Dirt and other contaminants can interfere with the waterproof coating of your garment, impacting its breathability.

Important rules for washing

- Fasten all zips and Velcro flaps before washing
- Normal household detergents can compromise the waterproof coating. Use a specialist cleaning product like Nikwax Tech Wash® (or Nikwax Down Wash Direct for down-filled clothing).
- Do not dry clean your garment

WATERPROOFING

Eventually the DWR (Durable Water

Repellent) finish on your garment will wear off. You will know it's time to waterproof when water starts to be absorbed and the breathablity is affected, making you feel clammy.
