___ "Goodnight stars, goodnight air, goodnight noises everywhere."

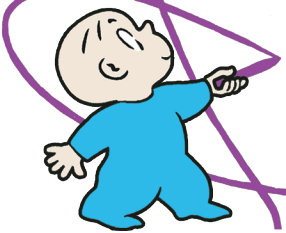
___ "There was you, and there was me, waiting for the day our stars would cross, and you and I turned into we."
