We are sure that you will enjoy your new basin for years to come. When properly sealed they are very easy to maintain.

+ Clean your CN product using a mild non-abrasive cleanser. Please refrain from using scour pads on the concrete, as it can scratch your product and break down the sealer.

+ Avoid exposure to products with high levels of PH such as paint strippers, bleach, and nail polish remover. If exposure occurs, rinse immediately with water to neutralize effect, and then follow usual cleansing procedure.

+ Do not leave moist or wet products directly on concrete for a prolonged period. We advise to use coasters under soaps and plants. Remember if its wet, wipe it up to avoid potential marking.

Stubborn Stains and Dried Spills

For dried spills, a wet cloth is recommended. For stubborn stains, use a non-acidic and non-abrasive cleanser, we love Koh Universal Cleaner but any multi-purpose cleanser will do the trick. Avoid forceful scrubbing as this may result in loss of shine and remove the protective sealer.

Direct Sunlight

Direct sunlight can cause concrete to slowly discolour over a long period of time.

Scratches, Cracks, and Edge Chipping

Overtime, your CN product may develop scratches and marks from day to day use. Try to avoid impact on edges and the surface with hard objects. However, each piece within the CN collection is sealed with a deep penetrative sealer so resealing is not required.

In the unlikely event that a product does need to be resealed or damages do occur to your product, Concrete Nation can provide a refresh kit with simple instructions.
