Cabernet Merlot / Hunter Valley / 2019

Home to Peter Drayton Wines at the foot of the Brokenback range is IronBark Hill Vineyard, named after the intrinsically Australian eucalyptus trees found on the property. IronBarkHill wines celebrate the Hunter Valley with the boldness and craftsmanship that is synonymous with Peter Drayton.

Colour

Bright deep crimson red.

Nose

Aromas of ripe red berries, blackberries and blackcurrants.

Palate

The palate is full and fruit driven with savoury plum flavours. Perfect balance of integrated oak and soft silky tannins.

Winemaking

Vintage 2019 arrived premature after an early budburst in Spring. A long, dry season resulted in virtually no disease pressure throughout the region. Winemakers were able to make picking decisions purely on when grapes displayed perfect ripeness. Cool nights allowed beautiful acid retention and concentrated varietal flavours.
