A beautiful and enticing cool climate Pinot Noir. Ripe flavors of cranberry and raspberry are enhanced by aromas of cocoa and leather. These Massal Selection vines were planted and grown sustainably by our winemakers, Nico and Laura Espenschied, on their family estate in Flonheim, Germany. The grapes were hand-picked and fermented in open tonneau by native yeasts. We let the wine soften and age for 18 months in large oak tonneau.

Anchor & Hope is a craft winery in Rumford, RI. Our grapes are grown on small family farms in Germany, California, Oregon, Rhode Island and New York. All of our wines are from a single vineyard, farmed sustainably, and made using minimal intervention practices. They are elegant, easy drinking, and food friendly.
