HOW TO GROW YOUR BEE-FRIENDLY WILDFLOWER SEEDS!

The best time to sow our seeds is between April and June.

Just sprinkle the seeds thinly in fine soil where you want them to flower.

You can sow the seeds in the garden, borders, pots, tubs or a window box. Just keep watering gently so the soil is damp, and until the first shoots appear! (And hope for sunshine!)



The seeds will be flowering from June until October!

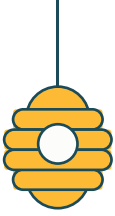
THE BEES LOVE THESE WILDFLOWERS...

We notice that regular visitors to our wildflowers have their individual favourite flowers or colours!





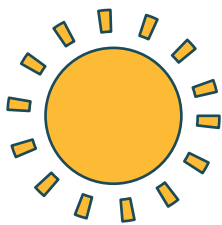

NO GARDEN?... NO PROBLEM!

Try growing your seeds in a Just Bee honey pot (or any other container).

Just remove the lid off your pot (make sure you finish your Honey first!) and then pop your seeds inside with soil or compost.



Place outside or sunny window sill and gently water.

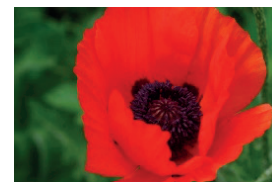

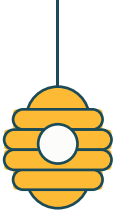
