**Swift Touring Paddles:** A remarkable blend of power and light weight in three distinct paddle designs. These paddles possess a radiant translucence in sunlight that is highly visible. One of the lightest paddles on the market today, Swift paddles prove powerful but forgiving with quick acceleration, a flutter free stroke and smooth follow through. The feathering angle is set at a comfortable 75 degrees to prevent wrist problems. The breakdown joints are reinforced, tight and trouble free. Three adjustments provide for left, right, and unfeathered control. Swifts are available in one piece or breakdown and shafts are lightly ovalled on both sides. Custom configurations are available.


**Lay-ups, Materials and Weight:** Available in fiberglass or graphite. Swift fiberglass paddles are some of the lightest on the market. All fiberglass paddles weigh in at 24 to 32 oz, depending on the size. Graphite is even lighter, stiffer and stronger – weighing 2 to 6 oz. less.

Fiberglass paddles may be ordered in a slightly heavier Outfitter lay-up for commercial use at no extra cost.


**Colors and Fabrics:** Fiberglass paddles are available in three beautiful translucent jewel tones: Amber, Red and Blue. These unique colors have brilliant visibility on the water. For an additional cost you can customize your paddle with our fabric inlaid blades. Like our standard blades, the fabric inlays are translucent and are quite striking when the sun shines through them. We have a variety of styles and colors to chose from. Graphite paddles are stealth black.



**WIND SWIFT:**  
With plenty of power for most paddlers and immune to wind, this paddle is extra light with absolute minimum impact to joints and muscles.



**MID SWIFT:**  
Our most popular size with plenty of juice for rough water conditions, yet behaves beautifully in wind. We find it ideal for extended paddling in varied and changeable conditions.



**SEA SWIFT:**  
Our largest blade with a unique asymmetrical blade and spoon configuration; this is an aggressive paddle. This blade is ideal for coastal paddling where surf and rough paddling conditions can be expected.

- To provide a healthful environment for our employees and that our methods protect the precious environment we live in.

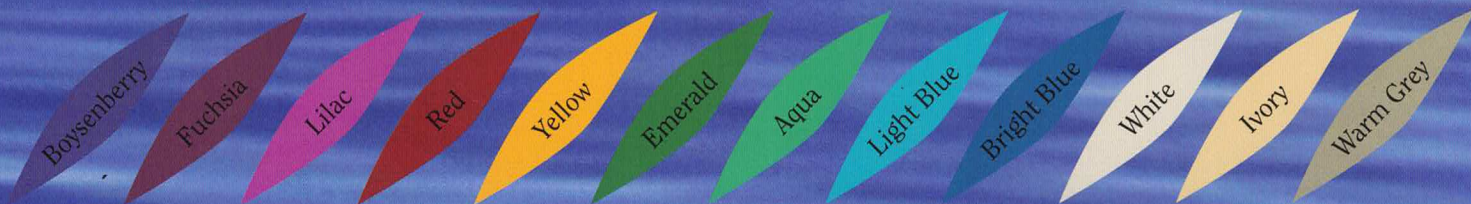
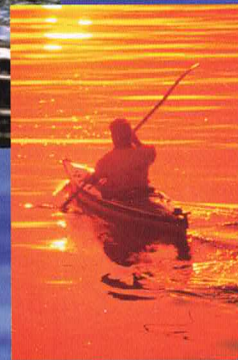
