Project description: Edelweiss is a delightful flower quilt constructed with no curves. With simple flip and sew techniques, you'll get perfect results every time. Choose how big to grow your flower garden quilt, a table runner or a twin sized quilt. Kits available for 74" x 74" quilt. We will make one flower and two leaf sections together in class.

Required Pattern: Edelweiss

Fabric requirements (kits available for quilt):

See pattern back for 74" x 74" quilt yardage

If making a table runner, you will need the following:

- 2 blue fat quarters (for flower)
- 3 green fat quarters (for leaves and stems)
- 1 cream fat quarter
- 1 yd. background (includes a small border and binding)

Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine with power cord/foot control/quarter inch foot
2. Rotary mat, rotary cutter and a 24" ruler
3. Neutral thread
4. Fabric marking pen, optional
5. Ziplock bags to organize cut fabric

Preparation prior to class:

We will organize and cut the fabric as needed in class.

For one flower block you will need to cut:

- (8) 4" squares 1st blue (petals)
- (1) 4" square 2nd blue (flower center)
- (16) 1.75" squares background
- (4) 2" x 4" rectangles background
- (4) 2" x 5.5" rectangles background
- (4) 2" x 4" cream (flower interior)

For one leaf block you will need to cut:

- (1) 1.5" x 14" rectangle for green stem
- (2) 2" x 16" rectangle 1st green
- (1) 2" x 16" rectangle 2nd green

From background fabric for leaf:

- (12) 2" x 2" squares (label D)
- (1) 1" x 5" (label E)
- (2) 1.5" x 5" (label F)
- (1) 1.75" x 5" (label G)
- (1) 2" x 5" (label H)
- (1) 2.25" x 5" (label I)
- (1) 2.5" x 5" (label J)
- (2) 2.25" x 14" (label K)
