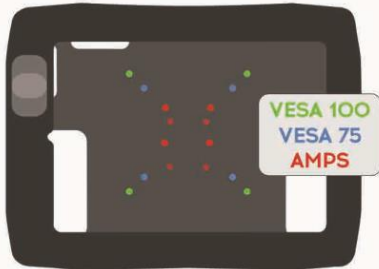


# PADHOLDER PRO SERIES

## SURFACE GO

### STEP 1



Determine which mounting pattern you are going to use with your mount. For VESA mounting use the tapered screws, installing them through the front of the back plate facing outward. If you're using the AMPS pattern, use the pan-head screws to install the mount on the back of the holder

### STEP 2

If you are not using a case with your holder, skip to step 4.

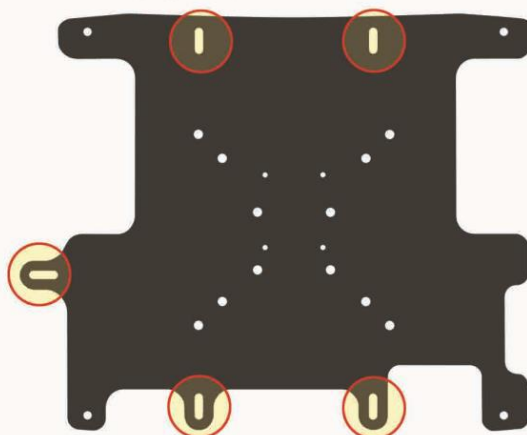
#### To change the spacers:

- Remove the 4 bolts from the front of the faceplate.
- Loosen the 2 bolts on the back of the lock (DO NOT REMOVE THE LOCK). (Fig. 2A)
- Remove all of the spacers from the front and back plates.
- Select the set of spacers that is slightly thicker than the case you wish to use with your iPad.
- Install the 4 corner spacers on the backplate.
- Loosely install the 5 spacers that go on to the screws in the slotted holes of the backplate. (Fig. 2B)

### STEP 3



- Slide your tablet in the holder and center it.
- Push the spacers in the slotted holes against the tablet and tighten down the bolts.
- Engage the lock by pressing it in, then move the lock so the pin is against the iPad.
- Tighten the 2 bolts for the lock to keep it in place.

### STEP 4



Your tablet is now able to freely slide in and out of the holder while the lock is disengaged. To lock the tablet in the holder, press in on the face of the lock cylinder. To unlock, insert the key in to the lock and turn clockwise.
