



## **Errant Ball Policy**

St. Marys Golf & Country Club is not responsible or liable for property damage or personal injuries arising out of errant golf balls. Errant shots are a part of the game, and it is impossible to eliminate the inherent risks associated with the game of golf. However, St. Marys Golf & Country Club is committed to safety, good sportsmanship, and cooperation, and as such has developed the following guidelines to minimize errant shots and to assist affected parties in identifying the responsible golfer who hit the errant shot.

Golfers are expected to exercise the highest degree of sportsmanship, etiquette, caution, and consideration of others – refraining from horseplay, carelessness or reckless behaviour always.

In the event of property damage or personal injury, an employee of the golf course may assist the injured party in trying to identify the golfer who struck the errant shot if the employee is able to. However, the injured party cannot be disruptive or discourteous to facility patrons or staff.

All property damage, whether intentional or not is to be reported to the Pro Shop upon the completion of the round or earlier.
