



ALL ABOUT the free-motion quilting foot

The free-motion quilting foot is used for all free-motion techniques such as stippling, embroidery, or creating battenburg lace. By lowering the feed dogs, you control the movement of the foot during stitching. You can stitch to the right and left or back and forth as you desire.

Use either a straight or zigzag stitch. The markings (1) on the foot indicate the widest swing to the right and left of the needle.

Depending on the sewing technique, the fabric is either placed in a hoop or not for movement and control.
