
Installation Instructions for Setcom Half-Shell Helmet Headset Kit


For use with Helmets having pre-installed Snap Fittings

(For Example: Seer S1608V)



The illustration at left shows how the Helmet Kit speaker enclosures fit onto the Helmet Chin Strap

On the inner side of each plastic speaker enclosure, note that there are two sets of Velcro strips already in place – the "loops" are installed on the enclosures and the "hooks" are fastened to the "loops". The outer side of each "hook" strip has a protective layer of plastic tape. See below:



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Leave the protective tape in place until instructed to remove it.

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Installation Step1:

The Helmet Kit speaker enclosures fit onto the Snap Studs installed on the Helmet chin strap. Starting with the Left-Side enclosure, follow the illustrations below. Note that the Snap Caps have a "dot" (dimple) on the lower edge. Repeat the process with the Right-Side enclosure.



A) Locate the Snap Studs on the Helmet Chin Strap. Remove the protective plastic film from the Velcro "hook" strips to expose the adhesive backing. B) Position the enclosure as shown above, so the tops of the Snap Caps are partly engaged on the Snap Studs. pivot and press Snap into place

C) Pivot the enclosure downwards and press the Snap Caps into place on the Snap Studs.

Next press the Velcro "hook" strips firmly in place to allow the adhesive to stick to the Chin Strap.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Be sure the Velcro has fully adhered to the Chin Straps during installation – this prevents outward movement of the speaker enclosures during periods of high-speed motorcycle operation.

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
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Installation Step2:

After installing both of the speaker enclosures, use a blunt-tipped tool (thin popsicle stick or the end of a cotton swab with the cotton cut off) to push the thin cable connecting the enclosures down into the gap between the outer liner and shell of the helmet.


This completes the installation, the Helmet Kit is ready for operation.



Removing Helmet Kit from Helmet: To remove Helmet Kit from Helmet, first gently pull the thin connecting cable out from between the Helmet outer liner and shell. Allow it to hang free.

Next, remove the speaker enclosures by prying apart the Snap fittings –

These fittings are designed to be separated at the points indicated by the arrows in the illustration below, the "dots" on the caps show where to pull apart the Snap Caps and the Snap Studs on the Chin Straps – only pull them apart from these points.




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Instructions for Installing Slide-In Snap Plates for Setcom Half-Shell Helmet Kits

Setcom Part numbers 13-1112L (Left) and 13-1112R (Right)



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
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Step 1: Install Helmet Kit Enclosure(s) on Slide-in Snap Plate(s).

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Step 2: Slide Snap Plate(s) into Helmet, between outer shell of Helmet and outside of liner. A front-to-back rocking motion helps the Plate slide into place. Use attached Velcro to help secure speaker enclosures to Helmet strap.
