The Shumi Winery and Tourist Complex is in the Tsinandali village, Kakheti, Georgia — 1,5 hours' drive from Tbilisi and 10 minutes from Telavi

Shumi occupies a historic location along the Kisiskhevi river

This land belonged to the kings of Georgia and Kakheti, prince Alexander Chavchavadze, Georgia's national poet, and served as a part of the summer residence of the Russian Emperor Alexander III





Founded in 1997, Wine Company Shumi produces a wide range of grape-based alcoholic beverages, including some created using patented technology and others found nowhere else in the world

Under the direction of top Georgian winemaker, Giorgi Khatiashvili, consulting with renowned French winemaker Jean-Michel Ferrandez, Shumi's products are acclaimed for their quality and have earned more than 350 prestigious international awards

- **The Enoteca**, a cellar vault holding Shumi's best





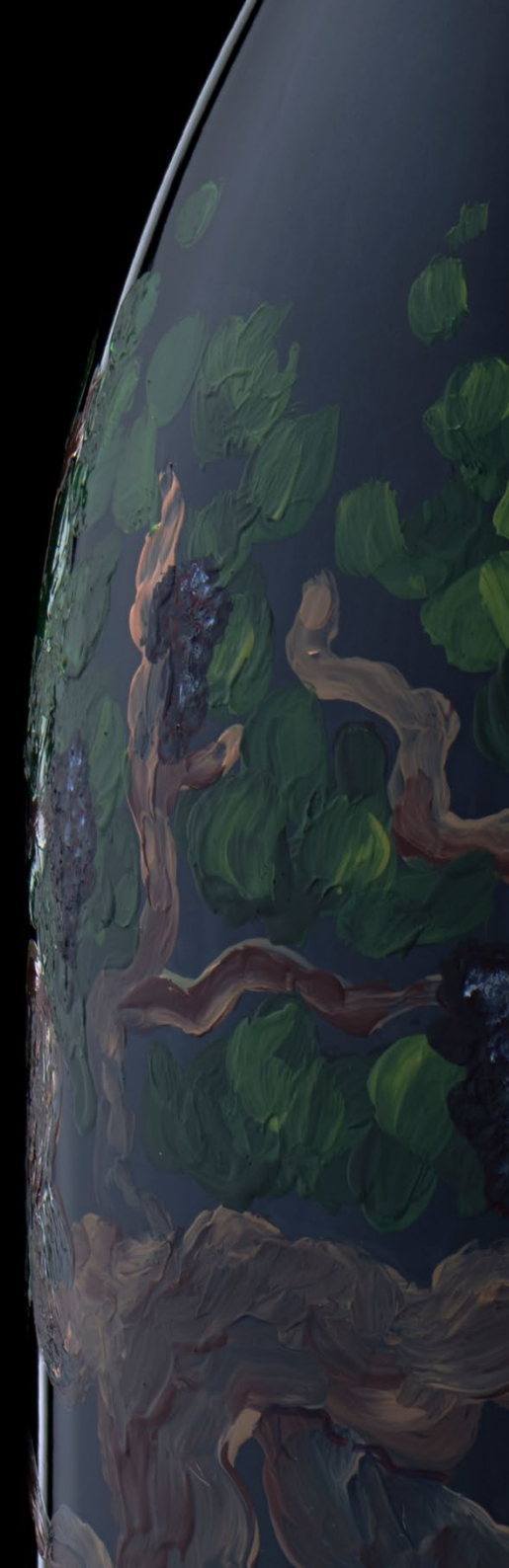
The Shumi Winery and Tourist Complex includes:
