She received a B.A. in Studio Art (1999) and a Masters of Professional Studios in Arts & Cultural Leadership(2017), both at the University of Minnesota. She has shared her art form with schools and communities as a teaching artist since 2003, and has been selected to be on teaching rosters with Compas, Inc., VSA-Minnesota, and Lifetime Arts. She has received several grants for her professional growth, as well as the Emerging Artist Award (CMAB) and the Outstanding Contributor to the Arts of Morrison County with FWAC. With over 12 years experience in nonprofit administration, she has run several juried exhibits, designed new art programs, and facilitated community conversations around the arts. In 2019, she was awarded with the opportunity to build the Tiny School of Art & Design to build community through the foundations of art, and serve as a value-added option for her already solid teaching artist engagements. She recently completed a Creative Community Fellowship with National Arts Strategies, where she expanded her Tiny School into adult populations in small towns, to expand ways to solve community-based problems or approach new opportunities.
