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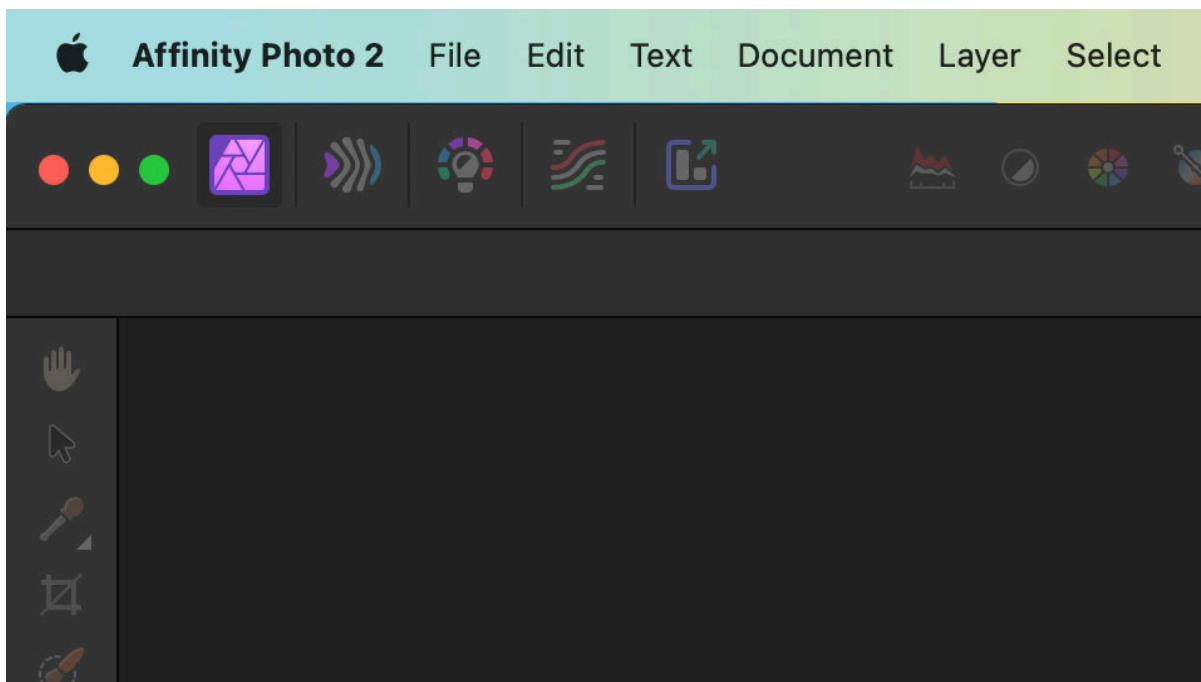
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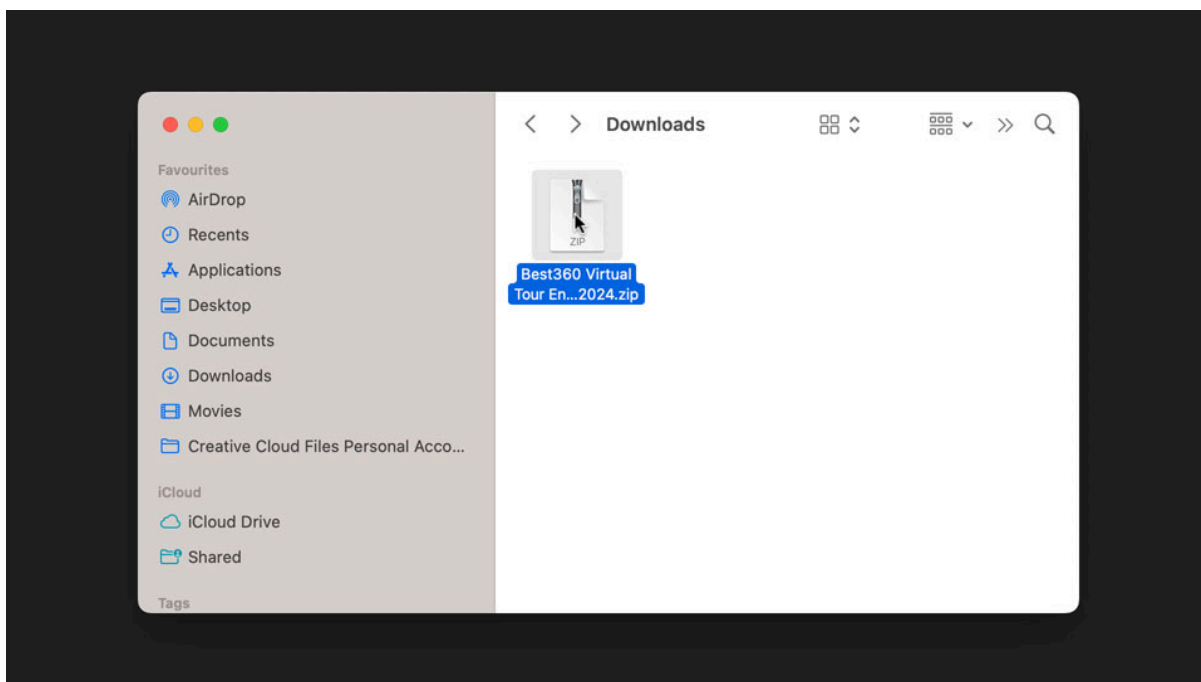
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Prepare Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX for installation

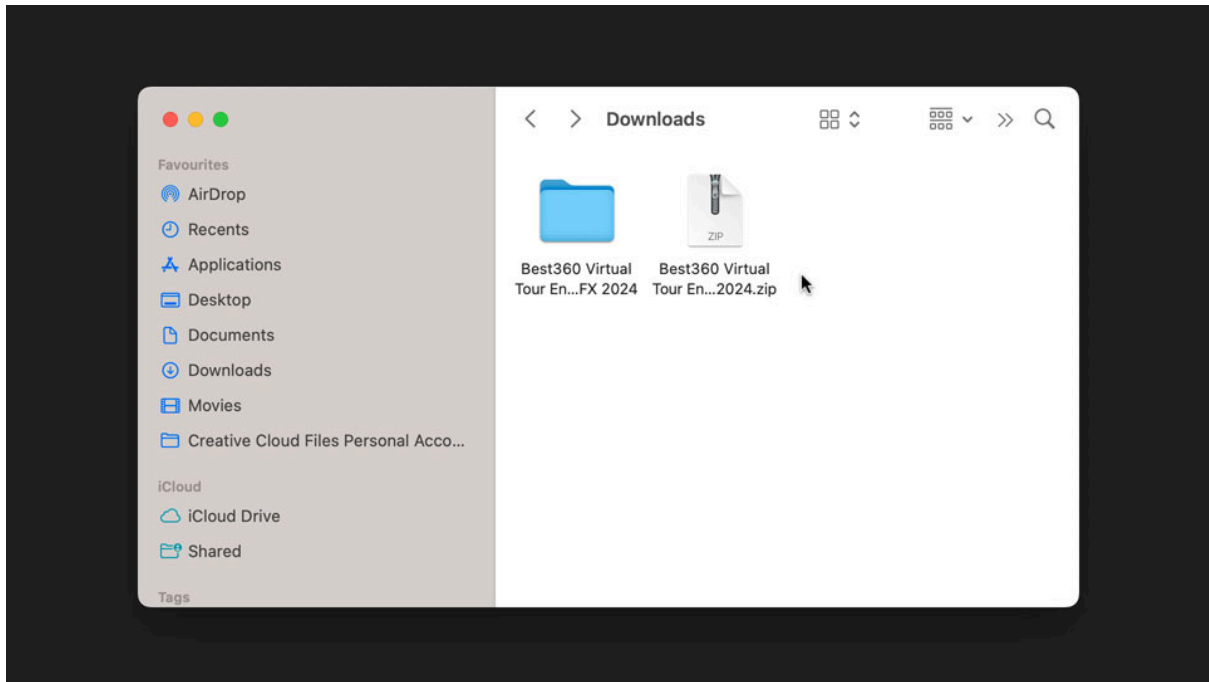
Open Affinity Photo. Please make sure you are updated to the latest version.



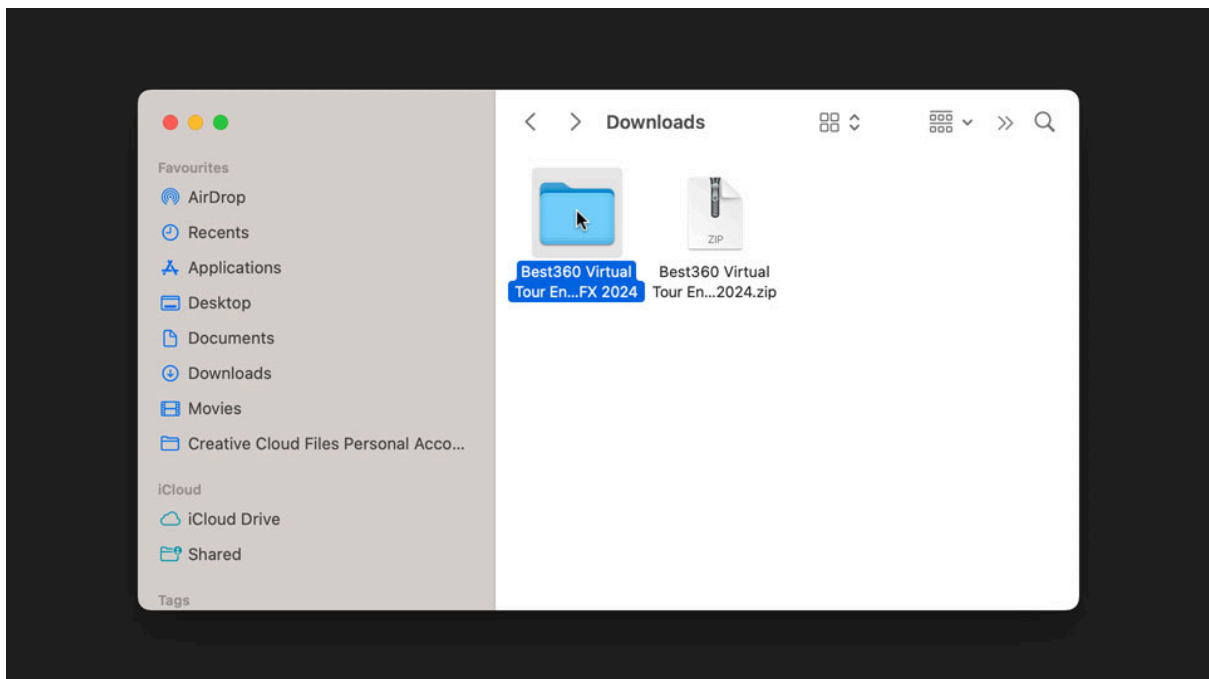
Download the Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX zip folder and double click it.



