Spa Cloth BY JANET AVILA

This pattern works well whether you pair your square with a special bar of soap and give it to a new mom or create a stack of them for washing dishes.

After the first repeat it is easy to read your knitting and thus knit without the pattern at your side.

ABBREVIATIONS

K knit, P purl,

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 38 stitches.

Row 1: K2, * P2, K2, repeat from * Row2: P2, *K2, P2, repeat from *


Row 3: Knit Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Repeat Row 1 Row6:Repeat Row 2

Row 7: Purl Row 8: Knit

Repeat rows 1 - 8 seven times, ending with a Row 6.

Bind Off.



PATTERN INFORMATION

FINISHED SIZE

approximately 7.5"x 7.5"

YARN

one ball of Clean Cotton or about 40g of worsted or DK weight cotton

GAUGE

Gauge isn't important, but you want a firm fabric so it won't completely lose shape when it is wet.

NEEDLES

US size #6 or #7 needles
