How To: Adaptiv™ Night Mode





Bring more ambiance to your campsite with this simple and functional Adaptiv[™] Night Mode hack. By adhering efficient, battery-powered puck lights to the interior of your Adaptiv[™] cubes, you can bring soft, diffused lighting to your campsite. The HC Team loves using these outdoors while we hang with friends. We usually set up a tabletop with a patio base alongside the Adaptiv[™] Night Mode cubes while we hang with friends.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

Battery-powered LED Puck Lights (with a remote)

VHB Tape (or another heavy-duty adhesive tape)

Small strip of Velco or command strips

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Flip over the lids from your cubes and use a gentle multi-purpose cleaner to wipe away any dust. Dust or debris can prevent your installation from going smoothly.

Open the back cover on each of the lights and remove the small plastic tab covering the batteries. Get the cover back on nice and tight then doublecheck that your lights are working. If they don't turn on, check that the batteries are connected properly in the back or are not dead.

CAREFULLY APPLY TAPE

Cut a piece of VHB adhesive tape to be the same width as your lights. Smooth the tape onto the back of the lights. Once you have the tape applied to the lid, carefully remove the red side of the VHB adhesive tape. If you're having trouble separating the red layer, you can use a knife or razor to peel it off.

PRESS LIGHT TO LID

Before applying the light and tape to the bottom of your cube lid, make sure you are aligning it directly in the center of your lid. Press it down for 10 seconds to create a solid bond between the light and the lid.

ENJOY!

Wait for sunset and test the lights out! Play with the settings, such as the dim and timer features, till you create your desired light scene!

TIPS

- Use the velcro or command strips to secure the remote somewhere in your trailer. We like to put it near the door beside or under the fire extinguisher
- These LED lights are extremely energy efficient and do not produce heat. However, be sure to turn them off when not in use to extend their battery life
- Depending on what you store in your cubes, items might accidentally bump the lights on
- The white Adaptiv[™] cubes we offer are more transparent than the gray. The white cubes diffuse the light more than the gray would.
