ITEMS IN THE DIY KIT:



1 X WOODEN EMBROIDERY HOOP (15CM DIAMETER)



1 SET OF EMBROIDERY THREADS (9 COLOURS IN TOTAL)



1 PIECE OF COTTON FABRIC



2 EMBROIDERY NEEDLES



1 CARBON PAPER



1 PRINTED BOUQUET PAPER PATTERN

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED THAT'S NOT IN THE DIY KIT:



1 PAIR OF SCISSORS



1 SHARP PEN OR PENCIL

HOW TO TRANSFER YOUR PAPER PATTERN ONTO FABRIC:

STEP 1. ON A HARD SURFACE / TABLETOP, LAY YOUR FABRIC FLAT

STEP 2. PLACE THE SOLID BLUE SIDE OF THE CARBON PAPER
FACING DOWNWARDS. POSITION IN THE CENTER OF THE FABRIC

STEP 3. PLACE THE PAPER PATTERN OVER THE CARBON PAPER

STEP 4. USING YOUR SHARP PEN / PENCIL, TRACE THE ENTIRE
PAPER PATTERN

NOTE: TO CHECK WHETHER THE PATTERN HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY
TRANSFERRED ONTO THE FABRIC, FLIP THE SIDE OF THE CARBON
PAPER TO TAKE A PEEK.

REMEMBER TO KEEP THE PATTERN IN THE SAME POSITION WHILE
TRACING!

