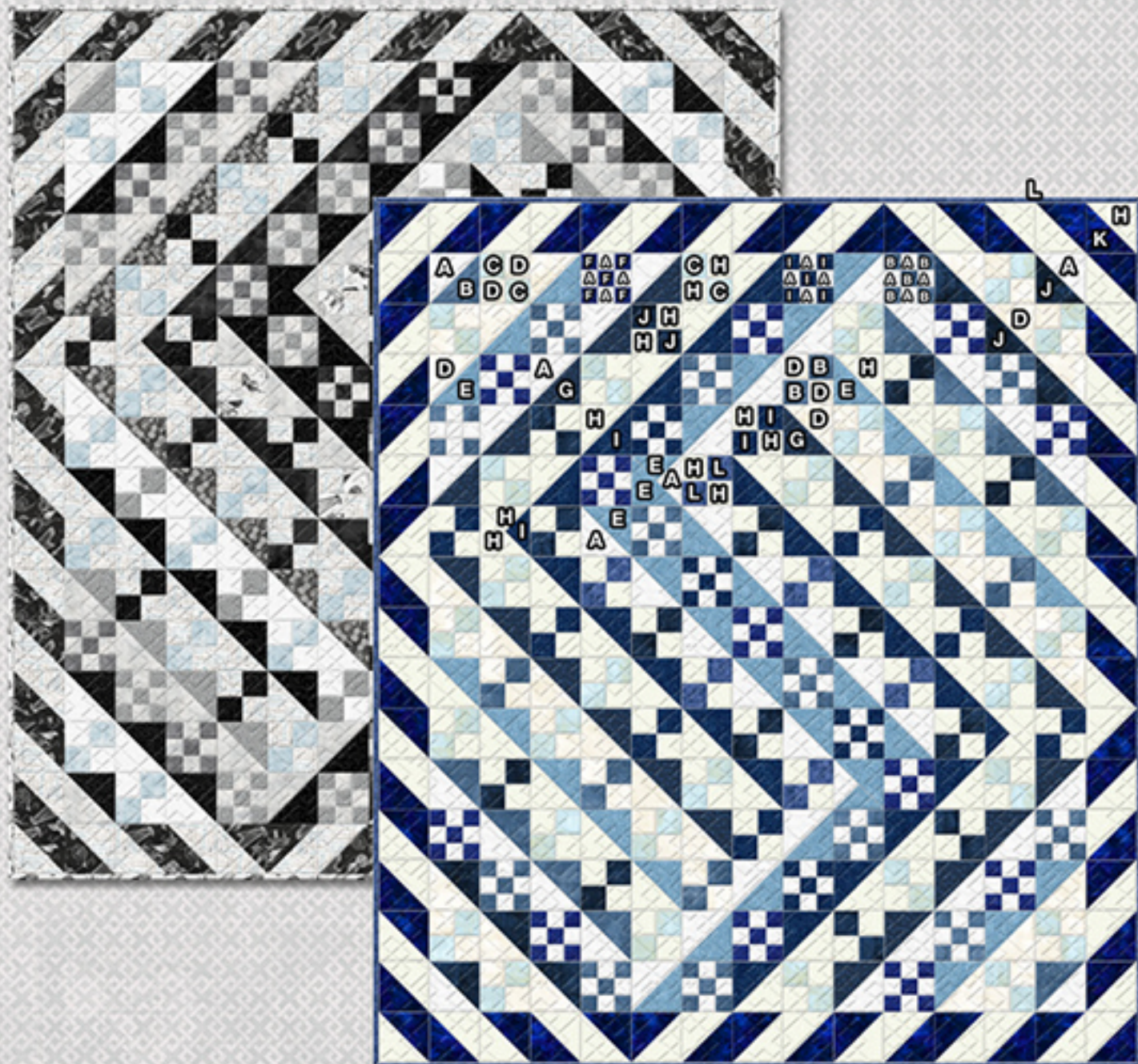


# CLASSIC Extra Large Throw Quilt #1



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Quilt Size: 67-1/2" x 76-1/2"

Fabric A 1-1/8 yards

Fabric B 5/8 yard

Fabric C 1/2 yard

Fabric D 2/3 yard

Fabric E 5/8 yard

Fabric F 1/3 yard

Fabric G 1/2 yard

Fabric H 2 yards

Fabric I 5/8 yard

Fabric J 1/2 yard

Fabric K 7/8 yard

Fabric L 7/8 yard (Incl. Binding)

Fabric M 4-7/8 yards (44/45" Backing Only)

2-1/4 yards (108" Backing Option)





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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 4 triangles] and (6) 5-3/8" squares

Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (14) 5-3/8" squares then cut all 5-3/8" squares in half  diagonally for 40 triangles


Cut (6) 2" strips, subcut (124) 2" squares

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 5-3/8" strip, subcut (5) 5-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for  10 triangles] and (2) 2" squares


Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (12) 2-3/4" squares


Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (63) 2" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (5) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (64) 2-3/4" squares


**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (12) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 24 triangles


Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (40) 2-3/4" squares


**Fabric E** - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 4 triangles] and (4) 5-3/8" squares

Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (14) 5-3/8" squares then cut all 5-3/8" squares in half  diagonally for 36 triangles


**Fabric F** - Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (65) 2" squares


**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (11) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 22 triangles

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 4 triangles] and (4) 5-3/8" squares

Cut (6) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (42) 5-3/8" squares then cut all 5-3/8" squares in half  diagonally for 92 triangles


Cut (7) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (92) 2-3/4" squares

**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half  diagonally twice for 4 triangles], (3) 5-3/8" squares, (2) 2-3/4" squares, and (4) 2" squares


Cut (1) 5-3/8" strip, subcut (7) 5-3/8" squares then cut all 5-3/8" squares in half  diagonally for 20 triangles

Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (14) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (21) 2" squares

**Fabric J** - Cut (1) 5-3/8" strip, subcut (4) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (28) 2-3/4" squares

**Fabric K** - Cut (5) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (30) 5-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 60 triangles

**Fabric L** - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (12) 2-3/4" squares  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

*Not all triangles cut are used.*

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **Fabrics H** and **K** 5-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 60 **Block 1a** (5" square unfinished).

2. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b-1j** listed using the fabrics indicated.

3. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics C and D** 2-3/4" squares in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 14 **Block 2a** (5" square unfinished).



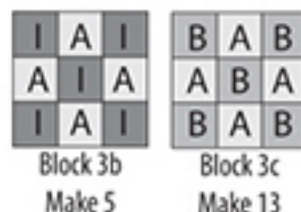
4. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 2b-2f** listed using the fabrics indicated.



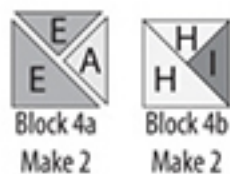
5. Arrange 4 **Fabric A** and 5 **Fabric F** 2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 13 **Block 3a** (5" square unfinished).



6. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 3b and 3c** listed using the fabrics indicated.



7. Stitch **Fabrics A and E** 5-3/4" triangles together along their short edges as shown. Add a **Fabric E** 5-3/8" triangle as shown. Make a total of 2 **Block 4a** (5" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 4b** using fabrics indicated.



8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks.

9. Arrange blocks in 17 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.

10. The quilt measures approximately 68" x 77" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric L**) and enjoy!!
