

Size and Measuring Guide

1. **Grab a fabric tape measure** or print this guide and cut out the measuring tape*

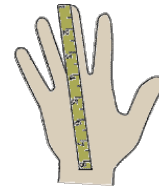
2. **Measure around:**

- Wrap the tape measure tightly around your dominant hand (your right hand if you're right-handed and left if left-handed)
- The tape measure should wrap tightly over the top of your hand and across your palm at its widest point
- Record the size of your hand at this point in inches or centimeters



3. **Measure lengthwise:**

- Spread your same hand and fingers and place the tape measure at the tip of your middle finger
- Stretch the tape measure down to the base of your hand, holding it tight where your wrist begins
- Record the length of your hand at this point in inches or centimeters



4. **Identify your size using the measurement guide below:**

- Now you have two figures in inches or centimeters (recorded at 2.c. and 3.c.)
- Take the bigger of the two figures and match it with a Maestrale Size using the table below
- If you are in between Maestrale Sizes we recommend that you go for the smaller one, a snug fit will give you greater mobility for the touchscreen functionality. Nevertheless, if you have thick fingers or prefer a loose fit, you may want to go for the bigger of the two sizes.
- If you are more than a half a size apart between both figures (ie- size 8 length but size 9 circumference), feel free to reach out to us for further guidance at hello@maestralenapoli.com

* **Printing instructions:**

- Select the A4 paper format in your printing options and print at 100% scale
- Verify it is correct by placing a credit card vertically at the top right-hand corner of the paper making sure that it matches the dotted green line on the measurer
- The edges of the ruler starting at 0 may get cut out when printing and a white margin may appear. Please do not cut off this white margin