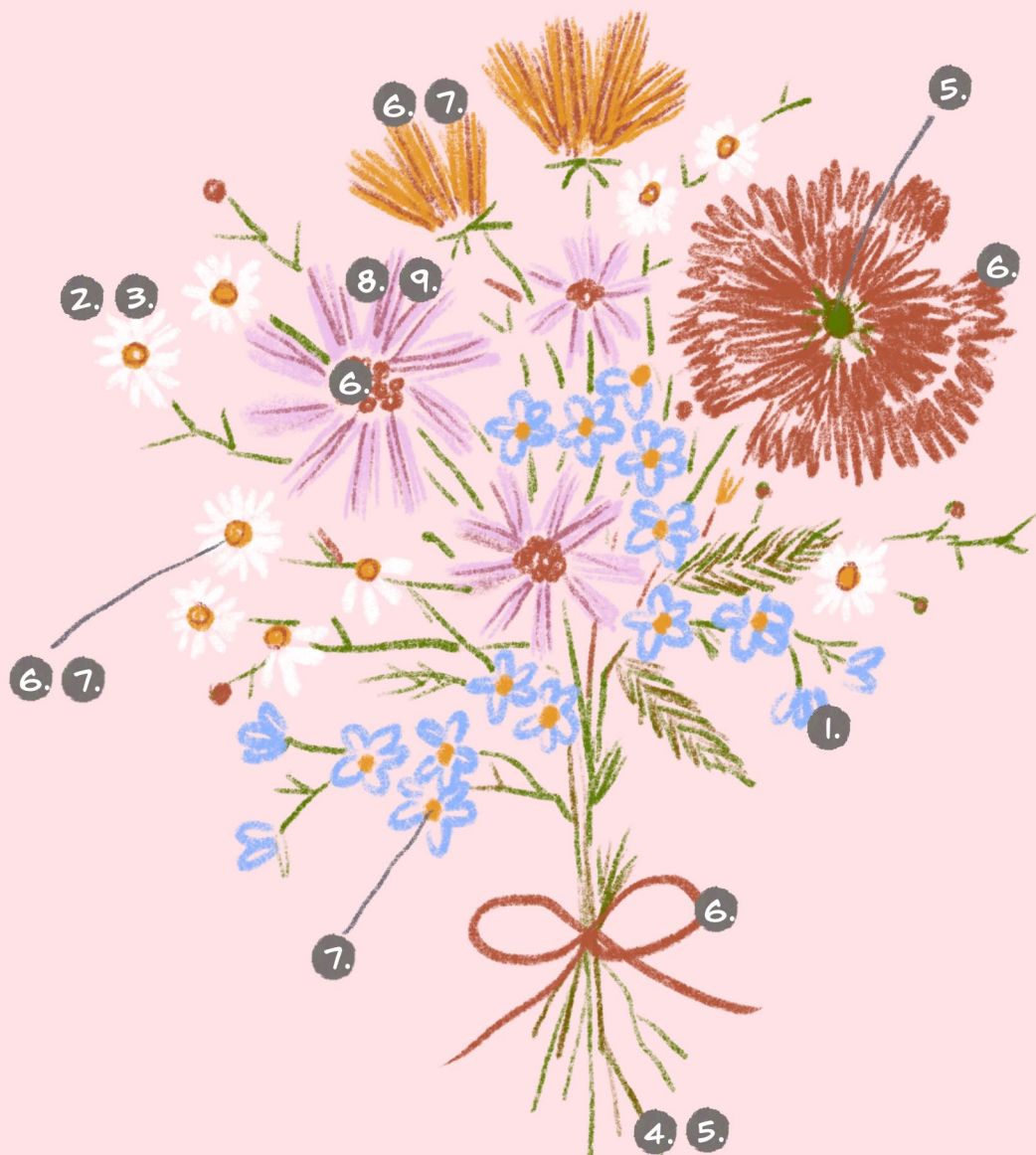


CARBON PAPER



1 SHARP PEN OR PENCIL

THREAD COLOURS

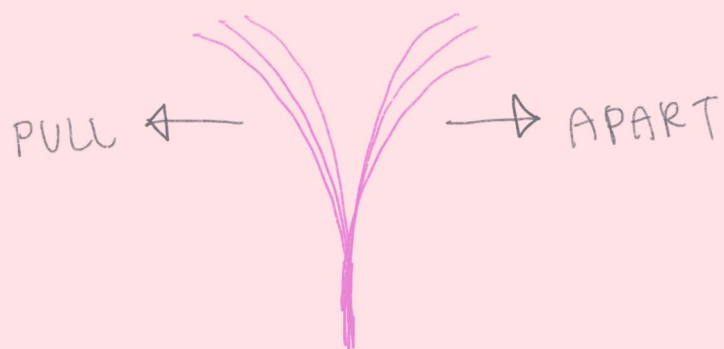


THREAD STRAND

THIS PATTERN USES VARIEGATED THREADS, SO BE PREPARED TO DO SOME MIXING OF THREADS USING THE STATED NUMBER OF STRANDS!

IF NEEDED, PLEASE SPLIT YOUR THREADS BEFORE STARTING THE EMBROIDERY SIMPLY BY PULLING THE YARNS APART!

