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# Baby's Adventure

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*

**Fabric A** - Fussy cut panel to 21-1/2" x 39-1/2"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 5" x 74" navy stripe border, (1) 5" x 74" gray stripe border, (1) 5" x 54" navy stripe border, and (1) 5" x 54" gray stripe border

**Fabrics C and D** - From each fabric:  
Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabrics E and F** - From each fabric:  
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together and cut into (1) 3-1/2" x 54" border  
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 34" border

**Fabrics G and H** - From each fabric:  
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (1) 3" x 24-1/2" border  
Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (1) 2" x 39-1/2" border

**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares and (2) 3" squares  
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (14) 3" squares

**Fabric J** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares and (9) 3" squares  
Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (42) 3" squares

**Fabrics K and M** - From each fabric:  
Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (19) 3" squares

**Fabric L** - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (18) 3" squares

**Fabric N** - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (17) 3" squares

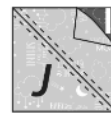
## 2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabric J** 3-1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

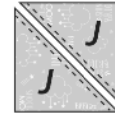


*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.*

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 3-1/2" square right sides together with a **Fabric I** 3-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 1.



Repeat 2 times for 4 units.

3. Arrange 2 Unit 1 and 1 each **Fabrics K and M** 3" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Block 1** (5-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 2

*Stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.*

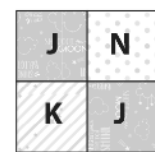
4. Arrange 2 **Fabric L** and 1 each **Fabrics J and M** 3" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 9 **Block 2** (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 3** and 17 **Block 4**.

Block 4 - Make 17

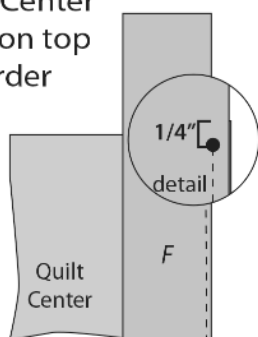
5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, blocks, and borders.

6. Stitch **Fabric G** 2" x 39-1/2" border to left side and **Fabric H** 2" x 39-1/2" border to right side of **Fabric A** panel. Add **Fabric G** 3" x 24-1/2" border to bottom and **Fabric H** 3" x 24-1/2" border to top of **Fabric A** panel. Quilt center measures 24-1/2" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).



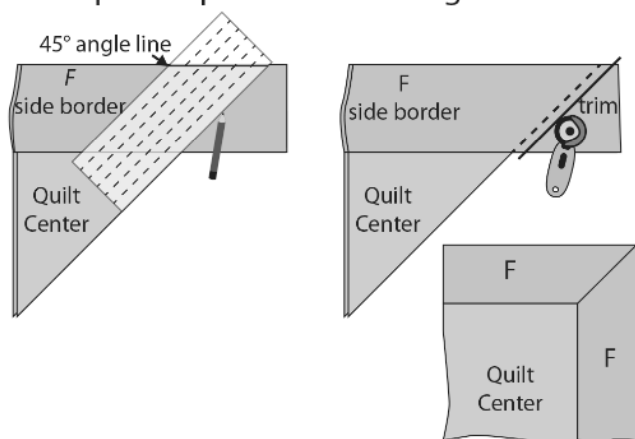

7. Center **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 54" border on left side and **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 54" border on right side of quilt center. Center **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 34" border on top and **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 34" border on bottom of quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.  
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

8. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



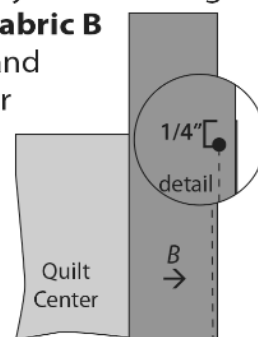
9. Arrange 5 **Block 2** and 5 **Block 3** in a vertical row on left side of quilt. Stitch blocks into left border (5-1/2" x 50-1/2" unfinished). Sew to left side of quilt.

10. Arrange 10 **Block 4** in a vertical row on right side of quilt, noting rotation of blocks. Stitch blocks into right border (5-1/2" x 50-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right side of quilt.

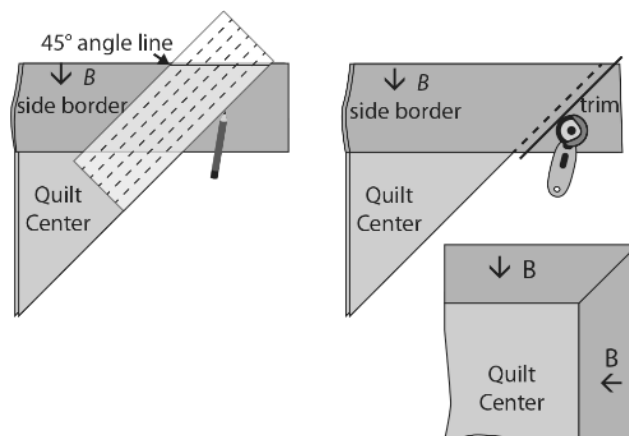
11. Arrange 1 **Block 1** and 7 **Block 4** in a row above quilt, noting rotation of each **Block 4**. Stitch blocks into top border (5-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top of quilt.

12. Arrange 1 **Block 1**, 4 **Block 2**, and 3 **Block 3** in a row below quilt. Stitch blocks into bottom border (5-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew to bottom of quilt.

13. Center **Fabric B** 5" x 74" navy border on left side and **Fabric B** 5" x 74" gray border on right side of quilt center. Center **Fabric B** 5" x 54" gray border on top and **Fabric B** 5" x 54" navy border on bottom. Note orientation of stripes. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



15. The quilt measures approximately 49-1/2" x 69-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabrics C and D**) and enjoy!!