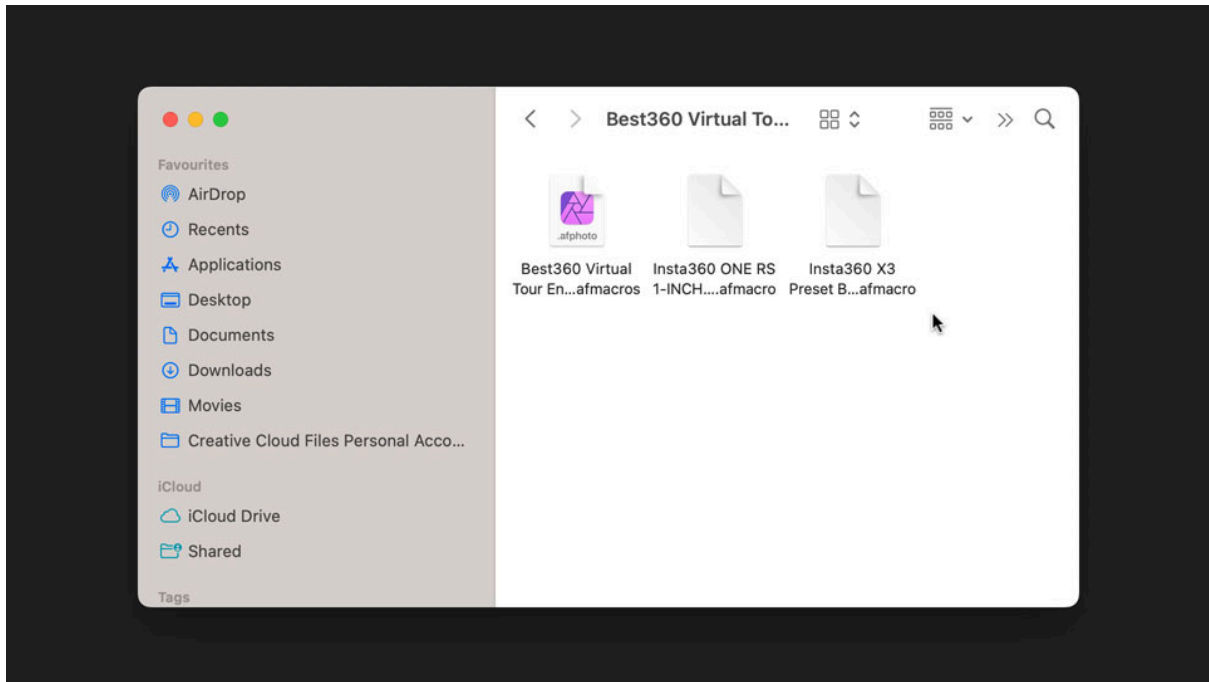
A folder will appear.



Double click the folder to open it.

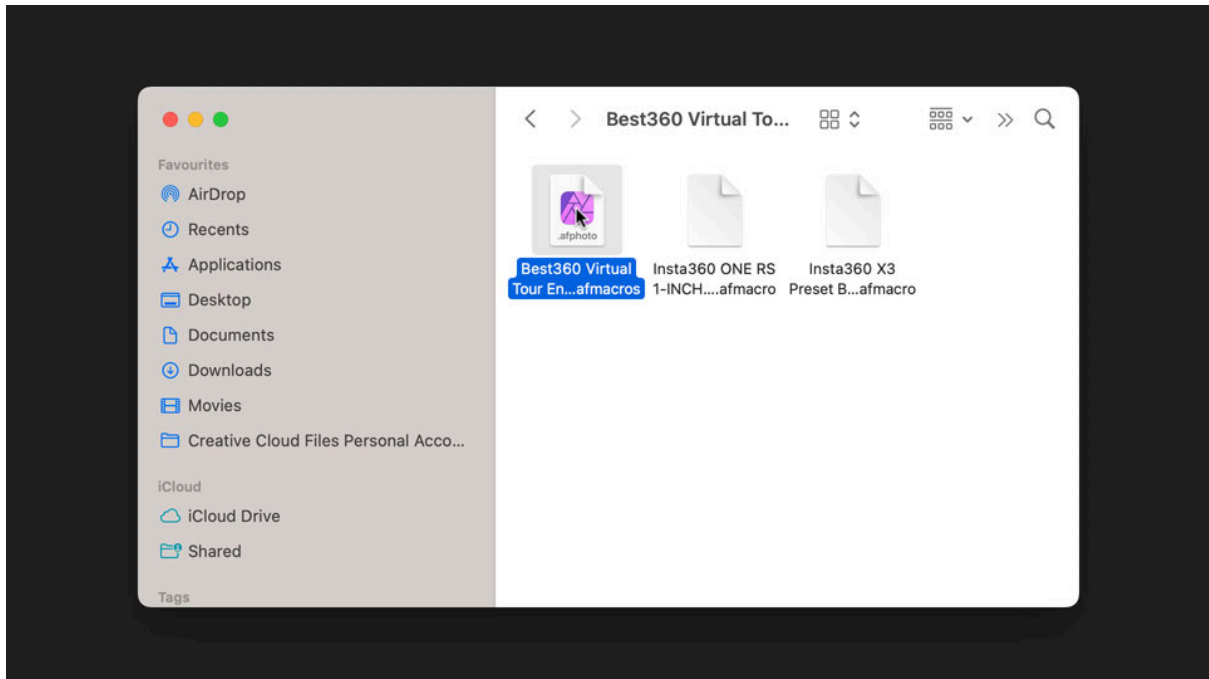


There will be 3 files. A .afmacro file and two .afmacro files.

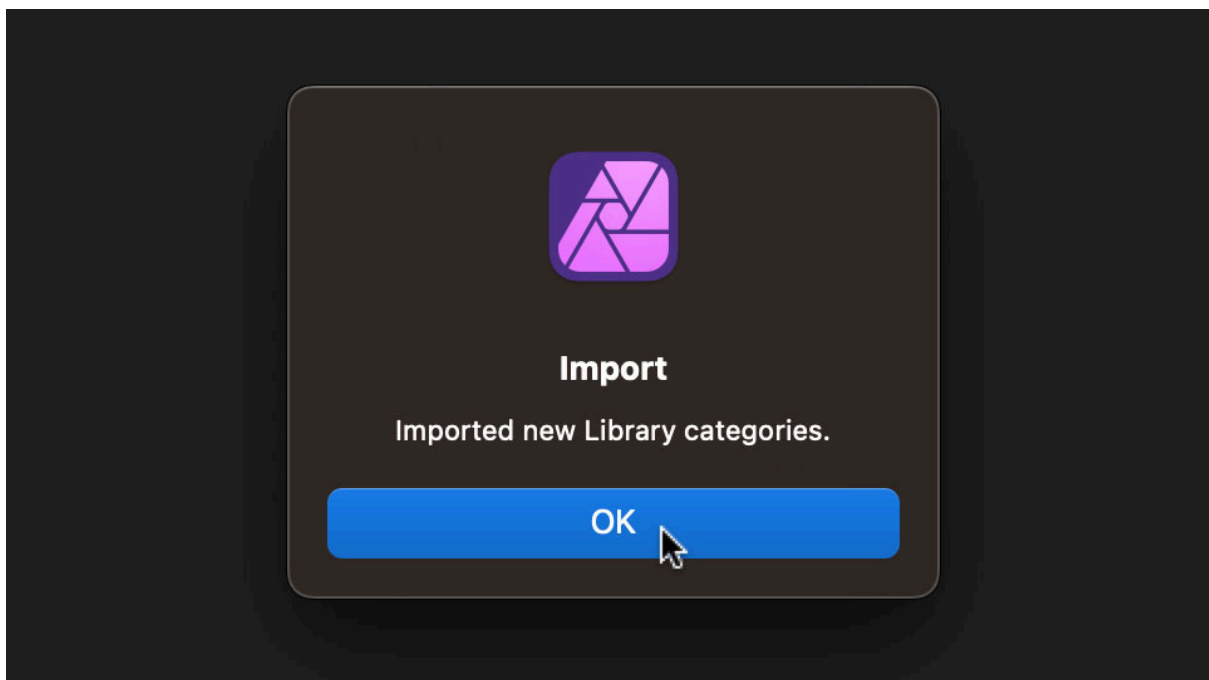


Install Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX (Mac)

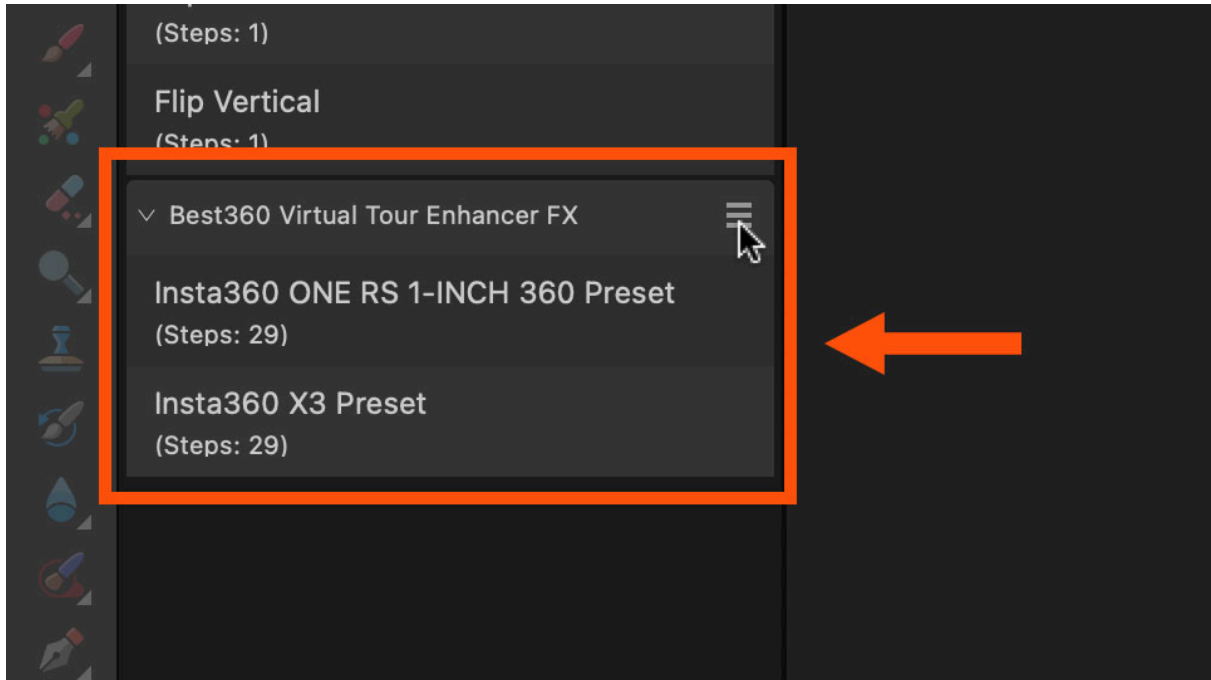
Double click the .afmacro file.



Click OK.

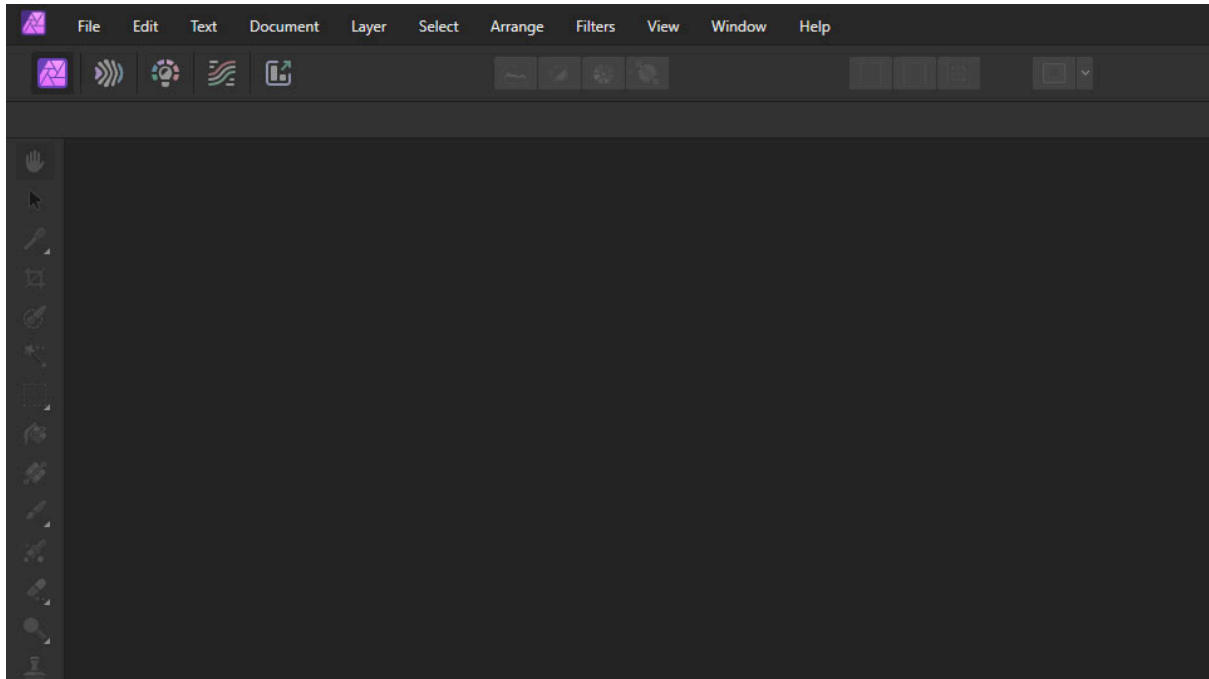


The Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX is now installed and ready to use.

