

Fabric cleaning instructions

Our fabrics resist stains, repel water, prevent odors, and inhibit the growth of bacteria all without sacrificing aesthetics and comfort. Because these fabrics are commercial-grade, they're designed to take on life's messes. We make cleaning spills and stains easy with a few simple and effective steps. Follow this process for any of our leading name brand fabrics.



Before spot cleaning, blot up liquids on the surface with a clean, soft towel. For thicker substances, use a spoon to remove any excess.



Combine 1 tsp of an enzyme detergent (such as laundry or dish detergent) with 16 oz of warm water. Mix well.



Apply the cleaning solution using a misting spray bottle.



Use a soft brush to work the solution into the affected area. Make sure to work from the outside of the stain inward so as not to spread the stain.



Rinse thoroughly with water to remove all soap residue.



Blot excess moisture with a clean, soft towel or sponge.



Repeat steps 3-6 (spray, brush, rinse, and blot) as needed.



Allow fabric to air dry.
