
* Before cutting out templates, check that the guide has printed at 100% scale by laying a credit card on this line.

LOCKET PHOTOS

Get started.

- 1. Print this guide at 100% to make sure everything is scaled just right.
- 2. Cut out the shape of your locket. (Template pictured right)
- 3. Place it over your photo and trace around with a pencil (not pen!). We recommend photos printed on anything but glossy photo paper as it's difficult to work with at this scale.
- 4. Cut out your photo by following the inside of the line you traced. Erase pencil marks when you're finished.
- 5. Use something pointy like the end of a paper clip or tweezers to help tuck the edges into the locket. And voila!



Psst, we left some extras in case you need a couple tries.

ALTERNATE IDEA

Keep a sentiment close to your heart.

Lockets don't have to hold photos.

Try writing a note, quote, loving reminder-to-self on a small piece of paper, fold it up and tuck it in the locket.