TIP: TRY WORKING WITH A LENGTH OF 50CM EACH TIME TO AVOID TANGLING



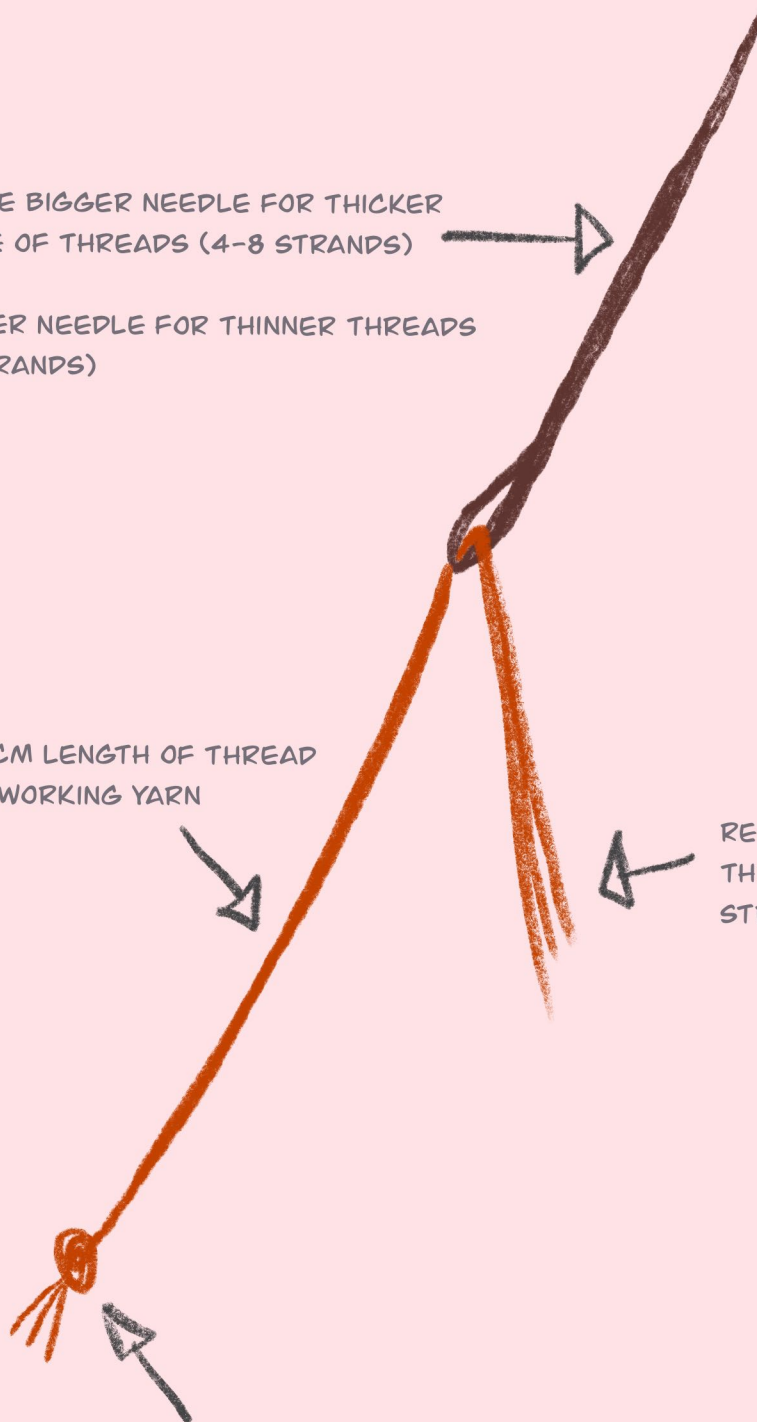
SOME TIPS BEFORE YOU START THE EMBROIDERY!

USE THE BIGGER NEEDLE FOR THICKER
BUNDLE OF THREADS (4-8 STRANDS)

SMALLER NEEDLE FOR THINNER THREADS
(1-3 STRANDS)

CUT ABOUT 50CM LENGTH OF THREAD
EACH TIME AS WORKING YARN

REMEMBER TO USE
THE RECOMMENDED NUMBER
STRANDS



MANUALLY TIE A KNOT AT ONE END

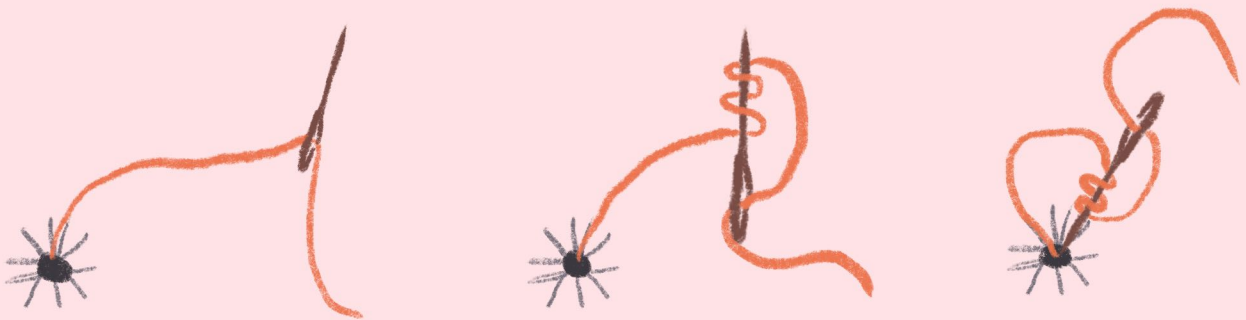
DAISY CENTER



THREAD COLOUR: 6. + 7.

THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS OF EACH COLOUR

STITCH TECHNIQUE: FRENCH KNOT



Step 1. Come out from the point you wish to make the French Knot

Step 2. Use the thread that came out from the fabric and make 2 turns around the needle

Step 3. Place your needle back into (or close to) the point in Step 1

Step 4. Pull your thread all the way through til a knot forms

Tip: At Step 4, while your needle is being pulled from behind, use your finger to pull the thread that is going through the point to gently guide it and prevent tangling

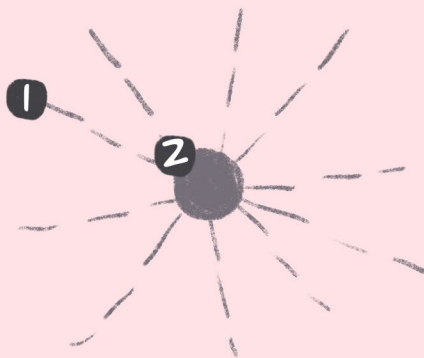
DAISY PETALS



THREAD COLOUR: 2. + 3.

THREAD STRANDS: FULL 6 STRANDS OF EACH COLOUR

STITCH TECHNIQUE: STRAIGHT STITCH



Step 1. Make a simple straight stitch for every petal! Start from the outer petal at point **1**, then head towards the center at point **2**
Nothing fancy for this stitch!

Tip: For a better result, complete the daisy centers (French knot) first before sewing the petals. This way, you have a center point that your petals can be sewn towards to.

BLUE FLOWER CENTER



THREAD COLOUR: 7.

THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS

STITCH TECHNIQUE: FRENCH KNOT



Step 1. Come out from the point you wish to make the French Knot

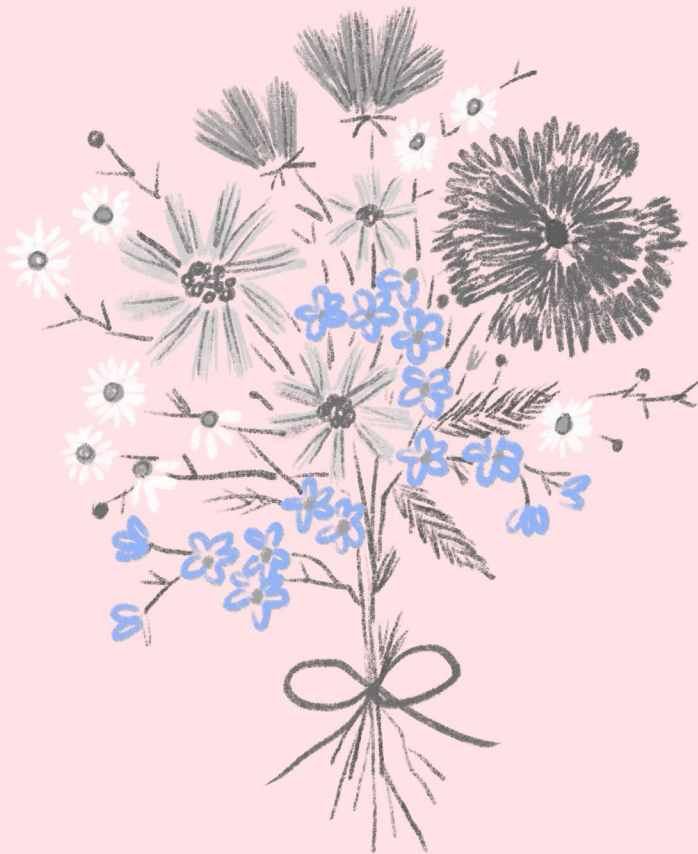
Step 2. Use the thread that came out from the fabric and make 2 turns around the needle

Step 3. Place your needle back into (or close to) the point in Step 1

Step 4. Pull your thread all the way through til a knot forms

Tip: At Step 4, while your needle is being pulled from behind, use your finger to pull the thread that is going through the point to gently guide it and prevent tangling