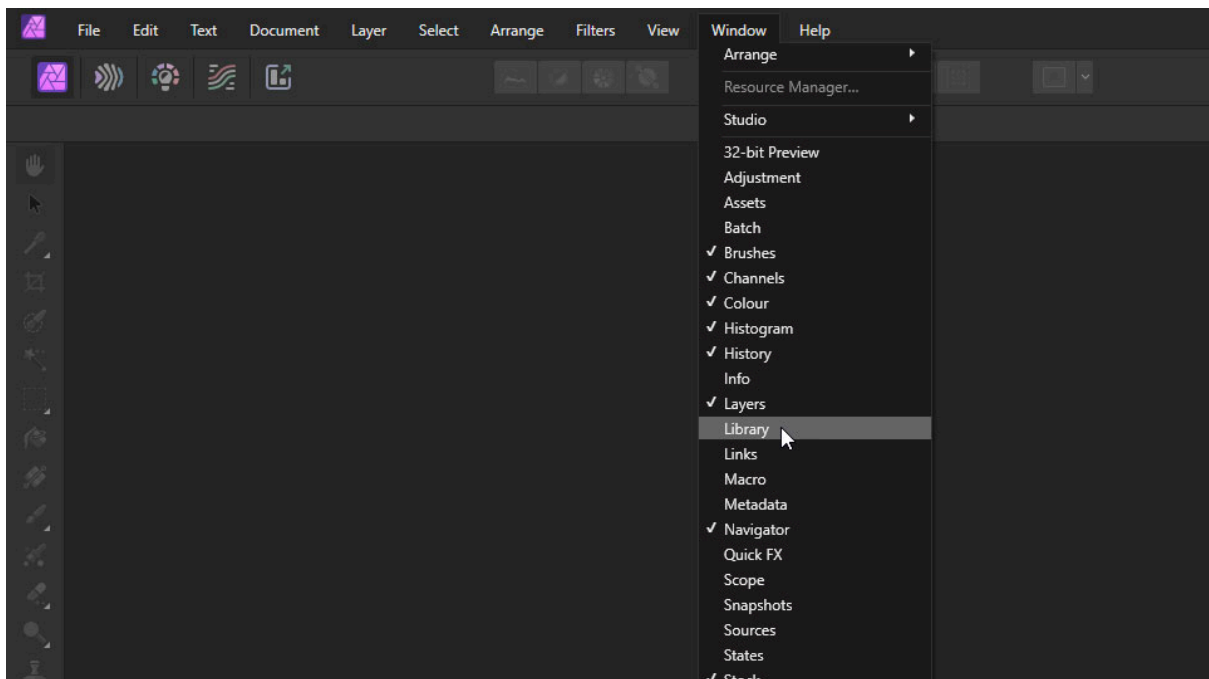


Install Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX (Windows) Method 1

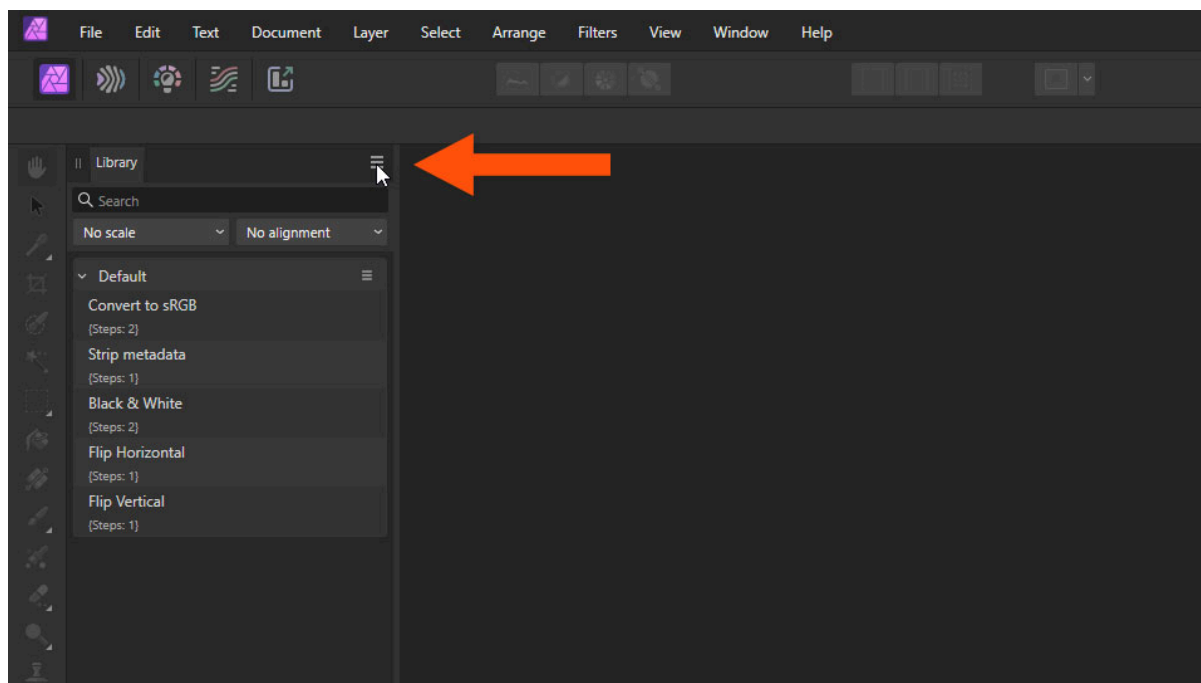
Open Affinity Photo 2.



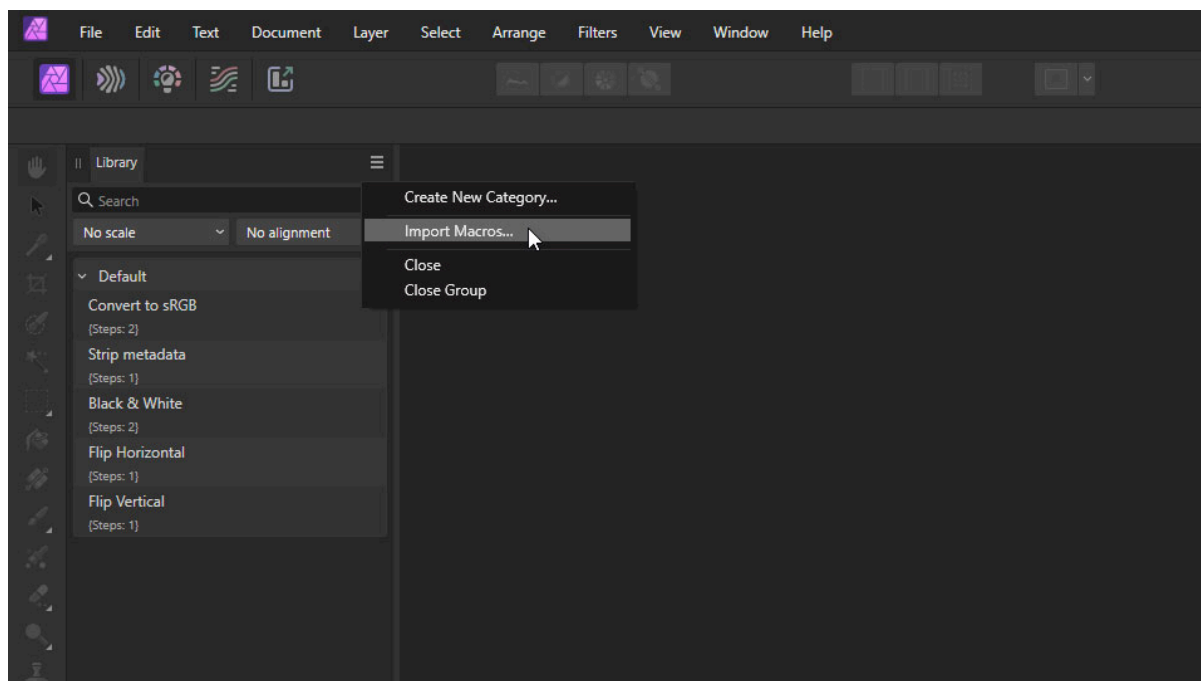
Go to Window in the top navigation bar and click Library.



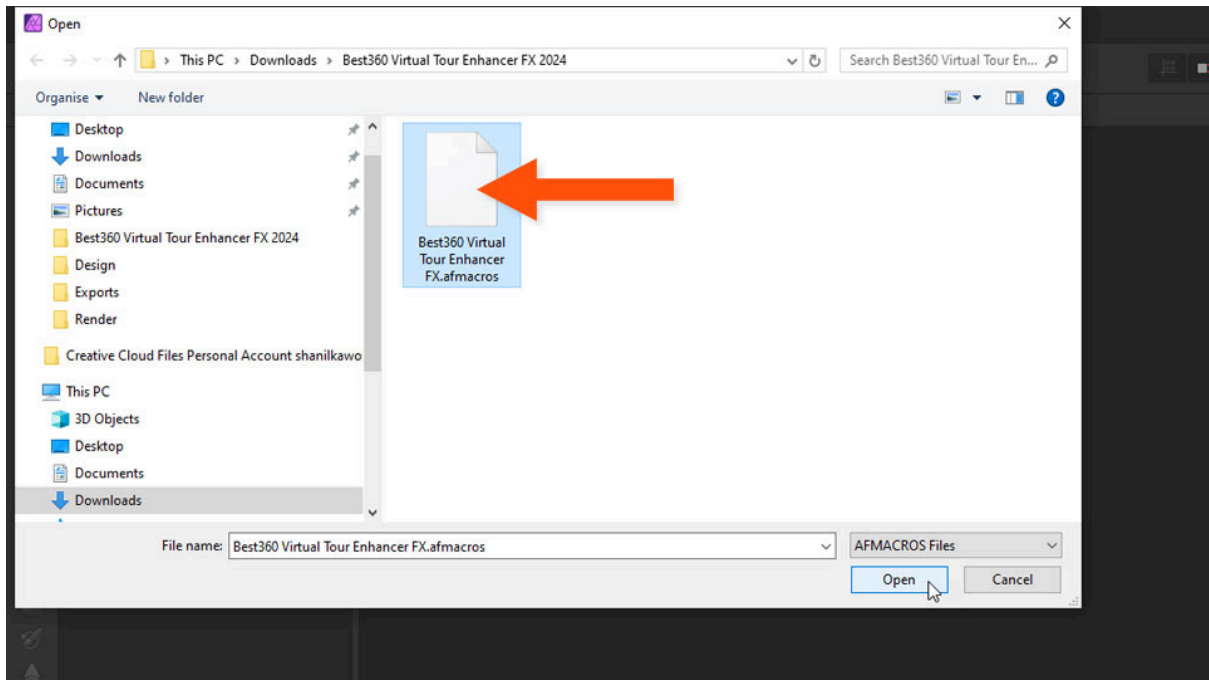
Open the Library menu.



