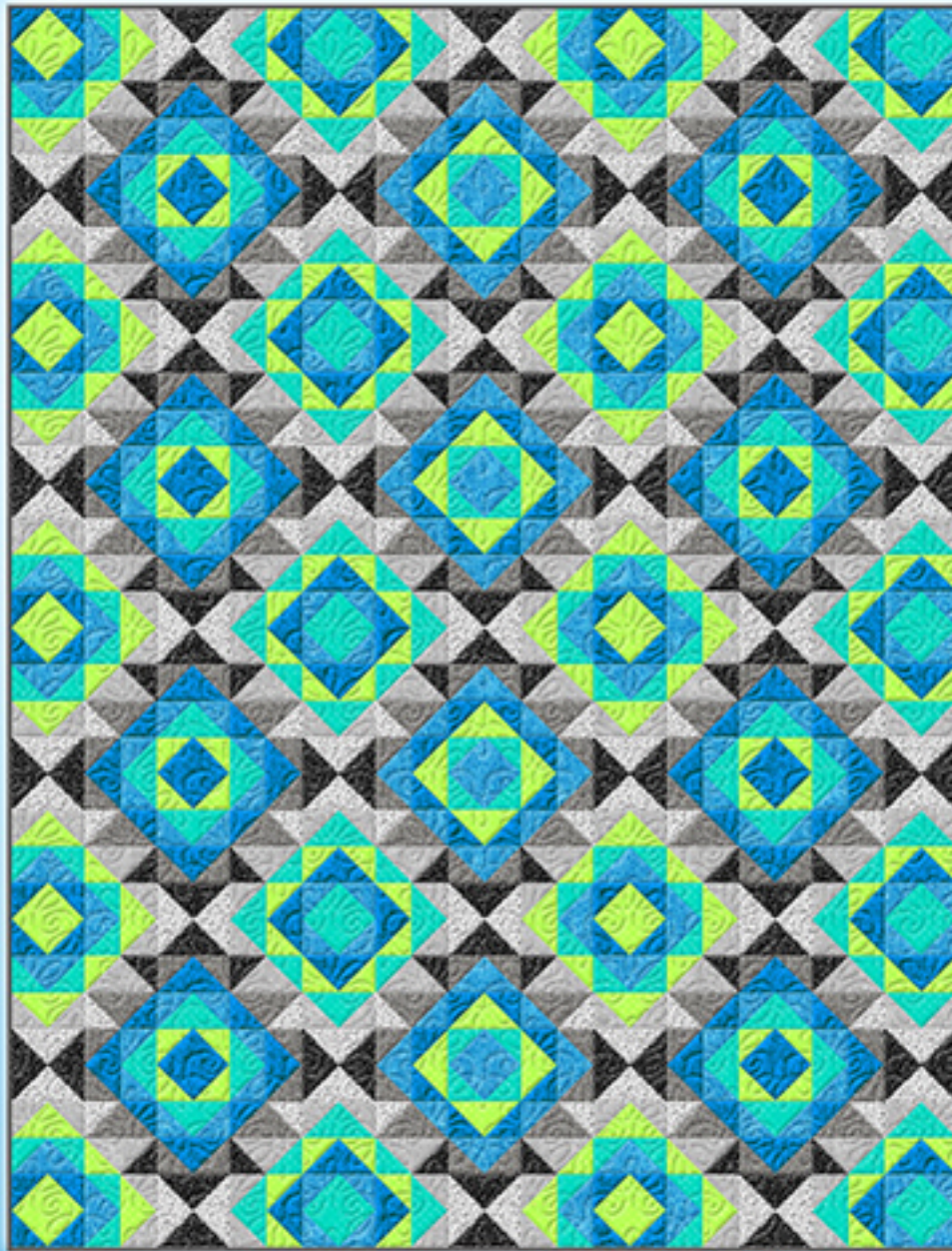


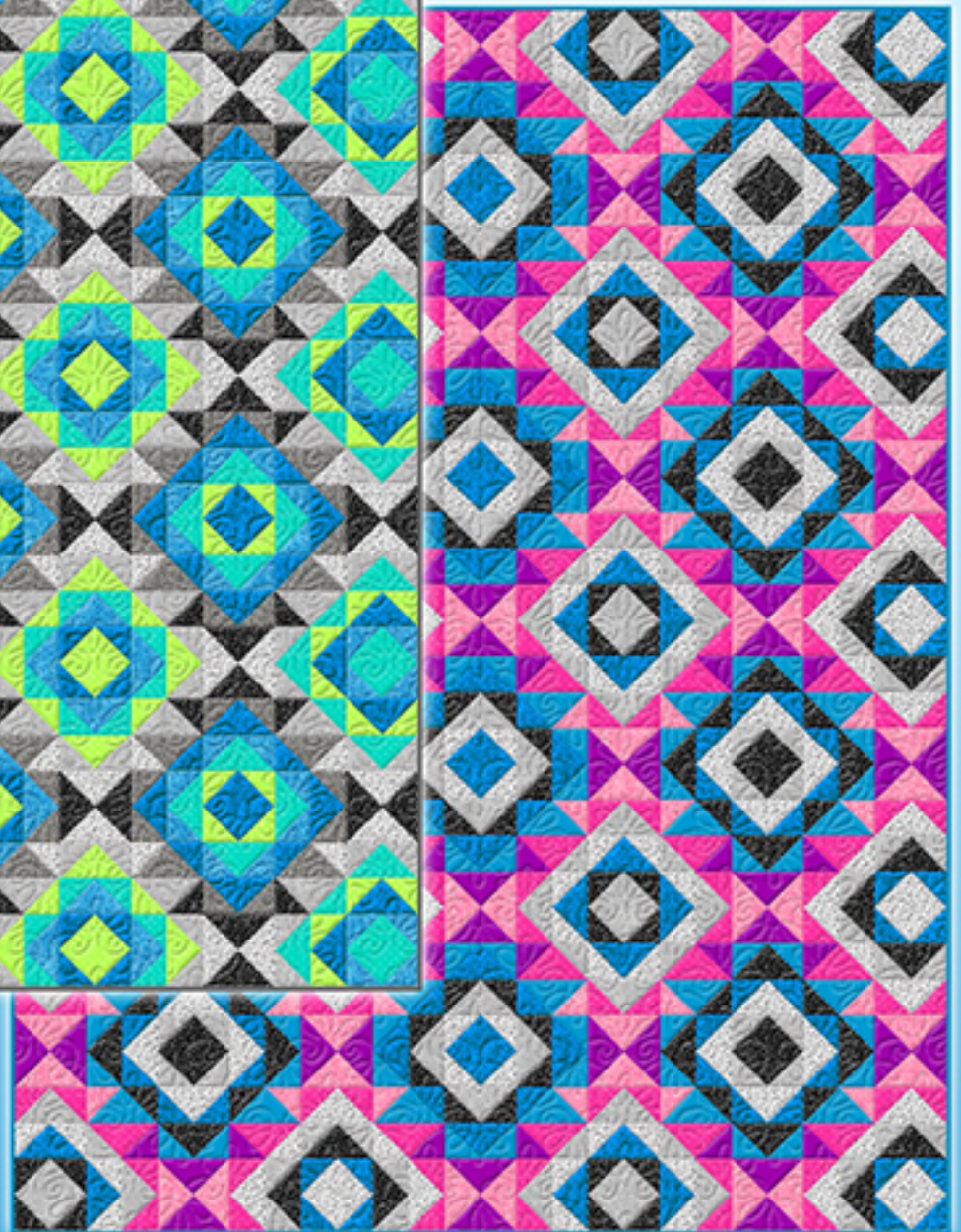

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# Essentials Sparkling Brights



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.  
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage.



## 1. Cut the following:



**Fabric A** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 64 triangles  
Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares  
Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (52) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 104 triangles



**Fabric B** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 5-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally  twice for 48 triangles] and (4) 3-3/8" squares  
Cut (5) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (60) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 120 triangles

**Fabric C** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 5-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally  twice for 48 triangles] and (3) 2-7/8" squares  
Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-3/8" squares  
Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (56) 2-7/8" squares then cut all 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally  for 118 triangles

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 64 triangles  
Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-3/8" squares  
Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (51) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 102 triangles

**Fabrics E and H** - From each fabric:  
Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 64 triangles  
Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 48 triangles

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 48 triangles  
