

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY



Athena and Clearlite Bathrooms are committed to conduct operations with minimal impact on the environment, to comply with applicable environmental legislative and regulatory requirements, and where possible, strive towards continued improvement, to ensure the environment is not adversely impacted by our activities.

Over 70% of our products are manufactured in New Zealand and as a consequence we comply with the HSWA 2015, the Resource Management Act and all local authority requirements.

Some additional specific steps taken by the business with the environment in mind are as follows:

- Using only low emission E1 standard, New Zealand Grown, Environmentally Sustainable Board from FSC Certified Radiata Pine Plantations for our vanity cabinet manufacture. Standards include leading the world in developing low formaldehyde emission board.
- Committed to eliminating polystyrene packaging across the business.
- Responsibly recycling waste materials wherever possible.
- Ensuring contaminants are not added to any landfill when disposing of materials by confirming the material is inert before disposal.
- Giving consideration to “end of life” consequences when deciding on materials used in the manufacture of our products.
- Health & Safety procedures along with Dangerous Goods management practices are in place to ensure we protect the environment from any potential pollutants. The management of the materials used to manufacture our product is regarded as a paramount activity.
- Working with our supply chain partners to identify opportunities and develop and promote sustainability-led solutions.

Our impact on the environment is considered not only by the practices we put into place within our manufacturing facility, we also consider the people who work within this environment which extends to:-

- Health and wellbeing in and around our manufacturing/distribution facilities and offices
- Pollution to the local vicinity including, noise, air and water arising from our operations
- Promoting environmental responsibility among our employees and encouraging their input
- Our internal management procedures
