Container Care Guide

All containers have been designed to be suitable for outdoors use.

Some of our containers have also been designed to be used indoors without the need for a saucer. These pots and containers have a plug in the base of them. Please leave plug in situ if using indoors and remove plug to aid drainage if using outside.

Whilst most of our pots and containers have pre-drilled drainage holes, some designs do not. If there are no pre-drilled drainage holes please drill holes yourself using the marked guides on the base of the pots to show you where to drill.

Pots and containers with handles should not be lifted using the handles when full, these are for decorative purposes only.

It is a good idea to wash previously used pots and containers in warm, mildly soapy water before re-filling with compost and potting up new plants. Not only does this help to keep containers neat and tidy but can also reduce the risk of disease passing between plants.
