- All entries shall be postmarked no later than June 22, 2024.
- All entries will be assigned a lineup number. Each entry will be contacted by EOD Wednesday June 26, 2024, and advised of their number and where to line up.
- Last minute entries may be accepted if time and space permits. **THERE IS NO GUARANTEE OF ENTRY IF YOU JUST SHOW UP!**
- All entries should have some type of peach theme decoration to correspond with the peach festival activities. Emergency Vehicles are exempt from this.
- lineup will begin at 7:30am, Parade will begin at 9:00am. Each entry should be checked in and ready to roll by 8:50am. Late arrivals may be bumped even if you have a number.
- Upon arriving at lineup area, entries should check in with parade officials.
- All entries other than School Marching Bands are required to be on a float or some type of moving vehicle unless approved by parade chairman.
- For floats/vehicles that have small children riding on them, they may have adults walk beside the float/vehicle as safety escorts as long as they are able to keep up with the float/vehicle.
- Businesses/Vendors/Clubs that wish to pass out advertisement materials may have person(s) walking beside their float/vehicle to pass out materials as long as they can keep up with the vehicle.
- All participants will conduct themselves with appropriate behavior. Anyone with improper behavior, attitude, or rule violation can and will be removed from the parade by any parade official or law enforcement personnel.
- Anyone riding motorcycles, scooters, or ATV's will wear required safety equipment at all times during the parade.
- All vehicle drivers must have a valid driver's license and insurance in their possession and may be required to present it upon the request from any parade official or law enforcement officer.