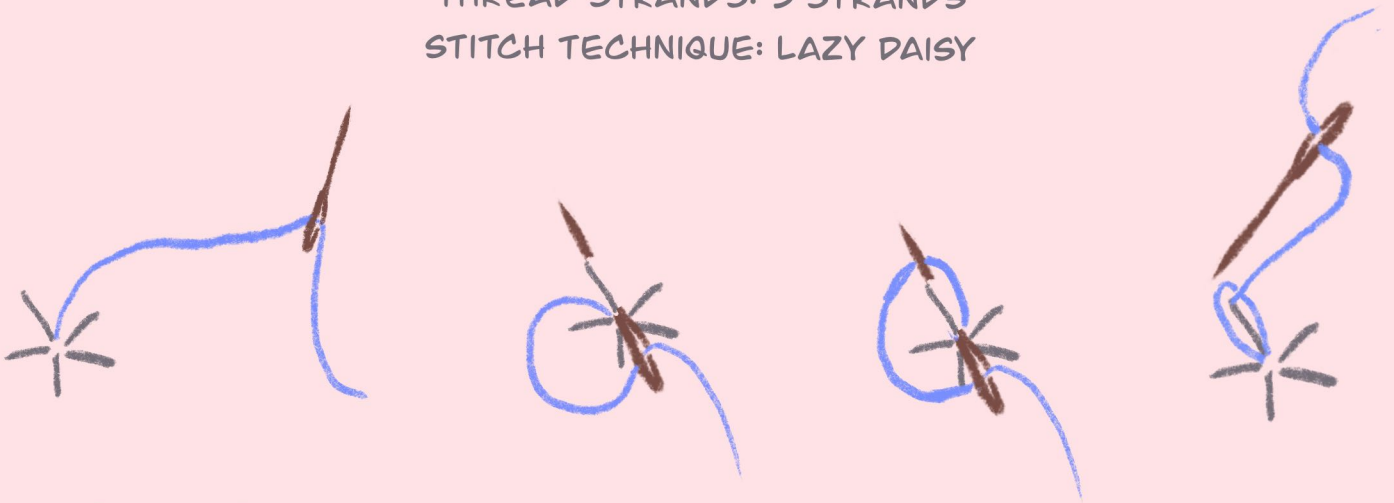
BLUE FLOWER PETALS



THREAD COLOUR: 1.

THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS

STITCH TECHNIQUE: LAZY DAISY



Step 1. Come out from a point near the center of the flower

Step 2. Position your needle under the same point in Step 1 and out from the tip of the drawn petal

Step 3. Using the thread that comes out from the fabric, make loop behind the needle

Step 4. Pull your needle gently all the way through til a petal is formed and stitch back into the fabric just above the petal tip

Note: Repeat Step 1 - 4 for every petal until the daisy is complete

YELLOW TULIPS



THREAD COLOUR: 6. + 7. + 3. (OPTIONAL)
THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS OF EACH COLOUR
STITCH TECHNIQUE: SATIN STITCH



Step 1. Make a long stitch from ❶ to ❷

Step 2. Then make a short stitch from ❸ to ❹

Step 3. Continue alternating long and short stitches until flower is complete

Tip: Make your stitches as close to each other as possible

Note: Observe the converging stitches towards the center of the flower

PINK FLOWER CENTER



THREAD COLOUR: 6.

THREAD STRANDS: FULL 6 STRANDS

STITCH TECHNIQUE: FRENCH KNOT



Step 1. Come out from the point you wish to make the French Knot

Step 2. Use the thread that came out from the fabric and make 2 turns around the needle

Step 3. Place your needle back into (or close to) the point in Step 1

Step 4. Pull your thread all the way through til a knot forms

Tip: Make as many knots as you like for the center until a nice cluster has formed

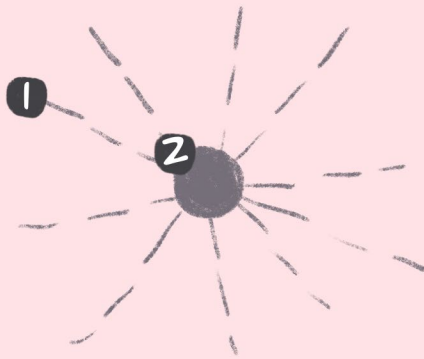
PINK FLOWER PETALS



THREAD COLOUR: 8. + 9.