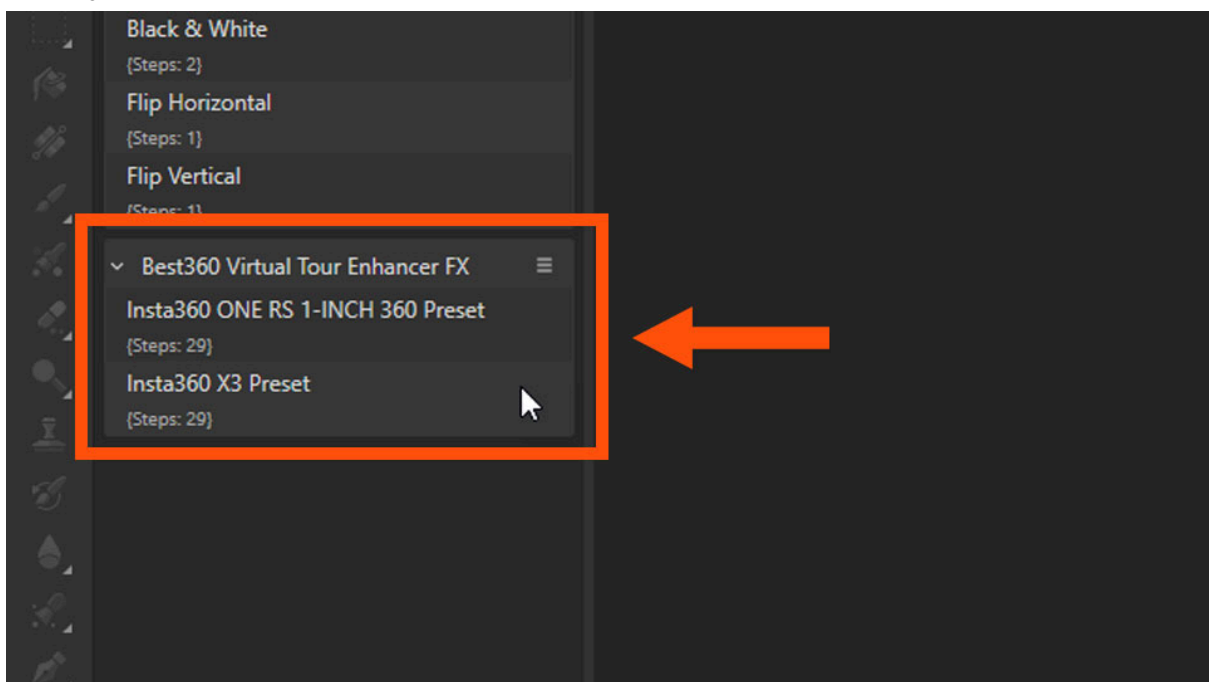
Click Import Macros.



Locate the Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX folder. Select the .afmacros file. Click Open.



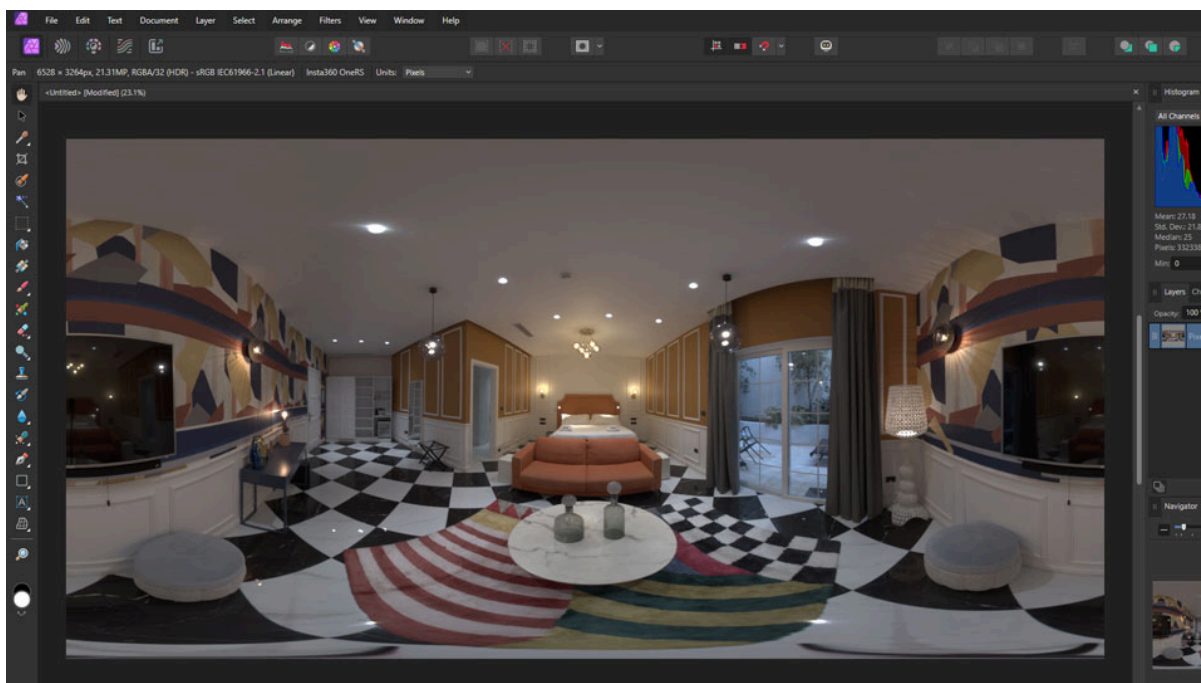
The Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX is now installed and ready to use.



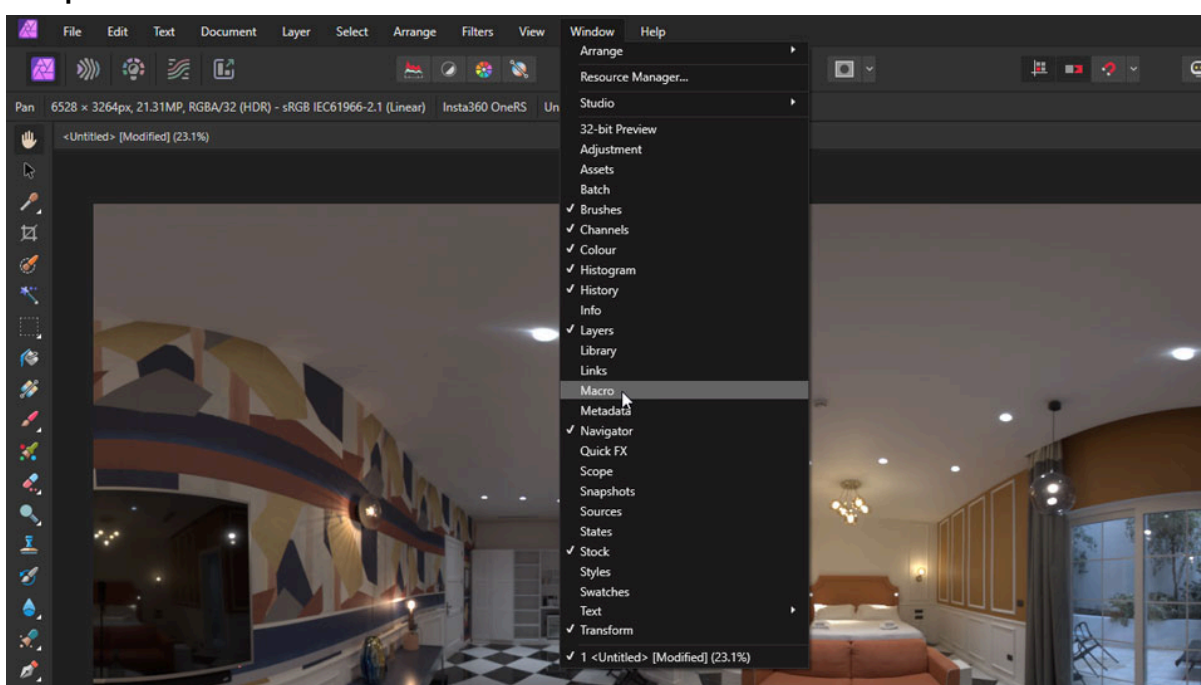
Install Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX (Windows) Method 2

If you experience abnormal results with the Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX, then try this installation method instead.

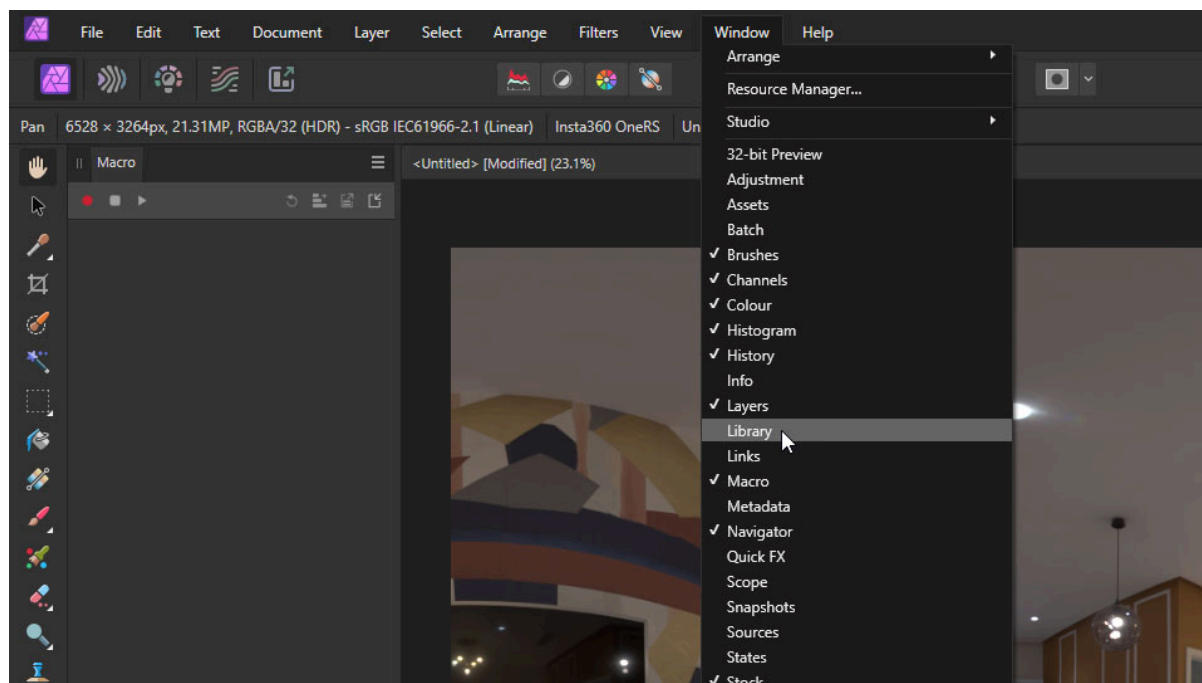
Load a temporary 360 photo into Affinity Photo 2.



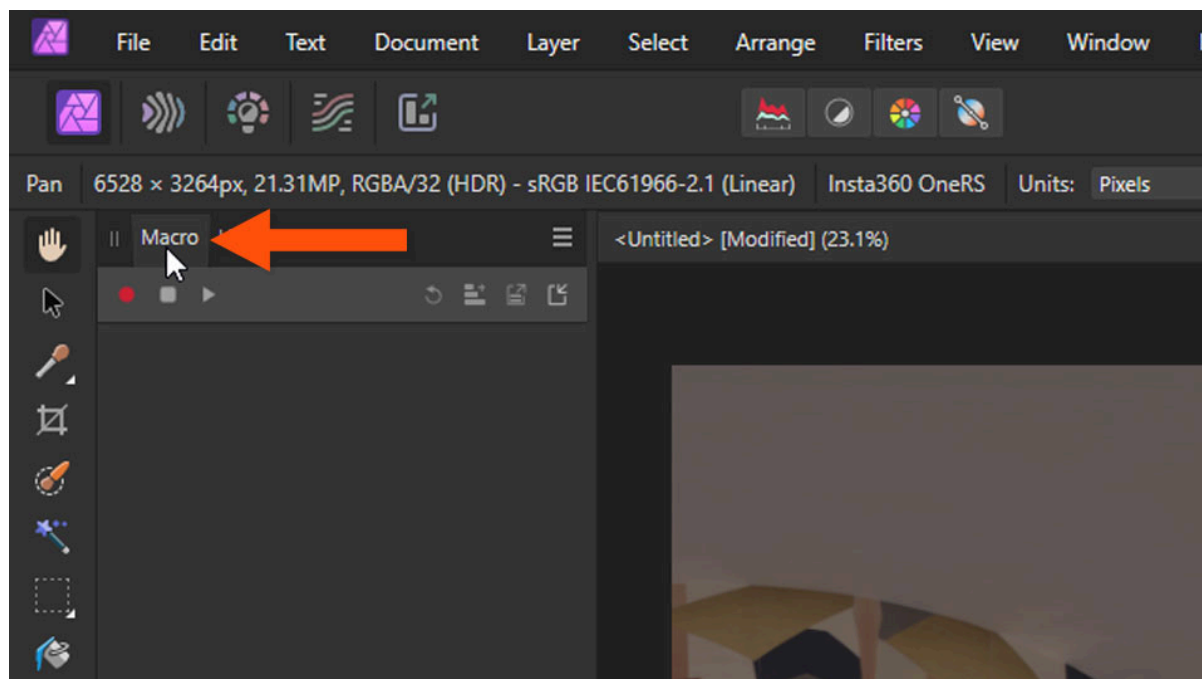
Go to Window in the top navigation bar. Click Macro in the dropdown.



