About the Early Readers Collection

The 'Early Readers' feature shorter words (CVC), less text per page and introduce additional code at a slower pace than the original Decodable Readers Australia collection. Therefore, the 'Early Readers' collection is recommended for children starting Read3. The 'original' collection (from Level 2) is best suited to those completing M3.1 as stories contain many words with extra consonants (CCVCC).

The Read3 Curation Process

Read3 has reviewed all books in the Early Readers collection. Titles have been grouped to align as closely as possible with the Read3 Scope and Sequence. The listing is provided in two formats:

- 1. Titles sorted by Read3 Step (includes full details of extra words)
- 2. Titles sorted by Early Reader Level

In the list sorted by Read3 Step, we have provided comprehensive details including:

- CCVCC Words: words with extra consonants for titles that may be suitable for Module 2
- Extra Words: words that do not match code taught so far in the Read3 Program
- HFW: High Frequency Words (early steps) or
- Extra HFW: High Frequency Words not covered so far in the Read3 Program
- Additional comments or guidance as needed

The listing under each program step is in descending order of difficulty from easiest to hardest. Because Read3 offers the flexibility to introduce some children to Module 3.1 (extra consonants) ahead of Module 2, some titles are listed in more than one place. The adjusted list of Extra Words includes identification of consonant blends so you can determine whether the additional code is manageable given the child's current skill level. For titles marked (** With Assistance) please review the book content carefully before sharing it with the child.
