


## HOW TO INSTALL A #402 U-BOLT



## **DIRECTION #907**

STEP #1. Slide bar into position from one side so it passes just over the

spare tire, arms forward. Slide the large bushing onto the bar.

STEP #2. Assemble end link on bar end as shown with the adaptor plate

at the bottom. Tighten the lock nuts only enough to keep the

assembly sung.

STEP #3. Slide the plate with the two pressed in lock nut into the

suspension assemble snug. Run the 5/16" bolts through the adaptor plate, then through the existing holes in the suspension

into the plate containing the lock nuts.

STEP #4. Position frame bracket over bar bushing and attach to existing

threaded holes via bolts provided. Note: Very early models and late models have no threaded holes in the frame. On these bars

use the square U-bolt provided- see general instruction.

STEP #5. Check all fastenings for suitable tightness and make sure that

all parts clear throughout the suspension travel.

STEP #6. Road test the car and accustom yourself to your cars new

handling. As we cannot supervise your installation (or your driving) we cannot be held responsible for more than the cost of

the kit. Note: for best results also install our front bar.
