A late 15th century edition of de Odendorff's Repetitio Capituli, a treatise which deals with the obligation to confess for Christians of both sexes from the age of awareness of injustice, which was decided at the 4th Lateran Council in 1215. Of Odendorff, he completed his studies of liberal arts in



Paris before coming to Vienna in 1383, where he was elected rector of the university there in 1485 as the first graduate in law. There are four painted initials, one featuring a face.

Leaves b3-b6 are lacking. Unusually, leaves b1-2 and b7-b8 have been bound in duplicate.

One volume in octavo, 16+112 of 116 leaves

This volume is in fair shape, with rubbing and wear to the binding, and the rear hinge partially cracked and split. There is damp staining throughout, with signs of mold spores. There is some worming throughout, mostly to the outer gutters, with some letter loss to the printed marginalia, and heavier to the last two leaves.

This volume is in very good shape, with minor rubbing and wear to the binding. There is some dampstaining affecting the first quarter and last handful of pages.

A scarce early 16th century edition of de Voragine Legende Sanctorum, also known more commonly as the Golden Legend of the Passion of the Saints, a famed collection of 153



hagiographies (biography or life of a saint or ecclesiastical figure), widely read in Europe during the Late Middle Ages.

Quire I is lacking, as is leaf P1, and the final blank.

Worldcat records 14 existing copies of this edition in libraries.

One volume in quarto, 282 of 291 leaves are lacking

This volume is in good shape, with some rubbing and wear to the binding. There is foxing and staining throughout, the staining mostly affecting the margins, and the title page heavily browned. The lower margins of quire R onwards to the end has small puncture marks. The last page has a bit of letter loss.

An early 16th century edition of the third collected edition of mystical theology from the end of the 5th century, attributed to Dionysius the Areopagite. This edition contains several works in up to three



different translations, including by Marsilio Ficino and Ambrogio Traversari with commentary by Hugh of St. Victor, Albertus Magnus, Robert Grosseteste, and others.

The volume is rubricated throughout, with impressive red initials, many with flourishes.

This volume has been bound in later 17th or 18th century blind stamped pigskin over wooden boards, with various floral designs.

One pigskin bound volume in quarto, (8)+CCXXIX

This volume is in very good shape, with minor rubbing, several small wormholes, and old staining to the binding. The lower margins of the title page have been crudely cut away, with tearing to the right-side margin. The lower right corners of the last three leaves are lacking, not affecting text, with a few more leaves worn and slightly torn at the margins. Leaf CXLVII is heavily wormed at the margins, with no text loss somehow. There are a few wormholes throughout at the bottom edge, not affecting text. There is staining throughout, affecting the first handful of leaves more heavily.

tracts attributed to Saint Bonaventure, this being the second of two volumes. There is a beautiful full-page woodcut at the end, displaying a seraph bearing confessional rules, sayings, and virtues in Latin upon its many wings.

The title page is lacking.

One finely re-bound volume in folio, (15 of 16)+CCXXXIII leaves

This volume is in very good shape, with minimal rubbing or wear to the binding. The first and last leaves are somewhat browned and chipped at the edges, with marginal wormholes, not affecting text. The rest of the volume has some scattered foxing and staining, more so to the margins.

An uncommon early 16th century edition of Platina's History of the Popes, up to Paul II, initially published in 1476, and here, supplemented up to Pius III. This is the first of two parts, containing the entire papal history, the second missing



being a smaller 128 leaf section containing smaller works by Platina. The title woodcut shows Platina writing in front of eight popes.

USTC records 24 existing copies of this edition in libraries.

One rebound volume in 12mo, CCCLII+(4) leaves

This volume is in very good shape, with minor rubbing and wear to the rebind, the early spine re-laid, being fragmentary. There is heavier wear and damage to the title page. There is some staining throughout, mostly to the upper margin of the pages.









A scarce early 16th century edition of von Busti's Rosary Sermon Predicated for the Easier Convenience of Pedigrees, being the first of two parts. Additionally bound is an earlier edition of de Bustis' Defender of the Mountain of Piety against all the devices of falsehood.



A scarce early 16th century edition of Auvergne's Commentaries on the Epistles and Gospels: throughout the whole year.

