Secondly, it causes the student to see God's answer in Scripture and read it for themselves rather than each student coming up with their own conclusions. There can only be real unity between believers when we sacrifice our own thoughts and ideas and stand on God's word alone.

Although any good version of Scripture can be used to search out answers, obviously the easiest one to match to the blanks will be the one that this series is based on. I have used *THE NEW AMERICAN STANDARD BIBLE* as the basis for this study because of its easy readability and excellent reputation for accuracy and faithfulness to the original text. I have tried to be as true to the Scriptures as possible with the questions and discussion, but there is always the possibility of human error, so be sure to read and study the Scriptures carefully. If you need a New American Standard Bible to study with, please be comfortable in asking the teacher or the person who gave you this material, and one will be gladly provided for your assistance.

I hope you find the Bible lessons in this series interesting and challenging. Your feedback on this series of lessons would be welcomed and there is a second series on Christian Growth that follows this one if you are interested.

INTRODUCTION

More and more people today are expressing grave doubts about the Bible being God's revelation to man. In many cases the reason that this is being done is not because these people have considered the evidence and seriously weighed the conclusions. The reason there is so much doubt today is because smear campaigns being waged by Satan to shake the faith of men in God's word are vocal and numerous. To grasp my meaning, just think of all the people that you have ever heard express doubt in the Bible and compare that number to the number of people you have heard express complete confidence. In the media and personally, we are often inundated with the idea that the Bible is "just another book of religion." We are told that it's untrustworthy because "it has been translated so many times," or "it's full of errors and contradictions." If one is willing to fairly examine the evidence, he will discover that in every way possible God has given us the means to PROVE His book is the book of books. The above generic criticisms of the Bible are false and have yet to be proven after almost 2,000 years. We encourage you to "taste" some of the reasons why it is logical and acceptable to believe that the Bible is truly the word of God to man.