Cut (5) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (62) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 124 triangles

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 48 triangles  
Cut (4) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (48) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 96 triangles  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

*Not all triangles cut will be used.*

*Shading of diagrams and Quilt Layout may vary depending on fabrics used.*

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics E** and **H** 5-1/4" triangles as shown. Stitch together. Make a total of 31 Unit 1 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



2. Sew 4 **Fabric C** 2-7/8" triangles to sides of a 3-3/8" **Fabric A** square. Make a total of 8 Unit 2a (4-1/2" square unfinished).



In the same manner make 4 Unit 2b and 10 each Units 2c and 2d.



3. Stitch 2 **Fabric B** 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of a **Fabric D** 5-1/4" triangle (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). Repeat to add 2 **Fabric G** 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of a



**Fabric A** 5-1/4" triangle. Stitch together as shown. Make a total of 32 Unit 3a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In

the same manner make 16 Unit 3b and 31 each Units 3c and 3d.



# Essentials Sparkling Brights

4. Stitch **Fabrics H and D** 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of a **Fabric F** 5-1/4" triangle (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). Repeat to add **Fabrics A and E** 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of a **Fabric G** 5-1/4" triangle. Stitch together as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 4a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner make 8 each Units 4b, 4c, and 4d and 4 each Units 4e, 4f, 4g, and 4h.

