

## Pehr Designs Standard Care Instructions

### Hampers, Bins, and Pints

These items should only be spot cleaned as needed and not machine-washed. Most surface stains on the canvas can be removed with a clean dry cloth. If the stain persists, hand-wash the affected area only with a clean, slightly damp cloth, with natural detergent if needed.

To get your storage perfectly perfect, iron the inner sides on low heat.

### Napkins, Tea Towels, Placemats and Table Runners

Tabletop items can all be machine washed and dried. Because of the natural cotton and linen content of the napkins, they will wrinkle if they are left in the dryer. The best thing to do is to take them out of the dryer and gently iron if needed or fold right away. The more you use them and wash them, the less wrinkled they will be when they come out of the washer and dryer, as the natural fibers in the napkin relax.

### Pillow Covers

Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat. Iron or steam on low heat.

Please do not iron felt reverse if applicable.

### Throws

*Wool:* Please dry-clean only.

*Linen:* Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat. Iron or steam on low heat.

### Quilts, Crib Sheets, and Swaddles

Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat.

### Nursery Pillow Covers

Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat.

### Character Pillows

Machine wash cold on a gentle cycle with natural detergent, and tumble dry on low heat.
