# BASIC Placemat #1 (Version 1)

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, strips can be trimmed to fit the panel after each strip is added if needed.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 13" strip, subcut (4) 5-1/2" wide x 13" tall pieces

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut  
(2) 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips  
Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (2) 2" x 13-1/2" strips

**Fabric D** - Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut  
(2) 2" x 18-1/2" strips

**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut  
(2) 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips  
Cut (2) 2" strip, subcut (2) 2" x 18-1/2"  
and (2) 2" x 13-1/2" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 17" strips, subcut  
(4) 17" x 21" rectangles for backings

## 2. Piecing Order:

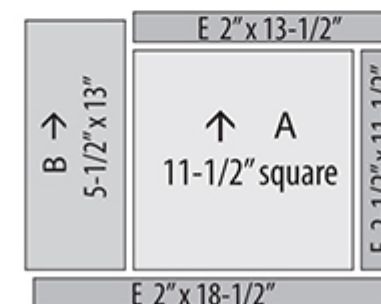
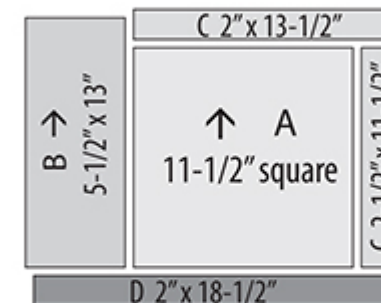
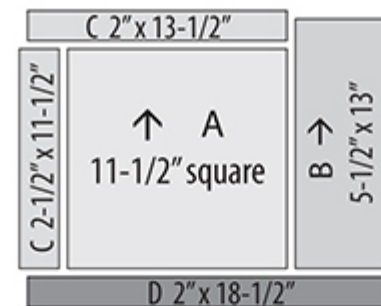
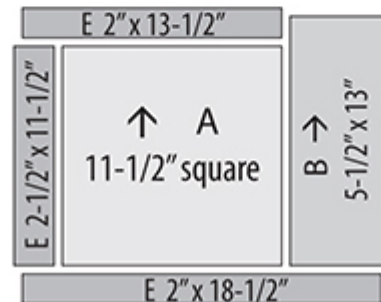
1. Refer to Placemat Layouts for arrangement and placement of panels and borders.
2. Stitch a **Fabric C** or **E** 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strip to left side of 2 panels and a **Fabric C** or **E** 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strip to right side of 2 panels.
3. Sew a **Fabric C** or **E** 2" x 13-1/2" strip to top of each panel.
4. Stitch a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 13" strip to right side of 2 panels and to left side of 2 panels.
5. Sew a **Fabric D** or **E** 2" x 18-1/2" strip to bottom of panels to complete 4 placemat tops (each 14-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

6. Layer each placemat top and backing (**Fabric F**) right sides together. Place a 17" x 21" batting piece on bottom. Stitch around all sides leaving a 4-5" opening on bottom edge. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Turn right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!

# BASIC Placemat #1 (Version 2)

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, strips can be trimmed to fit the panel after each strip is added if needed.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B1 & B2** - Cut (1) 13" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" wide x 13" tall pieces (total 4)

**Fabric C** - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips  
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 13-1/2" strips

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 18-1/2" strips

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 17" strips, subcut (4) 17" x 21" rectangles for backings

6. Layer each placemat top and backing (**Fabric E**) right sides together. Place a 17" x 21" batting piece on bottom. Stitch around all sides leaving a 4-5" opening on bottom edge. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Turn right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!

## 2. Piecing Order:

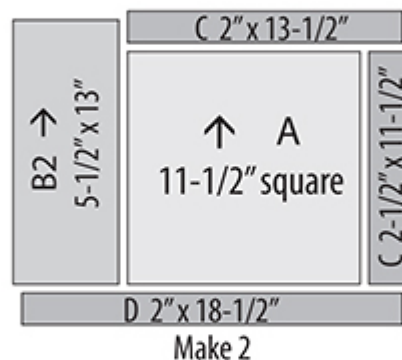
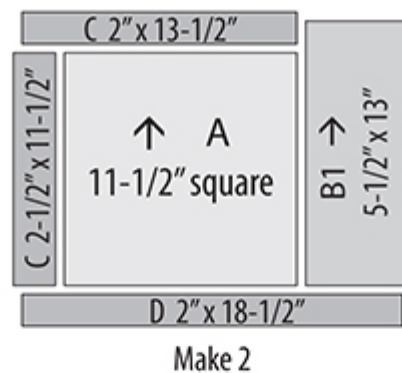
1. Refer to Placemat Layouts for arrangement and placement of panels and borders.
2. Stitch a **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strip to left side of 2 panels and to right side of 2 panels.
3. Sew a **Fabric C** 2" x 13-1/2" strip to top of each panel.
4. Stitch a **Fabric B1 or B2** 5-1/2" x 13" strip to right side of 2 panels and to left side of 2 panels.
5. Sew a **Fabric D** strip to bottom of panels to complete 4 placemat tops (each 14-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

## PLACEMAT LAYOUTS

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

Border measurements are the cut size.

Shading of Placemat Layouts may vary depending on fabrics used.



# BASIC Placemat #1 (Version 3 A/B)

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, strips can be trimmed to fit the panel after each strip is added if needed.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Optional Fabric A directional/overall prints**

- Cut (2) 11-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 11 1/2" squares (total 4)

**Fabric B1 & B2** - Cut (1) 13" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" wide x 13" tall pieces (total 4)

**Fabric C1 & C2** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips (total 4)

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (2) 2" x 13-1/2" strips (4 total)

**Fabric D1 & D2** - Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (2) 2" x 18-1/2" strips (total 4)

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 17" strips, subcut (4) 17" x 21" rectangles for backings

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Refer to Placemat Layouts for arrangement and placement of panels and borders.

2. Stitch a **Fabric C1** or **C2** 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strip to left side of 2 panels and a **Fabric C1** or **C2** 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" strip to right side of 2 panels.

3. Sew a **Fabric C1** or **C2** 2" x 13-1/2" strip to top of each panel.

4. Stitch a **Fabric B1** or **B2** 5-1/2" x 13" strip to right side of 2 panels and to left side of 2 panels.

5. Sew a **Fabric D1** or **D2** 2" x 18-1/2" strip to bottom of panels to complete 4 placemat tops (each 14-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

6. Layer each placemat top and backing (**Fabric E**) right sides together. Place a 17" x 21" batting piece on bottom. Stitch around all sides leaving a 4-5" opening on bottom edge. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Turn right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!
