# **BIG FLOWER**





## SIZE

Flower is about 24 in. (61 cm) across

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001)
   #611 Bouquet Pack
- LION BRAND® LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002)
   #303 Large (20 mm) crochet hook

## YOU'LL ALSO NEED

Hot glue and glue gun

### Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free—spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

## **KEY**

chain



single crochet

slip stitch

## **HERE'S HOW**

#### **Flower Center**



**Step 1** With A, make a slip knot onto the hook. Chain 3.

Join with a slip stitch to make a ring.

#### **Terms**

**sc** = single crochet

**turn** = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.



**Step 2** Chain 1, make 6 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in the first sc to join.




**Step 3** Chain 1, make 2 sc in each of the 6 sc, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 12 sc.

Fasten off.



Join B with slip stitch in any sc of Step 3.


**Step 4** With B, chain 1, \*make 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 18 sc.




**Step 5** Chain 1, \*make 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from \* 4 more times, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 25 sc.

### **Petals**

Join C with a slip stitch in any sc of Step 5.




**Step 6** Chain 1, make 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – you'll have 6 sc.




**Step 8** Chain 1, turn, skip the slip stitch, make 1 sc in each sc across, then make sc stitches evenly spaced down the side of the petal until you're back at the Flower Center.


Make 1 sc in the next sc of the Flower Center.



**Step 7** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of next 4 sc, slip stitch in next sc – you'll have 4 sc.





**Step 9** Repeat Steps 6-8 until you've made a total of 5 petals. At the end of the last petal, slip stitch in first sc of first petal to join.



Join D with a slip stitch on the last row of one of the petals.


**Step 10** Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the 4 sc across the top of the petal.






**Step 11** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc – you'll have 3 sc.

**Step 12** Chain 1, turn, skip first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, then sc evenly spaced along the side of the petal and up to the top of the next petal.





**Step 13** Repeat Steps 10-12 until you've made a total of 5 petals. At the end of the last petal, slip stitch into petal to join.


Fasten off.

Join B with a slip stitch on the edge of one petal.


**Step 14** With B, chain 1, make 1 sc in each sc around the outside edge of the petals, working 2 sc in some sc stitches and skipping some stitches to keep piece flat, slip stitch in first sc to join.

## **Finish Petals**


Join E with a slip stitch about 1 stitch before the top edge of any petal.




**Step 15** Chain 1, make 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc – you'll have 6 sc.



**Step 16** Chain 1, turn, skip first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, slip stitch in the last sc.



**Step 17** Chain 1, turn, skip the slip stitch, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, make sc stitches evenly spaced along the petal edge to the top of the next petal.



**Step 18** Repeat Steps 15-17 around the rest of petals, slip stitch to join.



## Stem

With A, make a slip knot onto the hook and work chain stitches to the length you'd like for the stem.

**Step 19** With A, make 1 sc in the second chain from hook and 1 sc in each remaining chain.

#### Leaf







**Step 20** With A, make a slip knot on the hook and chain 7. Make 1 sc in the second chain from the hook and in each of the next 5 chains – you'll have 6 sc.

**Step 21** Chain 1, turn, make 3 sc in the first sc, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sc – you'll have 8 sc.

**Step 22** Chain 1, then sc evenly around the outside edge of the leaf, slip stitch in first sc to join.

Fasten off.

Repeat Steps 20-22 to make another leaf.

Glue the stem to the flower, then glue or tie the leaves to the stem. Glue yarn tails to the back of the pieces.
