Fabric requirements:

• We will supply a kit to practice the binding technique. You will need no additional fabric.

Sewing supplies

- 1. Sewing machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot
- 2. Rotary cutter, 6 inch or 12 inch ruler and small mat
- 3. Fabric marking pen
- 4. Neutral thread
- 5. Scissors
