Pellets

Possums only



- A hard cinnamon lured cereal based pellet; small and cylindrical, being 7mm wide by between 5-10mm long
- Mimics the hardness of Feratox Pellets and accustoms possums to the bite
- Appearance: light brown colour
- Bait Placement: with Feratox Pellets in bait stations and for trapping possums