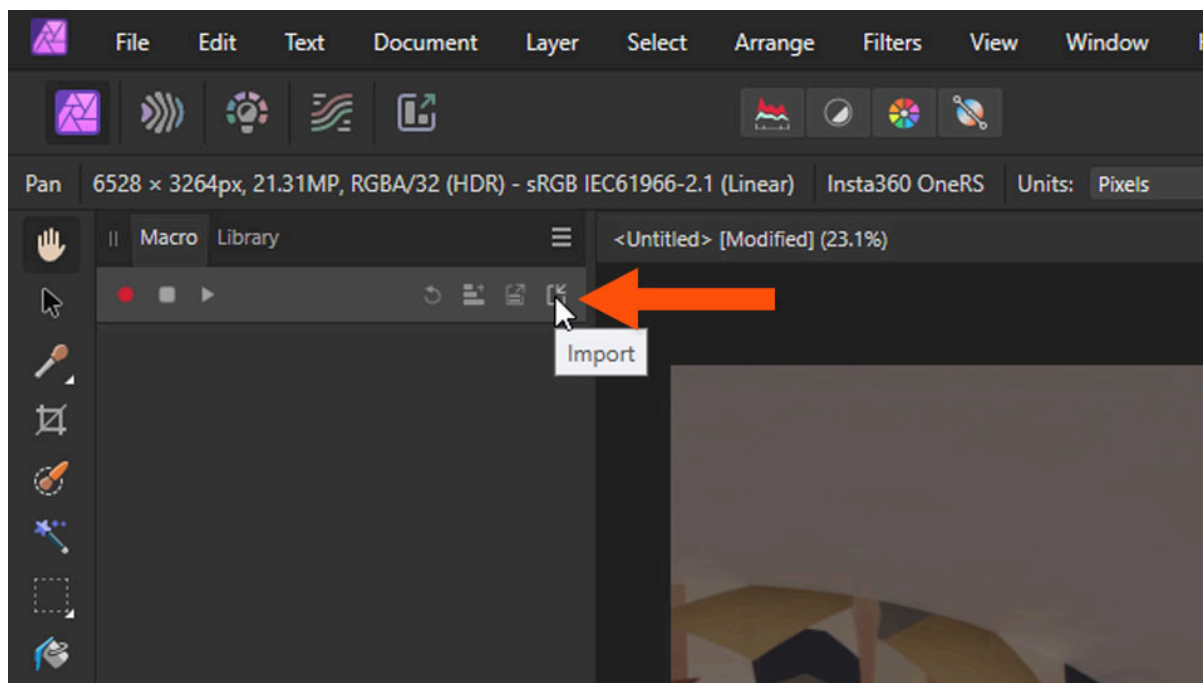
Go to Window and click Library in the dropdown.



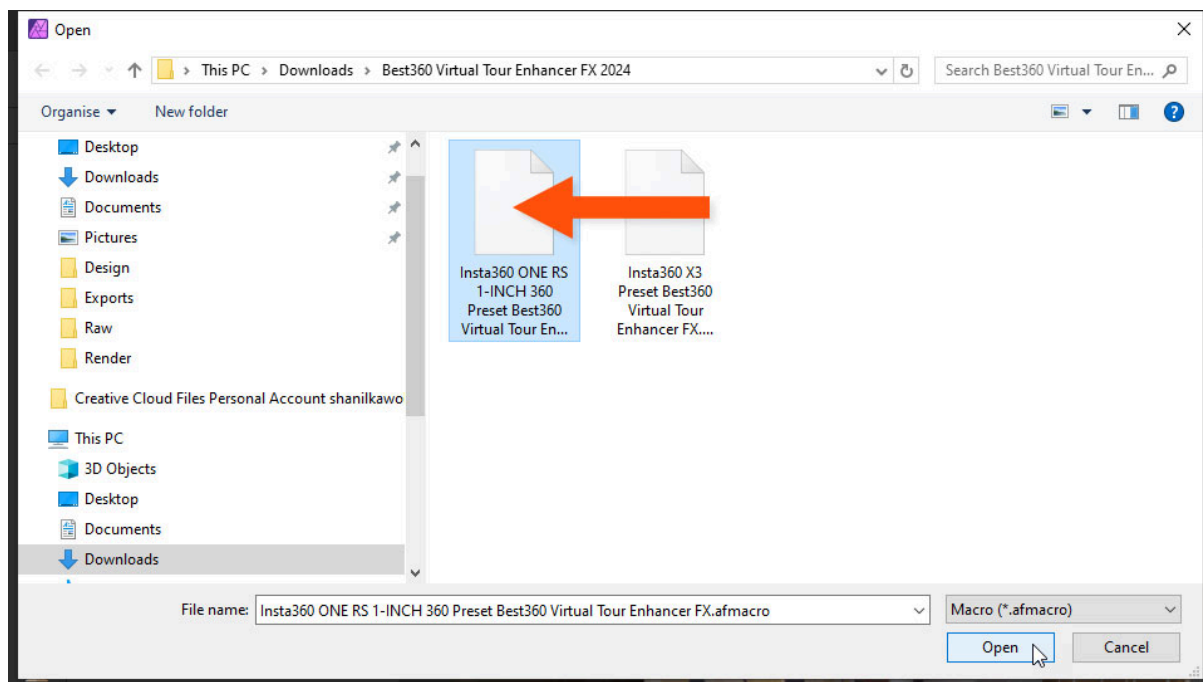
Click the Macro tab.



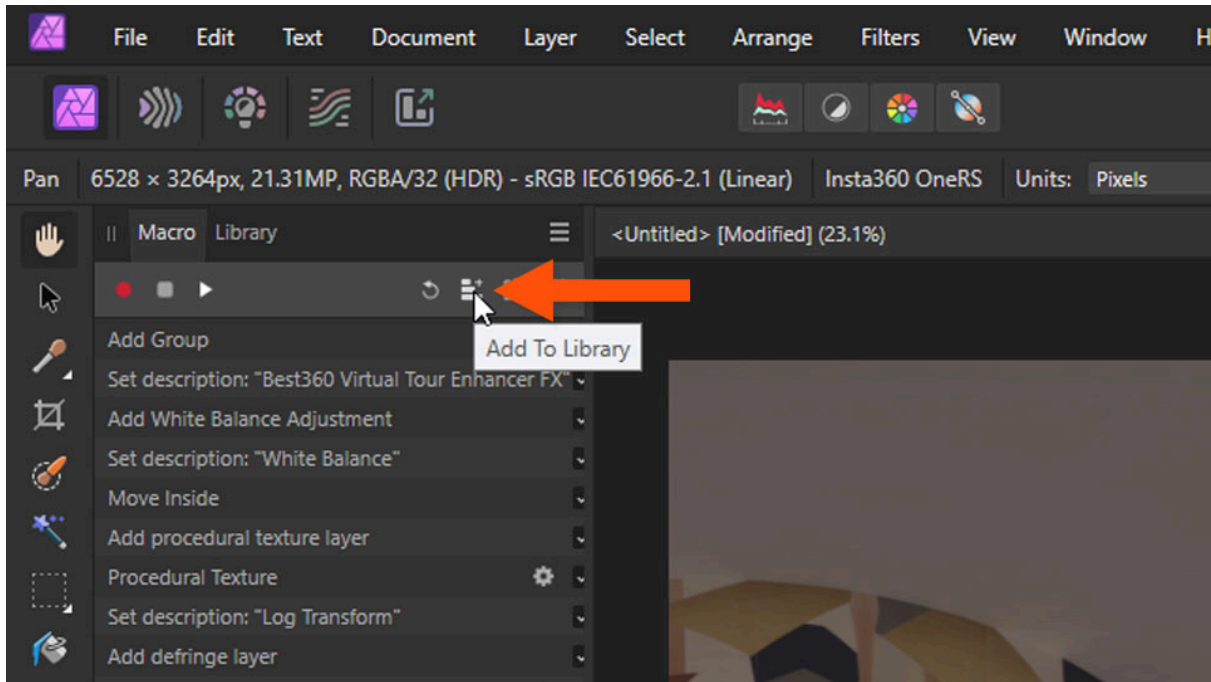
Click Import.



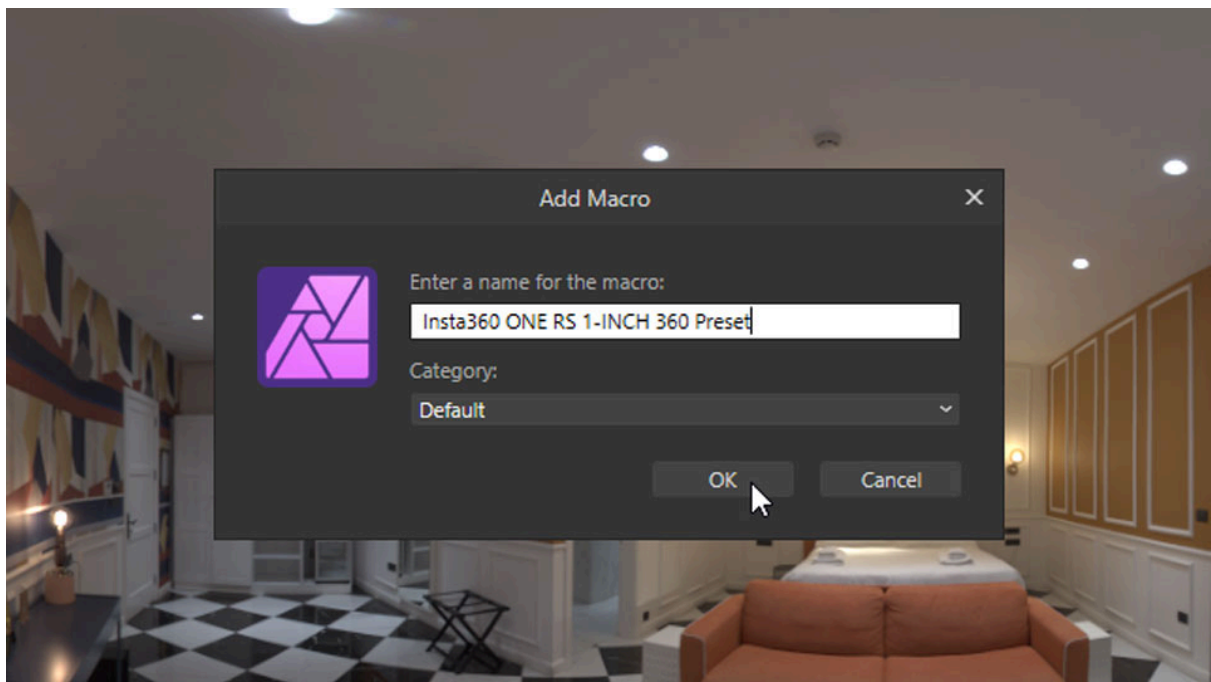
Locate the Best360 Virtual Tour Enhancer FX folder. Select a .afmacro preset file. Click Open.



