

WOCA PATINA DISCS - USER INSTRUCTIONS

WOCA introduces a new way of oiling wood floors and other woodwork, including countertops, tables, panels and cabinetry. By using the WOCA Patina Discs, floors and woodwork is instantly saturated, providing a hard-wearing and silky soft surface which is easy to maintain.

Wood floors treated with WOCA Diamond Oil and Patina Discs are now finished in a one coat application.

Instructions:

- 1. The green side of the Patina Disc is a specially designed polishing grit, while the other is covered in Velcro that attaches itself to a polishing pad.
- 2. Two or three Patina Discs are placed opposite each other under a green, red or white polishing pad.
- 3. After oil has been applied to the wood surface, it is worked into the wood with the Patina Discs mounted under the polishing pad. The combination of Patina Discs and polishing forces the oil to penetrate into the wood faster and leaves an extremely smooth surface.
- 4. When the floor or woodwork looks saturated, remove excess oil with cloth or towel, then polish with clean white pad to create a uniform gloss.

Tip: Patina Discs may be reused by cleaning with mineral spirit and afterwards rinsed in water.

Warning! Rags, pads or waste soaked with WOCA oil may self-ignite if improperly discarded. Immediately after use, place all rags and waste in a sealed, water filled bucket for proper disposal.
