YOUR IMPACT



Impact Numbers - So far in 2022, we have provided 4,612 total night stays at the House, serving 281 children and 543 caregivers.



At the House - After nearly two years of the pandemic, communal spaces like the Dining Room, Living Room, and Playroom reopened for families and children to enjoy.



Ronald McDonald House Family Rooms - We are excited to welcome back volunteers to our King's County Family Room. We have also been busy prepping our Elmhurst Family Room for a Phase 1 opening.



NYC Impact in 2022 - Beyond our House at 73rd Street, we have served 1,134 caregivers and 1,821 children who are being treated at our partner hospitals at their NeoNatal ICU, Pediatric ICU and Pediatric departments



Sponsor a Ride Program - In 2021, families utilized 6,552 rides to and from hospitals providing their child's treatment covering a total of 31,202 miles with an average distance of 4.79 miles.