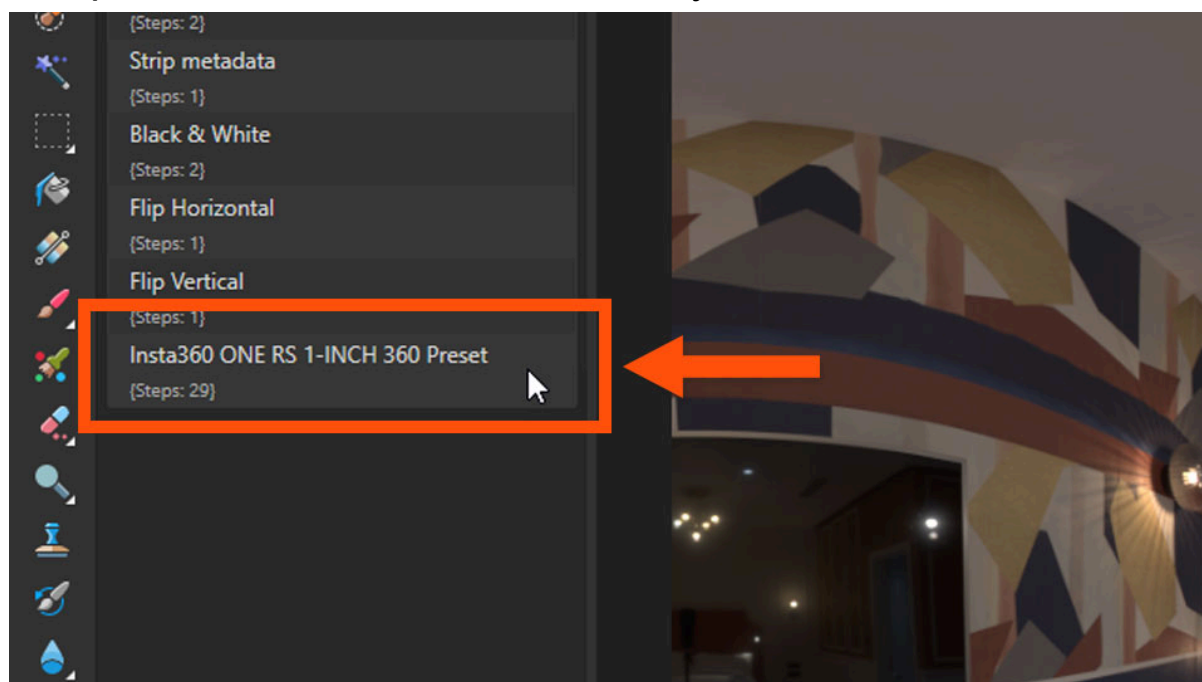
Click Add To Library.



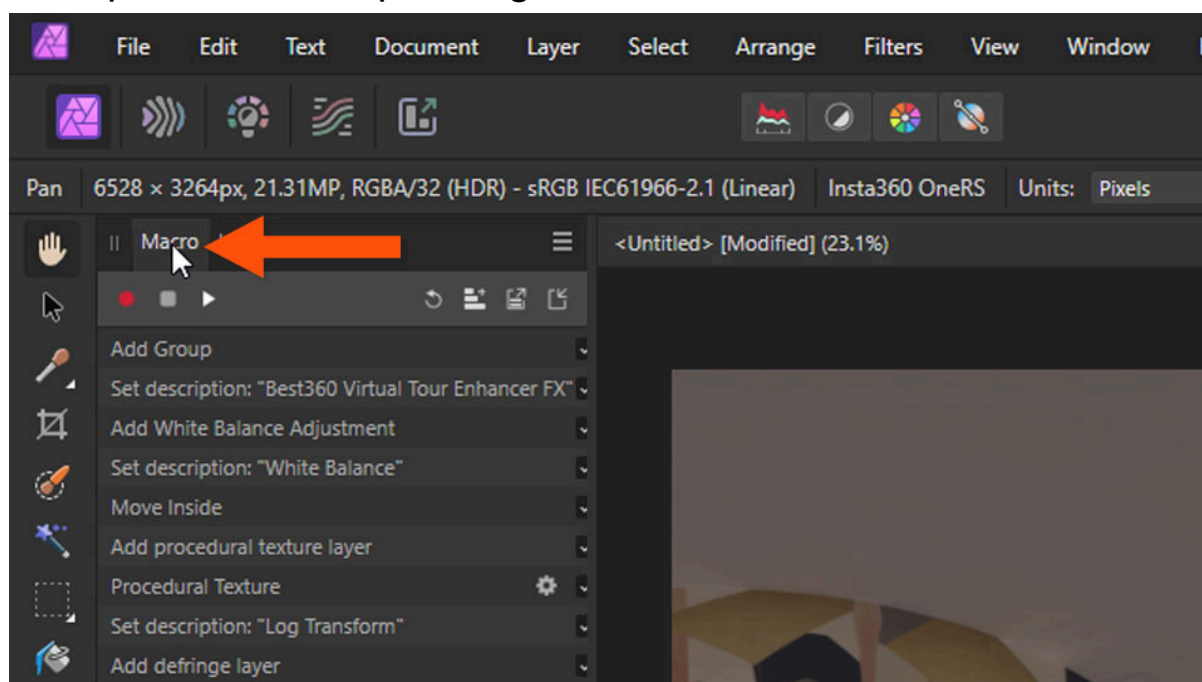
Enter the preset name. Click OK.



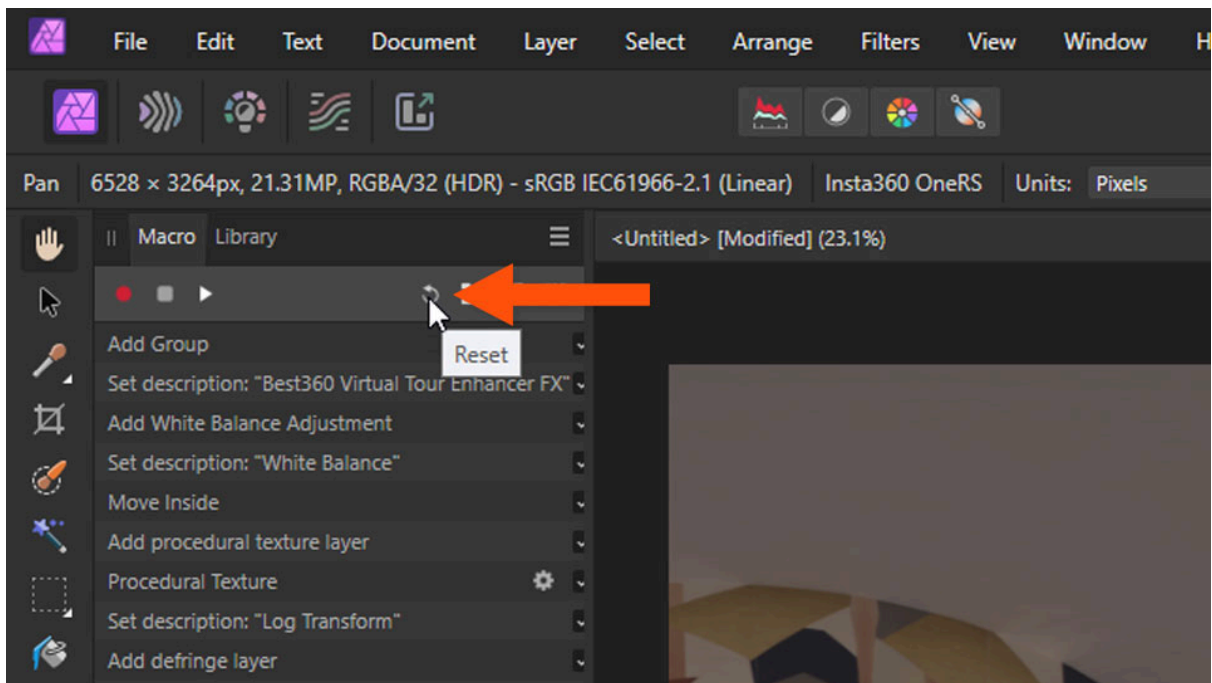
The preset is now installed and ready to use.



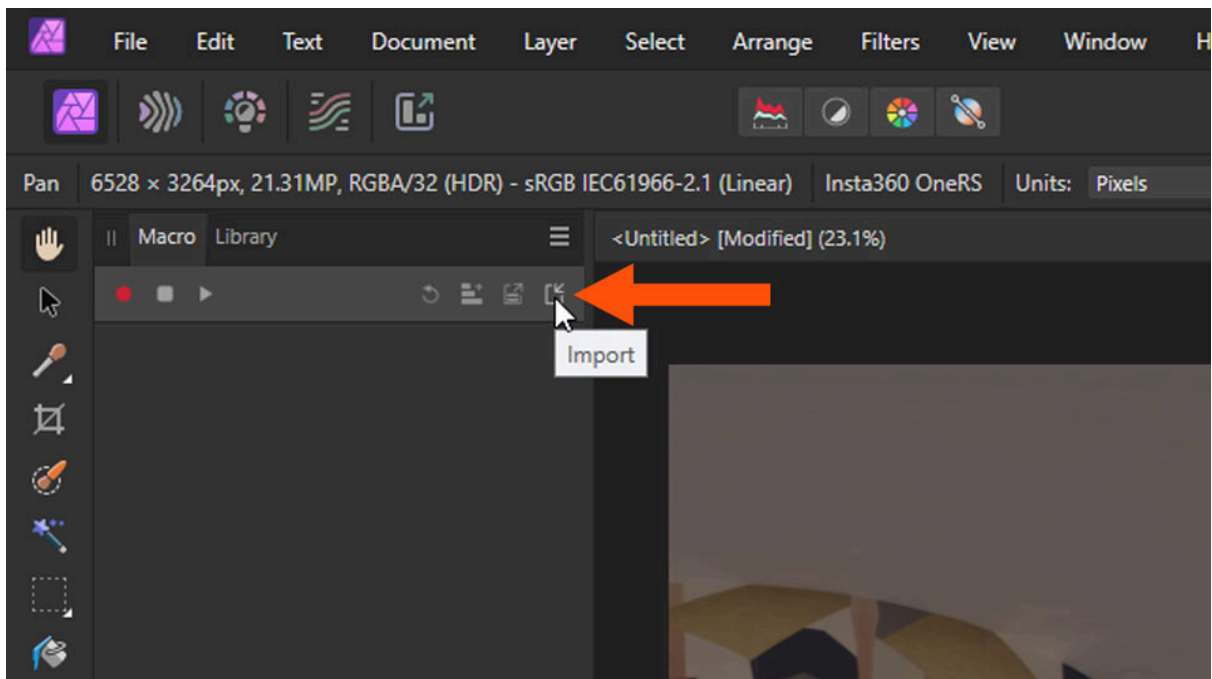
To import a second preset go to the Macro tab.



