### THE LOCATION

Nestled between the Greater and Lesser Caucasus Mountain ranges lies the Kakheti region of the country of Georgia. The 34-acre Bagtaubani vineyard, owned by Wine Company Shumi, sits on the right bank of the Alazani River, 1,840 feet above sea level on a slightly inclined slope.



### THE WINE

The Saperavi grapes are hand-harvested and fermented in the classic European style using stainless steel and filtering.



### THE TASTE

Saperavi has an intense pomegranate color with ripe cherry, blackberry and black plum aromas. This wine has a high natural minerality with lively tannins. It has a fresh and bright acidity with a medium, well-balanced finish.

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