Originally published in 1437, the work was published in more than one hundred editions across Europe between 1473 and 1500.

A French theologian and philosopher, he served as Bishop of Paris from 1228 until his death and was one of the first western European philosophers to engage with and comment extensively upon Aristotelian and Islamic philosophy.





This work is printed throughout in a gothic font, with detailed initials. There are two large woodcut titles, and over 100 in-text woodcuts throughout, all by Urs Graf, with his monogram seen on the title woodcut.

This copy has been annotated by several hands, including one nearcontemporary hand, with some scripts in Latin and another unidentified language.

USTC records 14 existing copies of this edition in libraries.

Leaves 11-14, 76, 84-91, and the second repeated title page are lacking (Leaf Aa). Leaf 81 has been misbound, being in place where leaf 84 would be.

This volume is in good shape, with minimal rubbing or wear to the newer binding. Leaves 136-138 were torn and restored at some point, with some text and imagery lacking where the blank paper has restored the leaves. There are a considerable number of careful restorations throughout where tears were. There is some foxing, staining, and scattered worming throughout.

This copy bears some occasional annotations, spread throughout. The pastedowns appear to be 15th century manuscript fragments.

This volume is in very good shape, with minimal rubbing or wear to the binding. There is some browning throughout, as well as some staining to the margins, with leaves 228 and 299 more heavily affected.

These volumes have been bound in blind stamped pigskin over wooden boards. To the covers are gilt tooled images of the Virgin Mary and Infant Jesus.

These volumes bear the stamps of the dissolved Franciscan monastery known as the Church of the Immaculate Conception of Mary, in Miltenberg.

This compilation of texts is lacking the title and a2 leaf to the Book of Common Prayer, the Old Testament title page to the Bible (The New Testament title is present, the Bible itself being textually complete), and The Book of Psalms is lacking the last 7 numbered pages, as well as the last 11 unnumbered pages.

This volume is in good shape, with rubbing and scuffing to the binding, and only one clasp present. There is foxing and staining throughout, with some of the page edges worn, and parts of the text block jutting out more than others. Leaves 220-221 are most affected by staining, with several lines of text supplanted by hand. Several leaves show signs of early restoration work.

This volume has been bound in blind stamped pigskin over wooden boards. To the front cover is a tooled image of the Crucifixion, and to the rear, is a

tooled image of the Salvador Mundi, with Christ holding the globus cruciger aloft in one hand. There is one clasp present.

This volume bears the stamp of the dissolved monastery library Franziskaner Kloster Dettelbach. There is also an ownership inscription bearing Jesuit provenance.

An early 17th century edition of Maioli's Dog Days, containing new and admirable physical conversations, both pleasant to read and refreshing beyond belief, both remarkable for knowledge and necessary for punishment. An encyclopaedic work, the work contains several volumes bound as one, encompassing quite a wide range of topics in natural history, including humankind, animals, botanical subjects, astronomy, and more esoteric subjects such as ghosts, spirits, werewolves, demonology, and the like.

This volume has been bound in blind stamped pigskin over wooden boards, with various floral designs. The symbol of the Society of Jesuits is present.

One pigskin bound volume in folio, (8)+1060+(54) pages

This volume is in fair shape, with heavy rubbing and wear to the binding, and some pigskin lacking to the upper right corner of the front cover. This corner of the pages up to 33 are heavily worn and frayed, with some letter loss, likely due to ancient rodent damage. The corners of the index leaves are somewhat frayed and worn as well. There is foxing and browning throughout.

Said to be derived from the insight of King Solomon, the text is broken down into two parts, the first part provides instructions for a number of magical implements, including a wand, talisman, and margic circle, used to summon the demon "Lucifugé Rofocale", a prime minister in Hell. The second part is divided into an additional two parts, Sanctum Regnum and Secrets, de L'Art Magique du Grand Grimoire. The Sanctum Regnum provides instructions on making a pact with the demon Lucifugé, while Secrets contains spells and rituals. Nine greater and lesser demons



are mentions as well, including, but not limited to, Lucifer, Astaroth, Nebiros, and others. Also included is a short version of the treasure-finding text known as "La Poule Noire".