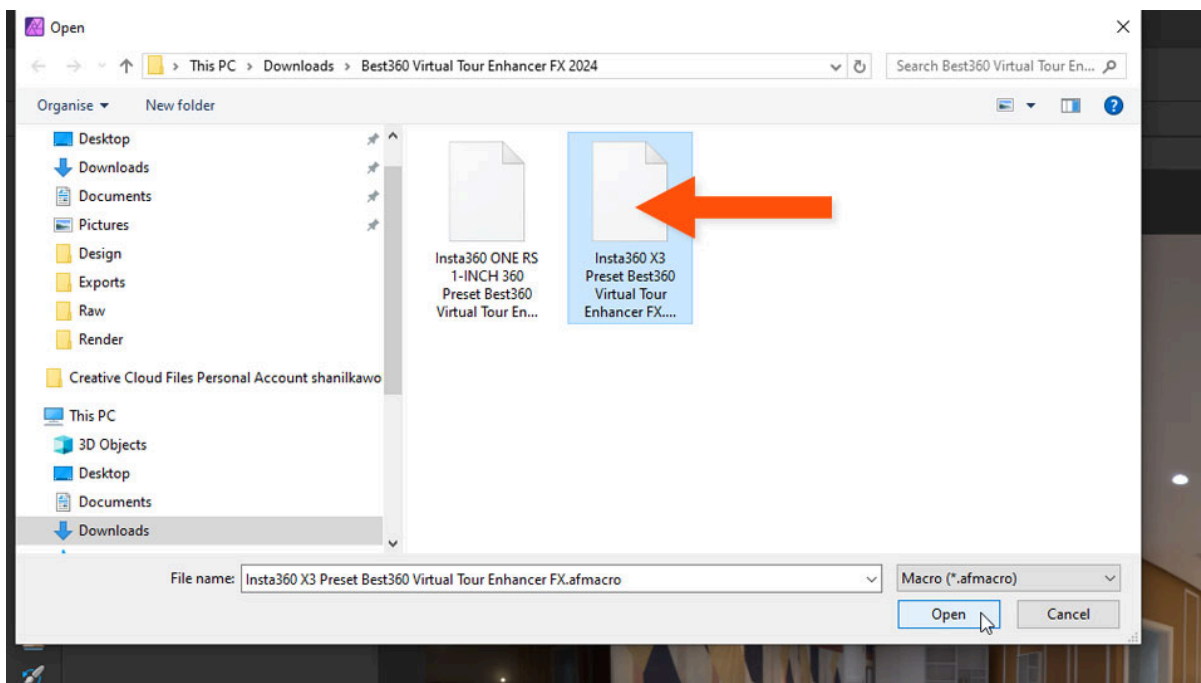
Click Reset.



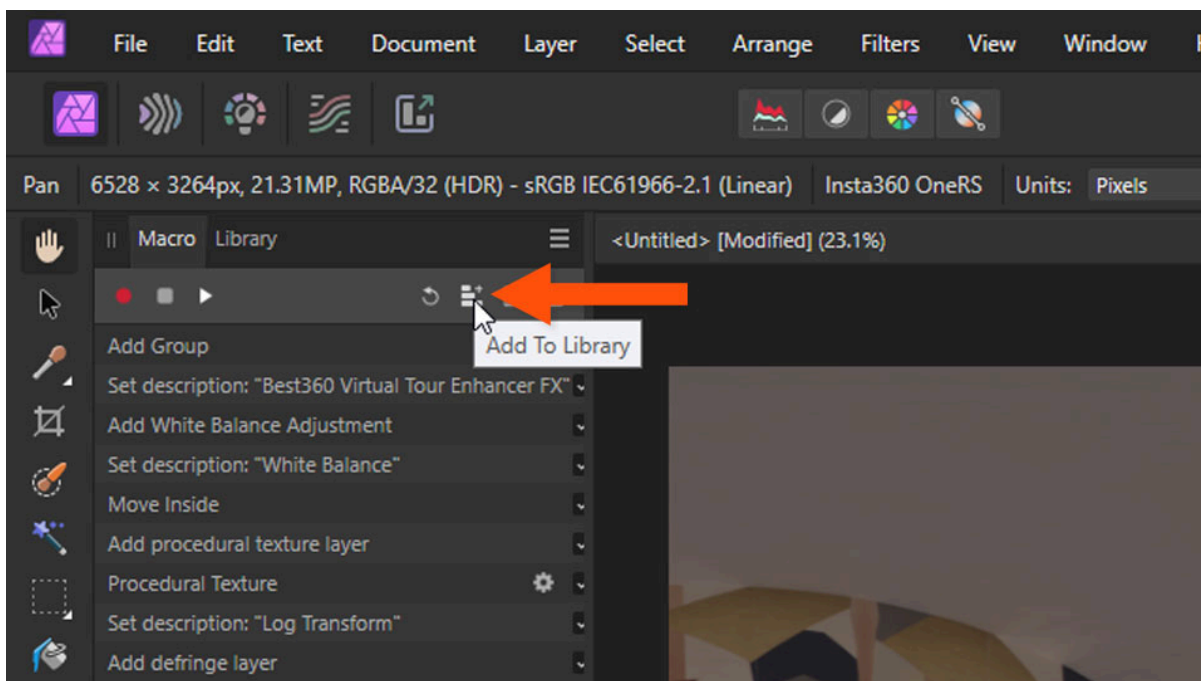
Click Import.



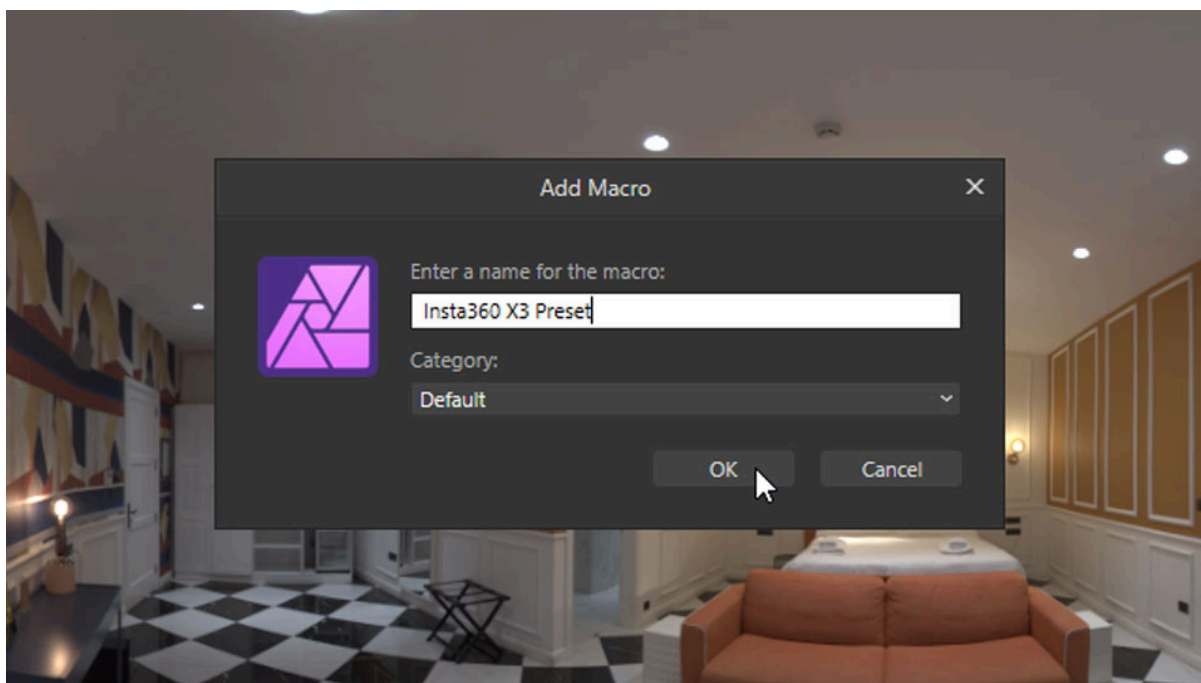
Select the second preset .afmacro file. Click Open.

Rename the preset. Click OK.

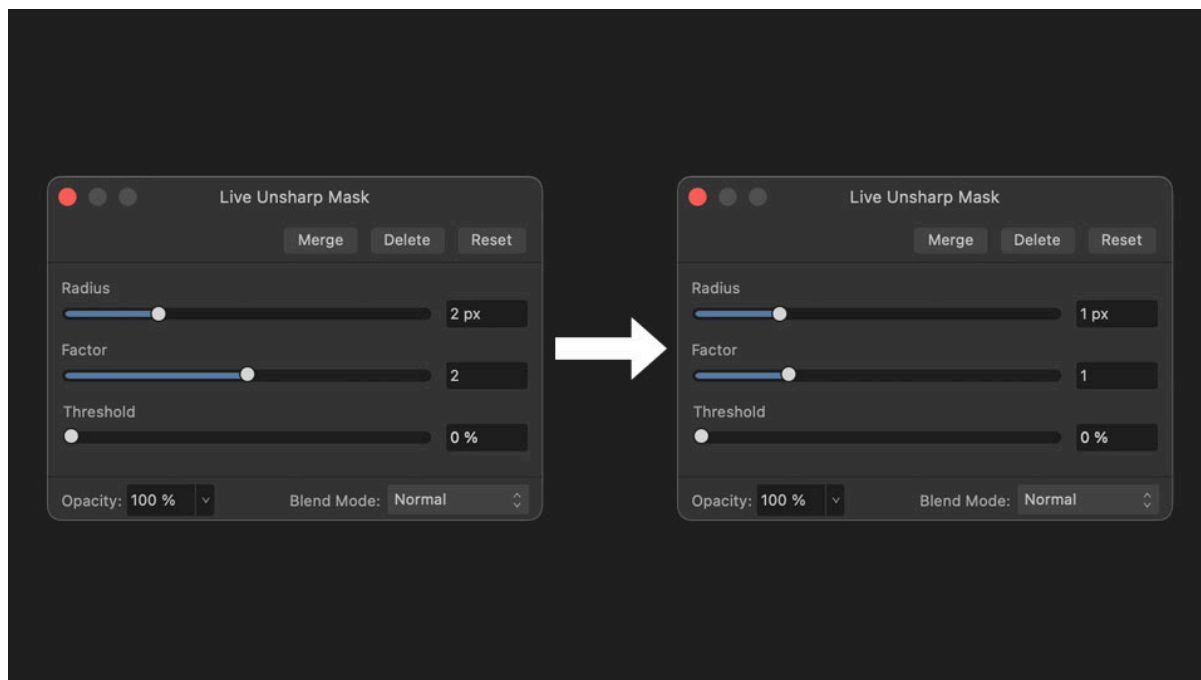

Troubleshooting

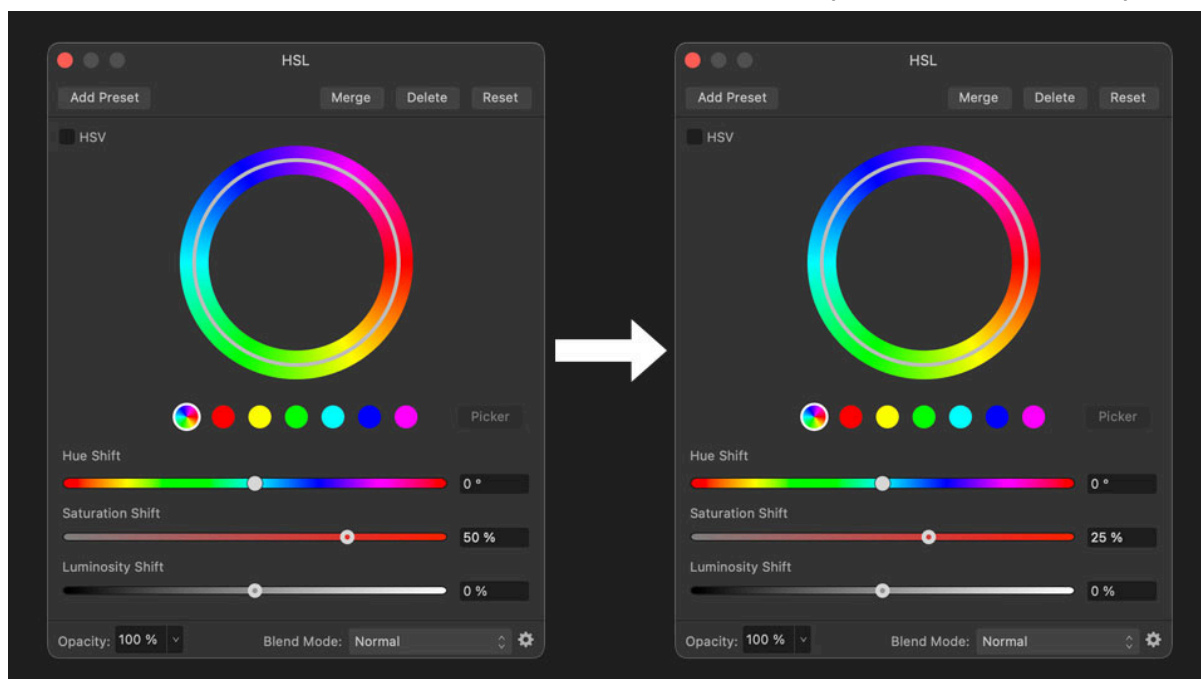
“My 360 photo is too sharp”

Double click Sharpening. Reduce the Radius (example below). Reduce the Factor (example below).

