### THE LOCATION

Nestled between the Greater and Lesser Caucasus Mountain ranges lies the Kakheti region of the country of Georgia. The 37-acre Spring at the Old Walnut vineyard, owned by Wine Company Shumi, sits in the strictly controlled Kindzmarauli micro-zone on the left bank of the Alazani River, 1,150 feet above sea level on level ground.



### THE WINE

The Saperavi grapes are green harvested in early summer – small, unripe grapes are removed by hand, allowing the vine to put all its energy into the remaining grapes. The grapes are fermented in the classic European style using stainless steel and filtering.



### THE TASTE

Kindzmarauli Premium is naturally semi-sweet and has an intense, dark ruby color with a hint of purple, strongly developed bouquet and expressed aromas of cherries, blackberries, and tropical fruits. The velvety tannic structure has a long, pleasant finish.



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