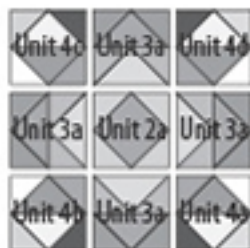

5. Arrange 1 Unit 2a, 4 Unit 3a, and 1 each Units 4a, 4b, 4c, and 4d in 3 rows. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 1a** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

6. Arrange 1 Unit 2b, 4 Unit 3b, and 1 each Units 4e, 4f, 4g, and 4h in 3 rows. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1b** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1b - Make 4

7. Stitch a Unit 1 between 2 Unit 3c. Make 8 **Block 2a** (4-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 2b** and 15 **Block 2c**.

8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of units and blocks.

9. Arrange blocks and units in 9 rows. (Note orientation of **Blocks 2c** as on Quilt picture). Sew units and blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

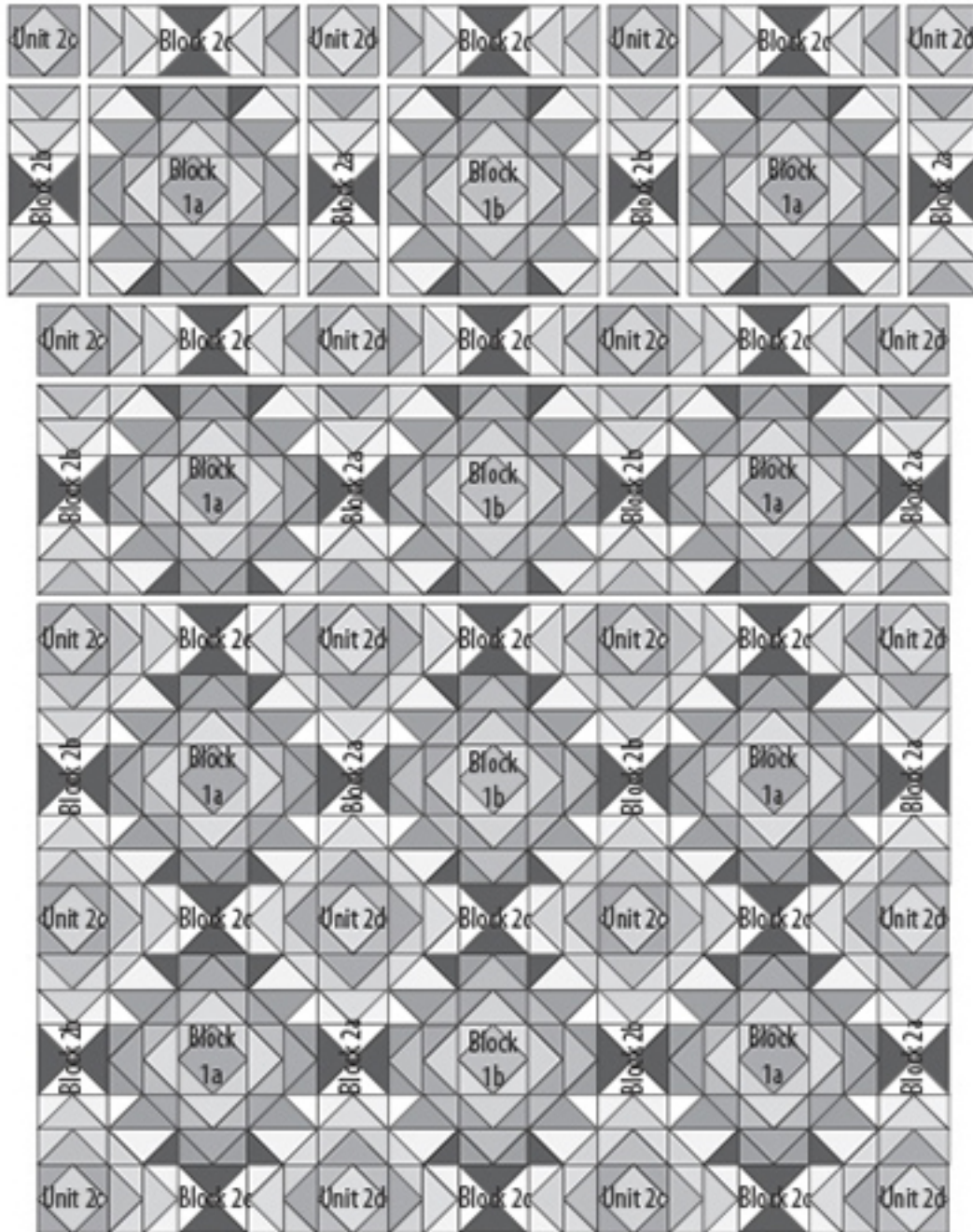
10. The quilt measures approximately 52-1/2" x 68-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric A**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

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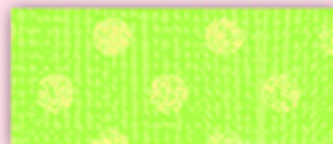

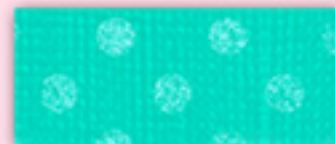