THREAD STRANDS: FULL 6 STRANDS OF EACH COLOUR

STITCH TECHNIQUE: STRAIGHT STITCH



Step 1. Make a simple straight stitch for every petal! Start from the outer petal at point **1**, then head towards the center at point **2**
Nothing fancy for this stitch!

Tip: For a better result, complete the flower centers (French knot) first before sewing the petals. This way, you have a center point that your petals can be sewn towards to.

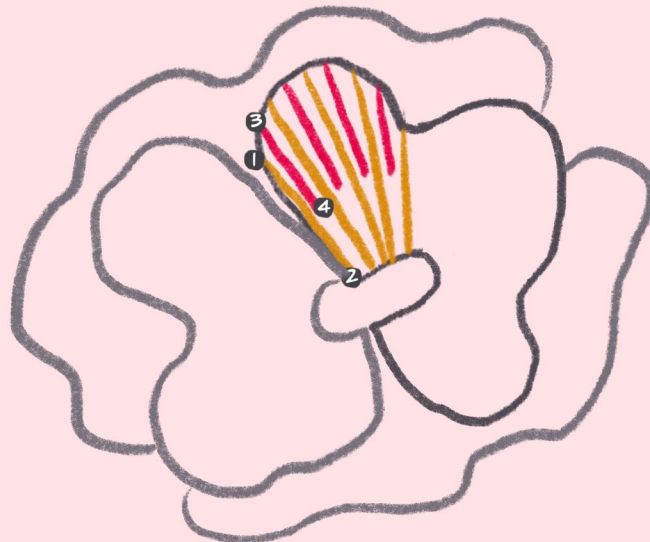
BROWN FLOWER



THREAD COLOUR: 6.

THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS

STITCH TECHNIQUE: SATIN STITCH



Step 1. Make a long stitch from ❶ to ❷

Step 2. Then make a short stitch from ❸ to ❹

Step 3. Continue alternating long and short stitches until flower is complete

Tip: Make your stitches as close to each other as possible

Note: Observe the converging stitches towards the center of the flower

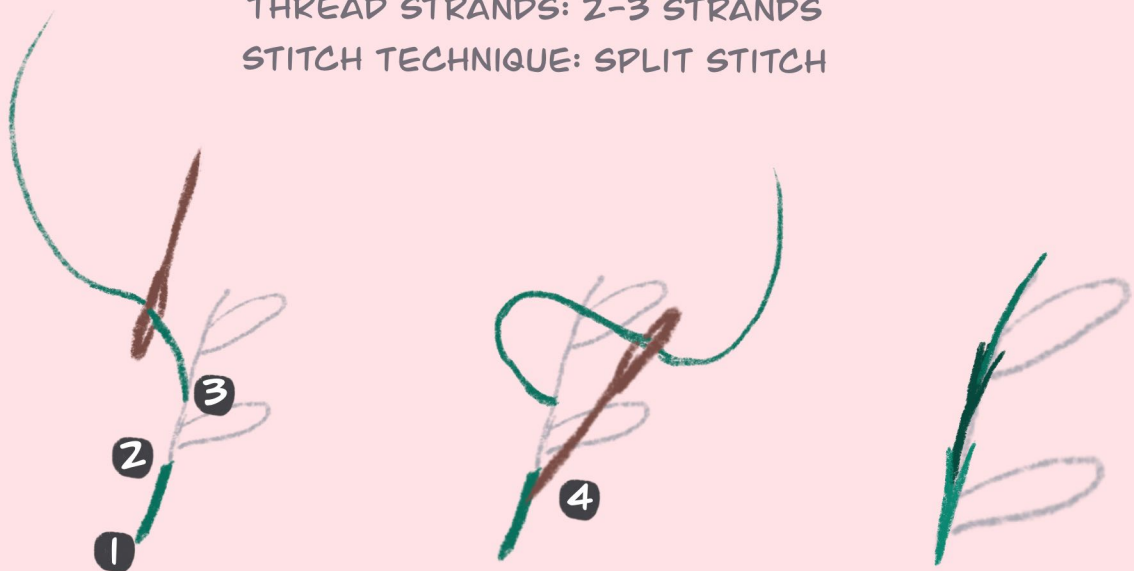
STEMS & BRANCHES



THREAD COLOUR: 4. OR 5.

THREAD STRANDS: 2-3 STRANDS

STITCH TECHNIQUE: SPLIT STITCH



Step 1. Make a stitch from **1** to **2** (about 0.5cm long)

Step 2. Come out at **3** about 0.5cm away from **2**

Step 3. Stitch back into the previous stitch at **4** creating a split between the yarns

Step 4. Repeat Step 2 - 3 til all stems and branches are done

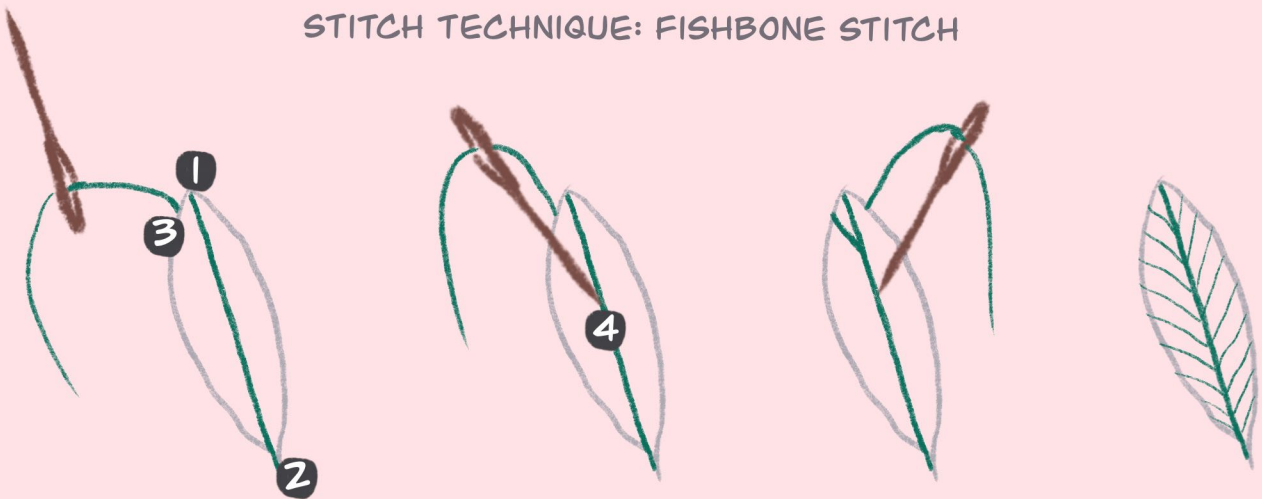
LEAVES



THREAD COLOUR: 4. + 5.

THREAD STRANDS: 3 STRANDS OF EACH COLOUR

STITCH TECHNIQUE: FISHBONE STITCH



Step 1. Make a stitch from **1** to **2** in the center of the leaf

Step 2. Come out at **3** on the left side of the leaf

Step 3. Stitch into the center yarn to create a diagonal line at **4**

Step 4. Repeat Step 2 - 3 til your leaf is complete with the fishbone texture

Note: Make sure your diagonal lines are parallel to one another

RIBBON



THREAD COLOUR: 6. (OR ANY TWINE YOU HAVE)

THREAD STRANDS: FULL 6 STRANDS



Step 1. Tie up a separate ribbon

Step 2. Place over the embroidered branches and stitch the center of the ribbon securely onto the fabric

And your bouquet is complete!