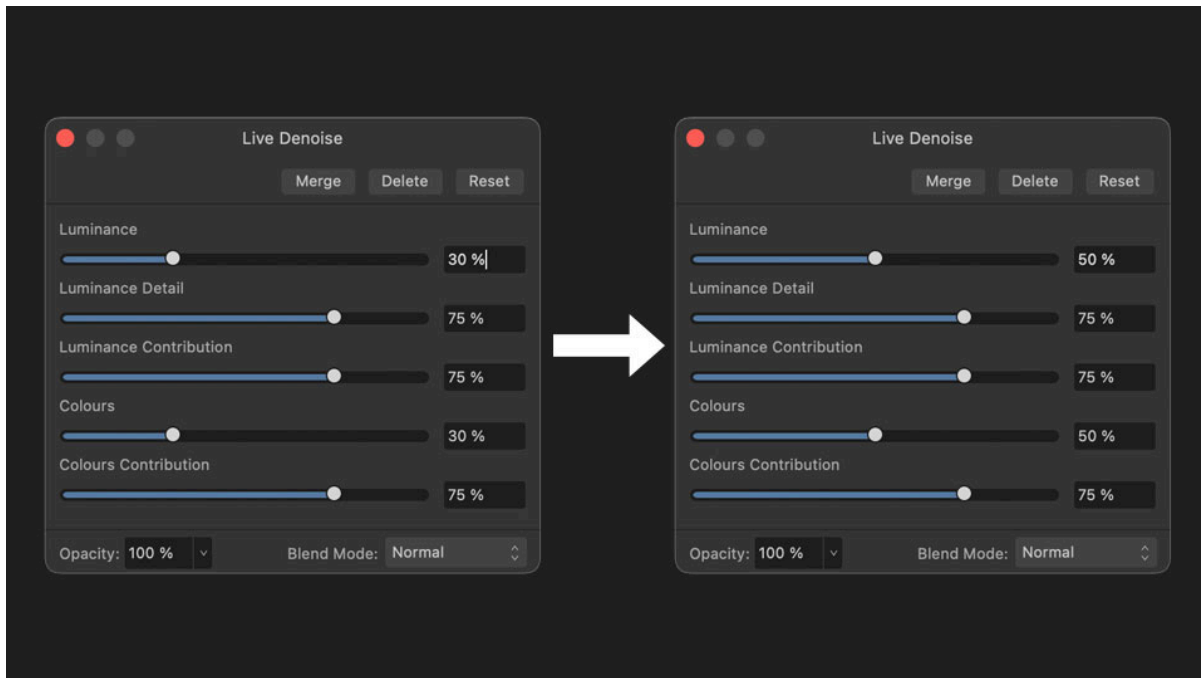


“My 360 photo is too noisy”

Double click Colour. Reduce the saturation (example below).

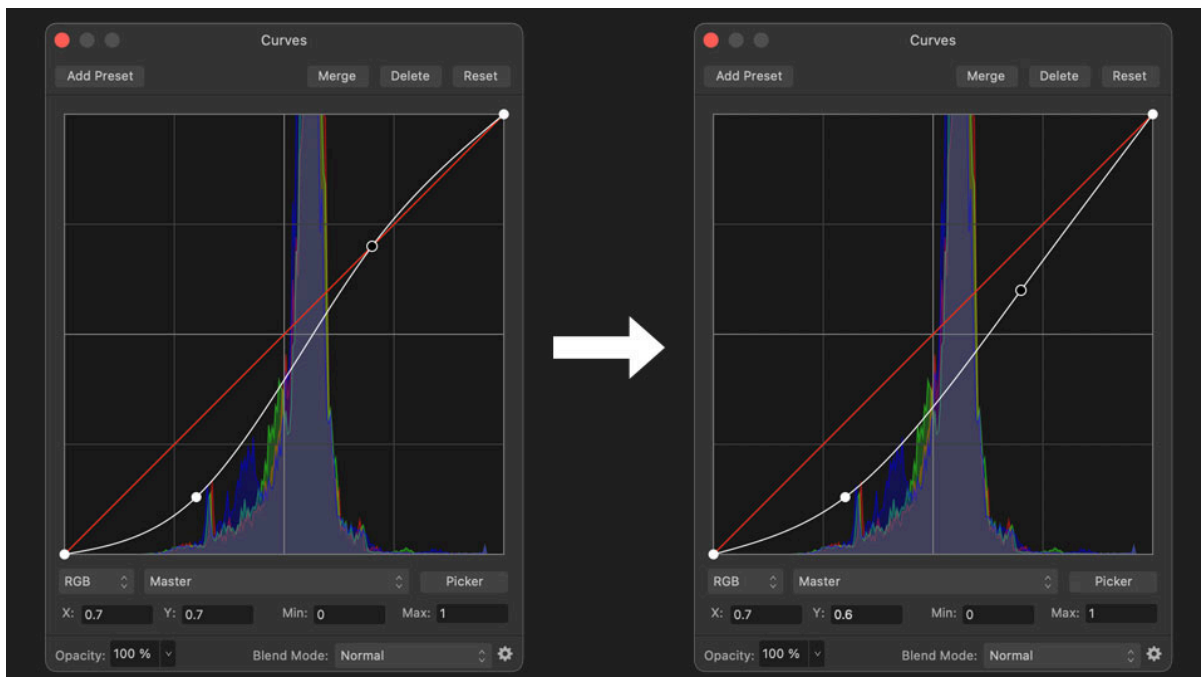


Double click Denoiser. Increase Luminance (example below). Increase Colours (example below).



“My 360 photo is too bright”

Double click Contrast. Click the third point. Reduce the Y value (example below).

If you shoot 360 photos with a 360 camera (Ricoh Theta or similar) or use the 'panorama' feature in a smartphone camera app, Facebook and Google know the results should be used as an interactive panorama. This is thanks to embedded metadata these sites look for when an image is uploaded.

But if you edit your shots in Photoshop or similar tools you may wipe out or mangle this metadata – and if you shoot and stitch your own 360 panoramas the files may not have the

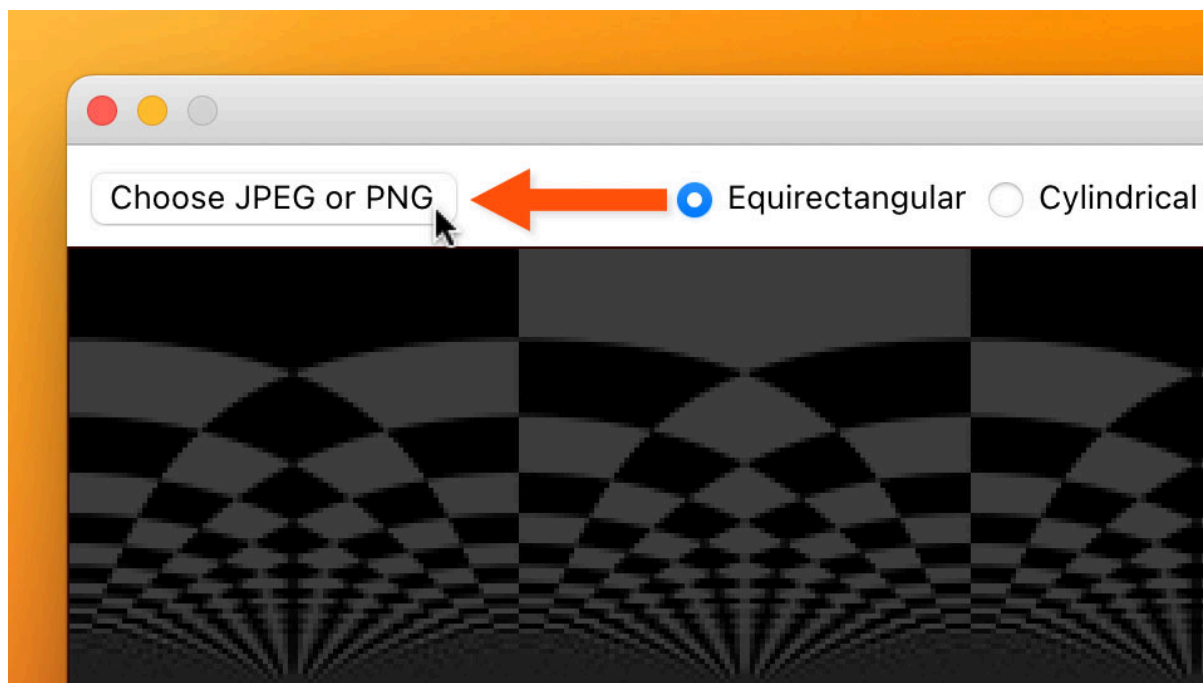

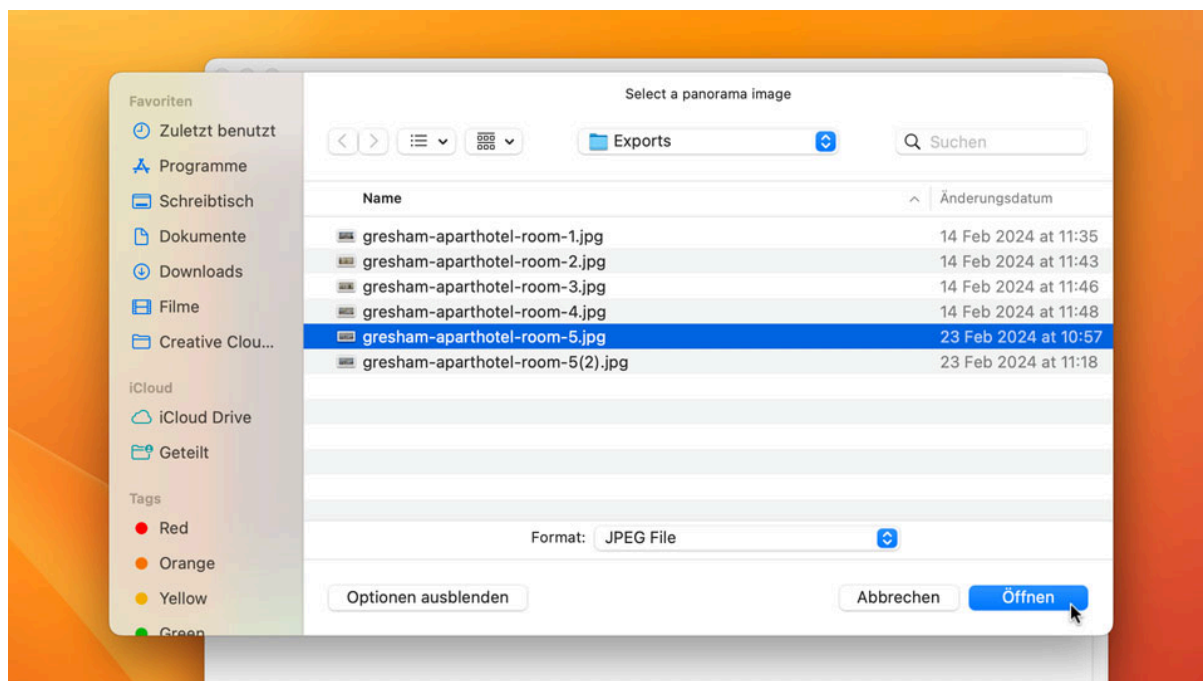

Open Exif Fixer. Click Choose JPEG or PNG.



Locate your photo and click open.





Click Add Metadata.
