THE LOCATION

Nestled between the Greater and Lesser Caucasus Mountain ranges lies the Kakheti region of the country of Georgia. The 62-acre Nadolobari vineyard, owned by Wine Company Shumi, sits in the strictly controlled Kindzmarauli micro-zone on the left bank of the Alazani River, 1,150 feet above sea level on level ground.



THE WINE

The Saperavi grapes are hand harvested and fermented in the classic European style using stainless steel and filtering.



THE TASTE

Kindzmarauli has a dark ruby color with a hint of purple. Naturally semi-sweet with a velvety composition, this wine has a medium bouquet of cherries and blackberries. The smooth tannic structure has a pleasant finish.

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
