## A portfolio of archival prints of Vintage Gaja-Lakshmi Paintings

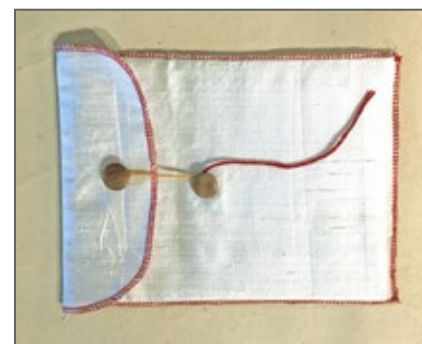

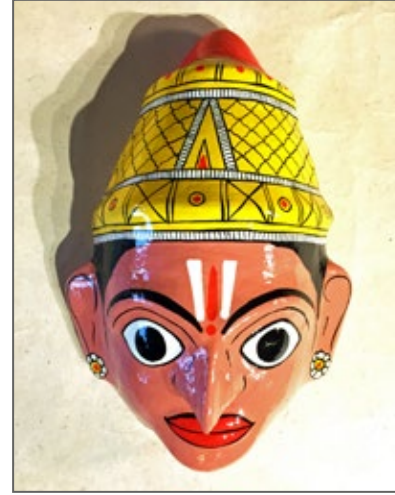

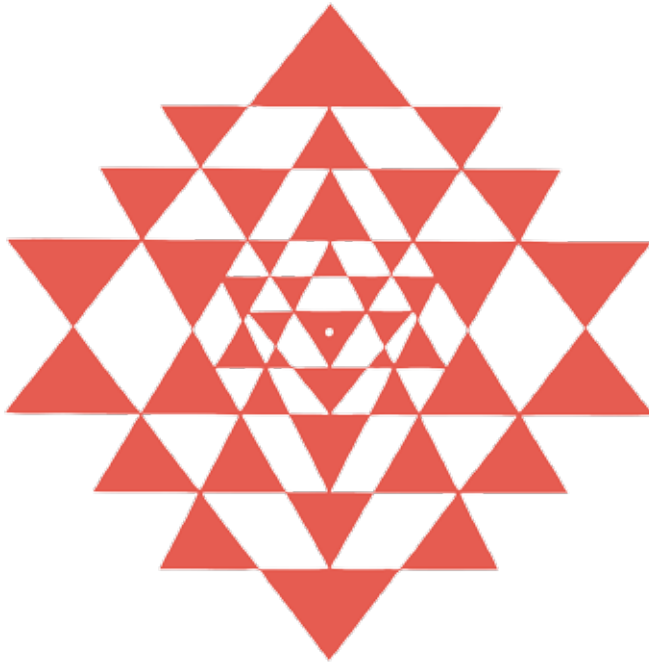
