Conditions of Use

- Iluminar Mirrors require walls to be plumb and flat.
- While sealed from moisture it is recommended the room be well ventilated
- Do not position the Mirrors in the direct path of any water
- Iluminar Mirrors must be attached to the walls using suitable hardware fixed into solid fixings such as studs or noggs
- If hard wiring the connection must be carried out by a registered Electrician
