Registration Sunday May 5, 2024 At the Chilton County Senior Connection Center (located beside Dollar General in Clanton) 2:00pm until 4:00pm Contestant Information

Please bring the following items:

- Three wallet size pictures, head shot only. Cut, with contestant's name/sponsor on the back.
- Pictures must be of the same pose and taken within the last year.
- Completed fact sheet, make sure it is complete and accurate; we will not make changes after you have turned in your fact sheet.
- The contestant fact sheet may not contain any information related to participating in or winning any other pageants.
- The contestant fact sheet may not contain any information on the Rising Star program.
- If the fact sheet contains any of the prohibited information, it will be removed.
- If a line item on the fact sheet limits you to the amount that can be listed and you list more we will take the first items listed and drop the rest.
- A Signed contract
- Bring a copy of your birth certificate.
- Sponsor/Entry Fee of \$75.00
- Photogenic Form and \$25.00
- AD and AD Money
- You will not be considered registered unless you meet eligibility requirements, and have your completed fact sheet, contract, birth certificate, pictures and registration fee turned in at registration.

Practices and Parties:

If you will not be able to attend a practice or event, you are required to let your group coordinator know as soon as possible.

Little, Young and Junior contestants' attire for the swim party is to be natural hair and makeup. No piercings or tattoos at any time for any group can be visible. If you show up with it visible, you will be Dismissed from the event. No piercings includes belly button rings.

Dress Information:

All contestants will model the following:

- Evening Gown
- Casual Wear
- No props are allowed



Pageant Information:

- Each contestant will introduce herself on stage. They will say their name, number and sponsor. This is designed to be fun, not stressful. So please encourage your child that this is a fun part of the pageant where they get to show their personality with a cute pose.
- We encourage each contestant to have a cute pose and to show their personality during the introduction, just remember to keep it classy.
- Little, Young and Junior contestants should be at the lunchroom dressed and ready at 4:45. Miss Contestants should be at the lunchroom dressed and ready for interviews at 4:00.

Peach Parade:

All Queens, Alternates, Miss Congeniality and Scholarship winners are required to ride on the official Peach Festival floats in the Peach Parade.

Peach Auction:

All Queens, Alternates and banner winners are required to attend the Peach Auction.

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CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT AND RULES:

Please note, where the agreement states contestant, this also means that said contestant would continue to follow these rules agreed to in the event she is crowned Peach Queen.

- 1. Contestant agrees she is a resident of Chilton County, a natural born female, is not pregnant and has never been pregnant.
- 2. Contestant agrees she is not married, has not been married and will not become married during her reign if named Peach Queen.
- 3. Contestant agrees to be a person of good moral character, now and at all times during the Pageant and during Contestants reign if she wins the title of a Peach Queen.
- 4. Contestant has not committed, nor will Contestant commit any act inconsistent with the highest standards of public morals and conventions or which may reflect negatively upon the Pageant, The Clanton Lions Club, its Sponsors, Affiliates, or any party related there-to.
- Any Contestant that wins and holds a Peach title shall not knowingly or intentionally engage in nude, lewd, or lascivious media.
- 6. At all times Contestant will be courteous, polite and act in a professional manner during the Peach Pageant and events.
- 7. Contestant will not smoke or drink alcoholic beverages in public at any time during the Pageant or during her reign as a Peach Queen.
- 8. Contestants may not have any visible tattoos or piercings other than ear piercings.
- 9. If Contestant wins the Peach Pageant and becomes the Peach Queen (Little, Young, Junior or Miss) and she holds another title, she must relinquish that title within seven (7) days from the date of being crowned Peach Queen. If she does not relinquish any other titles, she will be disqualified and 1st Alternate will be named Peach Queen.
- 10. A Peach Queen may not participate in any other pageants during her reign with the exception of her school beauty night (for example Miss JHS, Miss CCHS or Little Miss JES) where a winner for each grade is selected.
- 11. Contestant agrees that if she maintains or is involved in electronic networking sites such as Websites, Twitter, Facebook, blog, message boards etc., she will present a positive image that will not contain behavior such as negative postings, inappropriate photos, bullying or inappropriate language.
- 12. No parent, friend, family member and/or representative is allowed backstage other than the one person with the appropriate badge. At no time can the badge be changed to another person.
- 13. Contestant will not in any way or at any time make comments or correspond in such a manner as to be considered slanderous or libelous to her fellow contestants, judges, The Clanton Lions Club, volunteers, workers, sponsors, or any party directly related or connected to the Pageant.
- 14. At all times Contestant will display good sportsmanship.
- 15. All issues related to the *Code of Conduct* and consequences for violation(s) thereof shall be determined solely and exclusively by the Clanton Lions Club. Contestant agrees to accept such determinations made by The Clanton Lions Club as to both herself and others.
- 16. If at any time during a Peach Queen's reign any justifiable evidence of behavior that the Clanton Lions Club determines to be in violation of any rules or has been involved in conduct the club considers to be not of good moral character she will be removed from her reign and will forfeit her crown, sash and gifts.
- 17. If at any time a Little, Young, Junior or Miss Peach Queen has their title revoked the 1st Alternate will then be named the Queen for the remainder of the reign. If said 1st Alternate is still of age to participate in the Peach Pageants at the end of that reign, regardless of if it is the same category, she will be allowed to compete in the pageant that following year. For example, if a Miss Peach Queen's title is revoked the 1st alternate will be named Queen, so that 1st alternate still has the opportunity afforded to her to compete the following year for that same category if she is still within the age requirements. This is to allow for a successor to be named but not penalized from competing.
- 18. If a Peach Queen is removed from her duties of Queen, she will forfeit her Crown, Sash, scholarship (Miss) and cash reward (Little, Young and Junior), and all gifts awarded to her throughout her reign.
- 19. The Clanton Lions Club reserves the right to change or modify rules without prior notification.
