HOW DO I USE IT?

- Start with a clean dry surface free from oil and grease
- For precision tip, squeeze tube to apply one drop of glue per square inch
- For precision brush, use brush to apply glue to surface
- For the 3g size, unscrew the nozzle and puncture the protective foil. Replace the nozzle and remove cap

HOW TO REMOVE FROM SURFACE?

- If a few drops or a spill has touched an unwanted surface, allow the super glue to dry.
- Flex Tape Adhesive Remover or acetone products can break the bond.
- Follow the safety precautions and directions of Adhesive Remover, spray over the area then wipe off with a cloth or paper towel.
- Depending on the surface, it could penetrate other topcoats if left for too long.

STORAGE

- Replace the cap immediately and store in a cool, dry place.

FLEX SUPER GLUE REMOVAL & FIRST AID

FLEX SUPER GLUE® is a high- performance, instant adhesive that bonds in seconds. If you feel unwell or sick after coming into contact with Flex Super Glue, contact your doctor or seek medical advice.

HOW TO REMOVE FROM HAIR?

- If the super glue hasn't dried yet, act fast with warm water, shampoo, and conditioner.
- If super glue is fully cured, soak or wet hair in water for 10 minutes
- Use a brush or comb to gently release the bonded residue.
- Rinse and repeat this action until the super glue residue has been removed.
- There are many home remedies to removing super glue from skin and hair. Using warm water, shampoo, and conditioner is the safest means to remove the product.
- In case of emergency, call physician or Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424 - 9300.

HOW TO REMOVE FROM CLOTHES?

- If the super glue hasn't dried yet, act fast with warm, soapy water. You may need to use a toothbrush to help with the removal.
- Acetone, like nail polish remover, is faster and safe for most objects. Test it on a small area first to be sure it will not damage or discolor the fabric.
- If residue remain, repeat soak then scrub until all remaining adhesive is gone.

HOW TO REMOVE FROM FINGERS?

- Immediately soak bonded area in warm, soapy water for 10 minutes.
- Carefully peel or roll the skin apart gently and slowly. Do Not pull them apart.
- Once bond is released, gently scratch with your fingernail, or use a pumice stone, to remove the cured layer off your skin.
- If skin irritation or rash occurs, immediately call a physician or the Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424 - 9300

HOW TO REMOVE FROM EYE?

- If Flex Super Glue comes in contact with eye lid, DO NOT force open.
- Rinse eye lid with warm, soapy water to release bond.
- If the super glue comes in contact with the eyeball, immediately call a doctor or Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424- 9300.

HOW TO REMOVE FROM SKIN?

- If the super glue hasn't dried yet, act fast with warm, soapy water.
- If super glue has cured, soak affected area in the water for 10 minutes.

- If unable to soak the affected area, like the forearm or leg, then use a soaked cloth instead. Hold cloth on area for 10 minutes.
- Once the super glue has been softened, gently rub off the residue off with your fingernail or a pumice soap.
- If any super glue residue remains, repeat soaking, and continue to gently pick it off using your nails.
- There are many home remedies and some chemicals used for removing super glue from skin. Soap and water are the safest methods in removing the product.
- If irritation continues, call a physician or Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424- 9300.

WHAT TO DO IF INHALED?

- If inhaled, retreat to fresh air, and keep in a position comfortable for breathing.
- If discomfort persists, consult a doctor or Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424 - 9300

WHAT TO DO IF INGESTED?

- Flex Super Glue contains ethylcyanoacrylate and is not food safe.
- If ingested, immediately contact a physician or Poison Control Center at 1- 800- 424- 9300.
