No items allowed that are not art, craft, display, or set-up related. If you have a question about items, please contact Erin Solin or Lindsay Mena.
- ALL items remaining at the end of the Market will be donated to local schools unless you have made prior arrangements to pick up your items at the end of the show. If you do not pick up your items by the end of the pickup time (7:00 pm), we will assume that you have chosen to donate them.
- ACF will provide price tags and facilitate sales and money exchange. You are responsible for providing price amounts for your own items.
- Reserve your table space in advance advance pay \$25 to participate.
- A minimum of 10% (or 25% if you are not going to be there for the day of the sale) of your sales must be donated to ACF for the Scholarship/Education Fund. The \$25 advance-paid table rental will apply toward your total percentage.
- Payment of your total sales, minus your donation percentage, will be provided to you within two weeks of the event.
- We are also happy to accept items donations for our raffle baskets
